

Title: Vision/Overcome

Well, we do this once a year. I don't know how long I've been doing it, but it's really important to God what we do here tonight. His heart and His word is to be revealed. I'm just going to pray really quick and invite His presence on this Word. Amen.

“Father God, we thank You that You are who You say you are. I thank You that You have allowed us to seek your face. I thank You that You have revealed Jesus to each and every one of us, Father. We are so grateful for our salvation. Where would we be without You, Lord? It's all about You. We vow to only give You all the glory. It's not a religious slogan, Lord. It's our life. It's a vow of truth, that we vow to only give You the glory. You alone are worthy. There's only one. Jesus, thank You. Thank You that You call us Your own, and that everything You did was for us to be one with You. Lord, we thank You for Your grace and mercy. We thank You for bringing understanding to our hearts. We thank You for imparting fresh vision tonight and clear understanding. No matter how many years we've been serving You, Lord, *may* tonight be fresh and new. I ask for Your reformation, Your revival, restoration, renewal, strengthening, and encouragement to be imparted to all. In Jesus' name, amen. Hallelujah!

First of all, I want to state it's very vital that we have Kingdom vision. Okay, we're going to read some Scriptures about this. We have to have vision. That doesn't just mean with our physical eyes to see, but we know how important it is as humans, that God gave us eyes. He gave us eyes for a reason. He gave us physical eyes to see, and He gave us spiritual eyes to see when you're born again from above, hallelujah.

It's important for the Garden Gathering Church and for the Garden Training Center, for you to understand that our number one heart, is to host God's presence in fullness. That means there's no limit. There's no lid. Amen. We are fully submitted to the fullness of the Godhead, Father, Son and Holy Ghost, and we want His perfect will to be manifested in our lives every day, and not just when we gather. That is our desire and our purpose. It is our duty before God, amen. We want to host His presence. that means every time we gather in dinners, or one to one at home, cell groups, corporate gatherings, worship, if we go out to the streets and minister, or we go across the globe to minister. Whatever we have set our hands and feet to do, the whole goal is that Jesus is with us. God is with us. When two of us are gathered together in His name, He says, “I am there in your midst.” He is here, and He is with us. I want to acknowledge Him. I don't want to ignore Him. You know He's here. Our other call is to equip the saints to do the works of the ministry. That means every saint is a believer and is a minister. Every saint is a believer and is a minister. That doesn't mean that we're all behind a pulpit and lead a Church as pastors or apostles. Yet, every saint is a minister in all of our areas of influence, wherever the Lord our God would send us, plant us and put us, and starting in our homes.

You were born in a family. Then when you get born again, you're born again, again into a family, right? The family of God. Since Jesus Christ rose from the dead, He has been bringing in multitudes of family members. He's not finished yet. Say, "Jesus is not finished yet, that's why I'm here." Because, see, every saint is a minister to help Him do the works that He did, to save and seek the lost, to deliver, to heal, to restore, to comfort. Yes, wherever we have our feet, in any sphere on this planet, He is the One. He is the center of it all. "Without Him, you can do nothing." Constantly you hear that from me. The thread throughout all teachings is John 15. To hear Jesus's words, "Abide in Me, and My word," which is the Bible and My teachings. "Abide in Me, and in My word. Remain in Me, and you will bear much fruit. But, apart from Me, He said, "You can do nothing," absolutely nothing. Those things are called dead works of which is no reward, but great is our reward in Heaven, because we recognize who He is.

Matthew 28:18-20 NKJV

If you don't have this memorized, it's a good one to memorize, because this is your business. Say, "This is my business. This is my call. We have Kingdom vision to fulfill His Great Commission."

This is an apostolic prayer, and we are going to pray this prayer together. Don't just read it. We're praying it. Okay, y'all with me? Holy Spirit is hearing and listening and imparting what we are asking. Amen.

Ephesians 1:17-23 NKJV

This is a prayer that we are invited into to pray every day, every day, every day. You don't have to be gathered together in the Church to pray it. It is for every saint. What a powerful declaration that the great Holy Ghost gave the Apostle Paul when He wrote this. Now I'm going to read it again. I want you to listen, and hear the Father.

Ephesians 1:17-23 NKJV

Glory to God! Please, if you've never known this prayer, or if you've never read this before, today is the day. Now, you're invited to enter into this promise. This is glorious news. There is so much power in these words. It's not religious. It is a reality of the Kingdom of Heaven and the Lord of that Kingdom, Jesus, and the great Holy Spirit, and God, the Father's plan for all of us, for all eternity. As we come into agreement this day, I can guarantee you that Heaven is still

proclaiming this over us, now. Those who've already crossed the finish line and gone home, they are still in agreement with Heaven's mandate on the Earth. For the saints to complete and fulfill all that is written of them in the scroll of the book. Our desire is that everyone of us would have a heart that would say, "Father, I desire and submit to all that is written in the scroll of the book that you have for me. I say, "Yes and amen." 'Align my heart. Cast out of me anything hindering. Set me on fire. Anoint me with fresh oil. Teach me. Grant me repentance. Get me out of my flesh. Help me to walk after the Spirit, so that I can fulfill your purpose, your destiny, and your call, because I am your inheritance."

We are His inheritance, and we want to give Jesus our very best. He gave His very best for us. No one has loved us like Him. We all love each other so much. We love our families, but His love is perfect. His love is perfect, and He's teaching us how to love, correct? To know Him is to love Him, and to love Him is to obey Him, amen. We need Kingdom vision. I'm going to review some scriptures. Some of these will be new for you if you're new to this. I'm going to start in the King James and then give you some different versions, so you can hear the purpose of how important vision is.

Proverbs 29:18 KJV

"Where there is no vision, the people perish. But he that keepeth the law, happy is he."

Proverbs 29:18 NKJV

"Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint, but happy is he who keeps the law."

Proverbs 29:18 NLT

"When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful."

Proverbs 29:18 NIV

"Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint, but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instructions."

Proverbs 29:18 NASB

"Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, but happy is one that keeps the law."

Proverbs 29:18 LSB

"Where there is no vision, the people are out of control. But how blessed is he who keeps the law."

Vision is vital. This is the word of the Lord. The Godhead, the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, has vision. He is, "I am, that I am." That is who He is. He is all vision. That's it. "I am, that I am." That is His name, and He is the One that imparts to us His vision for His Kingdom. Isn't that amazing! If we don't lay hold of Kingdom vision, we perish. We will cast off restraint. We are running wild. We are not accepting godly guidance. We are going nuts. We are unrestrained. We are out of control. It makes sense to get in line and alignment with the Father of glory. He will impart to us His heart. He will impart to us and show us His heart, which is where all vision comes from. It doesn't come from the eye. True vision comes from the heart. It came from the heart of God, and He is the one that wrote these words. Great Holy Spirit wrote these words, and the Body of Christ is still receiving it to this day. Without it, "oh, my goodness, no, no." We have to have vision. You know what? This can grow, and you can go from glory to glory to glory, amen. Vision is vital. We need revelation knowledge of our God and Father. Revelation knowledge of our Lord, Jesus Christ. We need revelation knowledge, and we need Holy Spirit.

We need to know who He is and His Kingdom. I don't want to just read about Him. I don't want to just do another Bible study. I don't want to just teach another sermon without knowing Him. Everything is about knowing Him. Every single thing, all vision that He's imparted to you, you will give to others. That's why you sing, "Once I was blind, but now I see." Once I had a hard heart. Now, my heart beats for Jesus. Now, all I care about is what He cares about. All I want to know is what He knows. All I want to hear is what He has to say. All I want to do is to be about my Father's business. Now, my whole life is not about me, the carnal ways of this life and world. But now, my life is all about my God, His vision, His assignment, His heartbeat, and His purpose. That is the sole reason why we exist. I know, bless our hearts, it wasn't to find your beautiful wife or husband or have all these babies. It was to know Him.

Everything we do in life is about Him, everything, everything, absolutely, everything. Before we got saved, we knew nothing of this. Praise be to Jesus Christ, who has given us hope. We need to know who we are in Christ Jesus. We teach this at every level. We have to know in Whom we believe. We have to know who He says we are, because once you find out who you are, everything changes. You go from a sinner mentality to a saint, to a child of God, to the individual He called by name. Now, you're so precious, and you know it. Now, this causes the fear of the Lord to come into your life. When you submit to the fear of the Lord, wisdom comes. "For the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom." When we fear the Lord, the Kingdom of Heaven moves in.

If we fear man, and we are still bound by the devil, who is the little god of fear, who we were slave to when we were born. We had to come out of that to be born again from above into perfect love, and, "Perfect love casts out all fear." Hallelujah! Hallelujah! Hallelujah! We were not born to fear, but fear is a part of life. But once you know the Master, you're abiding in the Word and the great Holy Ghost. *He will* cast all those dumb demons out of you. He gets rid of those strongholds of the mind. You are renewed in the Spirit of your mind to who He is, what this is all about, and who you are. You walk with God, and you go around doing good, and healing all who are oppressed by the devil. As God was with Jesus, God is with us. You hear it?

This is Kingdom vision. This is the truth. It is total transformation. Total transformation is a miracle. You are a miracle. I am a miracle. Yes, if you're looking for miracles, look in the mirror. Yes, because that's the truth. Where would we be without His mercy, His forgiveness and His grace? Vision is vital to know this. We need to know the plans that He has for us. Now that's a journey, and I call it the journey of love. You don't get the whole playbook. The first day you're born again, you just step in and you start walking with God. We need to know what are we doing? We need to know where we are and where are we going. We need to know why. We need to know Him. How am I going to get there and win? The list continues, because now that you know that you know who you are, all of a sudden, you bow your knee to the Father of glory, and to the Lord Jesus Christ. You say, "Father, what am I doing? What's your passion for me? Where am I going? When? How? What? I'm yours, Lord."

It can be one thing today. In five years, He has brought you into more growth. You're able to be mature and to advance. Yes, He'll test our hearts. Oh yes, that's all through the Bible, because He's not afraid to test our motives and our hearts. He's got to uproot pride, because we were born under the father of pride, that haughty spirit that makes self king. So when we submit to the King of glory and His vision, He starts unfolding these things to us in the journey of love. We can be delivered when we repent of pride. If you think you don't have pride, you can go ahead and come to the altar after the word, because everyone of us were born in it. I tell the Lord all the time, "Search me and know me. See if there be any wicked way in me. If there is Lord God, deliver me, grant me repentance and pull it up and out, because I want what you want." That's the fear of the Lord. I promise He will continue to correct us to the end, amen.

Jesus Christ has revealed to us that, "Today is the day of salvation." That's scripture. That's amazing to me. It's like we'll say, "When does this vision start?" He says, "The day you got born again." He said, "Today is the day of salvation." As soon as you get born again, Kingdom vision comes inside of you. Now, all these things start to come out.

I've shared this story over and over. It always keeps coming up to me. The first time I had a thought or impression was when I was a little girl, sitting on my front sidewalk, in Amarillo, Texas. I was looking at the sunset, and the thought came into my mind, "Why am I here? Who am I? Why is this? What is the purpose?" I started asking these questions in elementary school, probably second grade. Who told me that? Who started speaking to me when I was sitting by myself on the sidewalk looking at the sunset? God Almighty was speaking. You know that, "From the womb, He was already declaring over you, "Live," and life and purpose. Angels were already assigned from conception, because He knew you from the beginning of the foundations." That's why we exist, truth. There is no accident. This is divine purpose. When we know and believe this, not only will our lives be changed, but we can change the lives of others who are still searching. They do not know yet, amen. "Today is the day of salvation."

Say, "When am I going to start?" Say, "Today." God is inviting us into His fullness, His life, His Kingdom and His will. It's a big invitation. Every day He invites us into His fullness, His life, His Kingdom and His will. Do you remember that Jesus prayed this, "Father, not My will, but Your will be done?" Jesus has yielded a willing heart for His Father's will in the Kingdom of Heaven, so will we? It looks like that, the Bride and the Church are going to follow His lead and example by the grace of God. Say, "By the grace of God." We're going to surrender our lives to His Lordship and love. Big words, say, "Surrender." Absolute surrender, that's where it all starts. That's the gateway to glory. Surrender is the gateway to glory, absolute surrender. Jesus is our model. Praise the Lord! He said, "Father, not My will, but Your will be done." Thank the Lord that He did what He did for us, so that we could be here. Truth. That brings humility and the fear of the Lord. As the Bride and Church, we shall follow His lead and example by the grace of God. God causes all growth and is perfecting what concerns us all. Hallelujah!

Psalm 110:3 NASB

"Your people will volunteer freely on the day of Your power."

Meaning God's power, "Your people will volunteer freely on the day of your power."

Psalm 110:3 WEB

"Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power."

"Your people will volunteer freely in the day of your power.' 'Thy people shall be willing.'" That's why Jesus said, "Father, not My will, but Your will be done." Jesus knew why He came to the Earth. But, He submitted it, He declared it, He prayed it, and He taught us the same truth, and we're still praying that today. We teach others this, amen. We don't have to go to the cross and pay for our sins. He did it. He said, "It is finished." But, we have to fully surrender and submit to His will, volunteering freely and willingly, with a willing heart. Look at the story here. Now, there are many, many scriptures in the Bible that talk about willing hearts, but I pulled a few for us to get the idea. It's one thing to know, you have to do something. It's another thing when you are so willing. It's one thing when you have to. It's another thing when you volunteer freely and you are willing. You have a willing heart, and the glory of God will rest on that, amen. They're bringing in offerings in the House of the Lord at this time in. You can read all of it at home.

Exodus 35:4-5 NKJV

Now, you're going to see that a willing heart is like unto an "offering unto the Lord," not just in what they were really collecting in order to do A, B and C. But, it goes together. Everything we touch goes back to the heart. Our heart and His, and His heart and ours. He changes it from "have to," in dead religion and laws, rules, and vain glory," to a "willing sacrifice," amen.

Exodus 35:21 NKJV

"Then everyone came whose heart was stirred, and everyone whose spirit was willing." That's the quickening of the Holy Spirit on flesh. That to a human, who was born self centered and in vain glory and under the devil's control, that God Almighty would come and transform that heart and will. Where now, you are a vessel of honor, you are a living sacrifice, you are more than willing. He stirs the heart. He stirs the heart, and everyone, "whose spirit was willing, they brought these offerings unto the Lord." You hear it? That's sweet. Oh, that's sweet. Say, "A willing spirit, and a willing heart." Truth. This is David. They're all about building the temple for the Lord.

First Chronicles 29:9-20 NKJV

"Then the people rejoiced, for they had offered willingly, because with a loyal heart, they had offered willingly to the Lord, and King David also rejoiced greatly." "Then the people rejoiced, for they had offered willingly, because with a loyal heart," A loyal heart to who, "God." Amen, and to His house, and to His will, and to His Kingdom, and His purposes in this now time in history, the people rejoiced. "They had offered willingly because with a loyal heart, they had offered willingly to the Lord and King David rejoiced." Of course, the King will rejoice. We love it when the people volunteer freely and are loyal and willing, yes. Verse 10, "Therefore David," Did what?" "blessed the Lord before all of the assembly. David said, Blessed are You, Lord, God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever." Verse 11, "Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty. For all that is in Heaven and in Earth is Yours. Yours is the Kingdom, O Lord, And You are exalted as head over all." Verse 12, "Both riches and honor come from you, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might. In Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all." Verse 13, "Now therefore, our God, we thank You and we praise Your glorious name. But who am I and who are my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly as this? For all things come from You and of Your own we have given You." What do we have that we've not been given? He acknowledges this. Verse 15, "For we are aliens and pilgrims before You, as were our fathers. Our days on Earth are as a shadow and without hope." Verse 16, "O Lord our God, all this abundance that we have prepared to build You a house, for Your holy name is from Your hand and is all Your own." We have been entrusted and we are giving everything to God, not just your tithes and not just your offerings. Verse 17, "I know also, my God, that You test the heart and have pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of my heart, I have willingly offered all of these things. And now with joy, I have seen Your people, who are present here to offer willingly to You." Verse 18, "O Lord, God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, our fathers keep this forever in the intent of the thoughts of the heart of Your people, and fix their heart towards You." Verse 19, "And give my son, Solomon, a loyal heart to keep Your commandments and Your testimonies and Your statutes, to do these things and to build the temple for which I have made provision." Verse 20, "Then David said to all of the assembly, "Now bless the Lord Your God." So all the assembly blessed the Lord God of their fathers, and bowed their heads and prostrated themselves before the Lord and the king." Amen. What glory! Say, "Nothing's changed." Now, He says, "Well, you're the temple of the Holy Spirit. Christ in you is the hope of glory." You know, "He lives within us, and we are the temple of the living God, the House of God, a city set on a hill."

First Peter 2:4-5 NKJV

There it is, and you can hear Heaven rejoicing. Oh Lord, everything that they had you gave them, and they're giving it willingly, joyfully. Their hearts are loyal to you, God, as servants of the Lord. Here we are hosting His presence. To this day, being called by God to host His presence, to make disciples, to go around doing good, to do His will, as one. Say, "As one." Living stones, spiritual sacrifices, a loyal heart, and thank the Lord, He has given us everything we have. What do we have that we have not been given?

Now, I'm going to read to you a prophetic word. It's in the psalmist prophetic mode.

The word of the Lord for this year that He says to our Garden is really simple, "Overcome." The Lord encourages us. "I have already provided all that you need. We will pray against weariness. You need a fresh wind. 'It's Me, 'Look up because your redemption has come. If anyone, if anyone, and yet again, if anyone could forsake Israel, it should have been Me. Yet, My love and word are, that Israel is forever. God has not forgotten His covenant with true Israel. What a living testimony of life and who God really is, faithful and true. He says, "I am." He will never leave us, fail us, nor forsake us. We walk by faith. But, He sees. We walk by faith. But, He sees. He is. He is the Word manifested and revealed, in season and out. He is the Word manifested and revealed, in season and out. He sees, He hears, He knows, and He has chosen to encompass us with His Holy Spirit, inside and out. I am not alone. You are not alone. We are not alone. He is above all things. He is in all things, through all things, upon all things. He is the rear guard. His glory guards. The glory of the Lord is His rear guard. Amen, the glory of the Lord is your rear guard. I am the glory, and I am the lifter of your head. I am all in all. Where can you go from His presence? Listen to Me, all who love Me. Listen, I have saved you to know Me, not just about Me. I saved you to reveal My heart to you and for you to give Me your whole heart. I didn't just save you to add you to a great number, in whom has no relationship with Me. I saved you to behold My glory. In My presence is fullness of joy. When we look upon the Lord, we shine. When we look upon His face, we behold His goodness, and we allow ourselves to quote, "enter in and go beyond the veil of life." See and know and hear and encounter the Almighty God and Father, Maker of Heaven and Earth. What transformation comes? Beloved, hear the loyal heart of the Father towards you. He is loyal. He is faithful and true. These are His names. I am, that I am. He says, 'I have given you My peace, and this peace passes all understanding. I always bring wholeness. That's the goal, wholeness. He who began a good work in you will complete it into the end. He always brings wholeness. This is a completion to your hearts, for all of you have ever needed or wanted. That is amazing, because He gives you the desires of your heart, truth. You cannot fail Me. Thank you, Jesus. I am in you, and you are in Me. Beloved, you must overcome. Yes, overcome. I make you brave, strong, determined, and impart My steadfastness within you. Great Holy Spirit is here now. "Oh, the glory of His presence. Give Him glory and give Him reverence." May He come close to me as never before. I will open your eyes. I will open your ears. I will open your hearts. This is My Word. Perfect love does not fail. There is no lack in My House. That is obvious. I shall always abundantly supply all of your needs, according to my riches and glory. You have given freely, only because I gave freely in order to save and heal you. This is My Word, and it is My character. Now, we must grow in strength, in faith, in order to look into My eyes and trust. Trust is going to manifest in your life now, more than ever before. Trust is going to manifest in our life, now more than ever before. I will impart to your hearts and minds and will, an anointing to be able to receive fresh revelation of trust. I am, Beloved, trust that I am. I am the great I am. Exalt Me, glorify Me, praise and adore Me. I am here, I am. Praise is your breakthrough. I shall remove veils of weariness. I shall heal hearts in My river of grace. I shall manifest My mercies. Oh, the wonder of my mercies. I shall render

swift verdicts against injustice. Eye has not seen. Yes, yet I'm imparting new sight. "Oh," you say, "If I had only been able to see, then I would have believed." Oh, blessed are those who have not seen, and yet believe. You are full of faith and righteousness. That's what God has said." Amen! Glory to God in the highest, and peace on Earth, and goodwill to men. Well, here I am. I am allowing you to come and overcome. Come to Me all who are weary and heavy burdened, I will give you rest. Overcome, you have need of endurance. You need to be strengthened. Beloved, receive My strength, not the strength of your own right arm. I am granting repentance for trying to do all in your own strength. Hallelujah. Some have given their all. Some have given small. Yes, all shall receive new strength. Amen. Now, I'm going to take you on a journey, and this is My journey of love and abundant grace, and you cannot exhaust Me. Hallelujah, I am. I am. As you meditate on My fullness, you will receive of My fullness. The truth you know and come to believe, is what is setting you free. Look up, don't be afraid, only believe. I guarantee, I will not share My glory with carnal pride or man's pride. I only behold and reveal My glory to those who are Mine. My glory is My revealed goodness. I have asked you to ask for my Shekinah glory. This is My Word, the precious face of Jesus Christ. Who can know Him? You can. Who can behold Him? You can. Who can fathom His greatness? You can. Who can overcome? You can. Oh, I am the glory, and I am the lifter of your head. Fear not, little flock, for the Father has chosen you to give the Kingdom to. The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. Repent and turn from all wicked, perverse ways, and make the way straight in hearts, minds, will, and emotion. Line upon line, precept upon precept, I will reveal My glory to you. You cannot exhaust Me. You cannot weary Me. I love you. Oh, Beloved of My heart, My eyes are upon you. You have ravished My heart with one glance of your eyes. I saw you. I see you. My eyes are always upon you. I see through you. You cannot hide from Me. All things are open to Me, all. Come away with Me. Come away with Me and see Me. You sing, 'Open the eyes of my heart, Lord. Open the eyes of my heart. I want to see you. I want to see you.' Consider the lilies of the field. Consider the birds of the air. Your heavenly Father sees them, feeds them, and clothes them.
