That's our desire as the Body, to know Him. He knows us better, but we are coming into a knowledge of Him. Once you see another essence of who He is, you're undone, and you will worship Him. You will praise Him, and you will thank Him for answering your prayer, for showing you love, for healing you, and for bringing a revelation and understanding to something that you didn't understand. But, it's all about knowing Him. You understand? He's the core. He's the center of it all. When we talk about gratitude and glory and victory, it is all found in the essence of Jesus Christ. We are God's household, beloved.

Ephesians 2:19 NASB

"So then you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household." We all understand households, and not everyone was raised in a godly household. Not everyone has been, "just born saved." Humans go through difficulties and have to overcome sin until they are born again from above. Once we're born again from above, we enter into a perfect household. It is the Household of Faith. Okay, so I know that no matter what I'm having to walk through, that the goal in life is to see the glory in the face of Christ, because He will walk with you through those things. Thank the Lord. He does not leave us alone. He does not abandon the Household of Faith. Even though He has gone back to Heaven. He said, "I'm not going to leave you alone. I'm going to give you Holy Spirit. He will be with you. He'll always be with you. He will be in you. You will not ever be alone. He will come to you. As a matter of fact, He's going to get so close, He's going to live in you. He will never fail you or forsake you. So, we're not abandoned, even though the Lord is preparing a house for us. "I go to prepare a place for you, so that where I am, you will be also." These are scriptures. Aren't you excited? Okay, I am. I want to live anticipating and looking for the glory in my Lord every day.

When you read the word and you open up the Scripture, there He is. When you open up your Bible, or when you hear the word taught or preached, there He is. Those who have been rejected, abandoned, unloved, looking for life and hope. That's the world right now that we're in, and everybody wants to be loved. That's it. Fear is dominating the world, and it's said it would increase to the end. But the love of God in the House of God will increase more and more. I have great expectancy to anticipate the glory of the Lord in the face of Christ versus the face of any adversity or troubled times, or antichrist agendas. My focus is not on adversity. My focus is not on trouble. My focus is on Christ, and Christ alone. "Christ in me, the hope of glory."

My focus is not on antichrist agendas. There is a spirit of antichrist. There is an antichrist coming one day in person. But, there is a spirit of antichrist that works in the world today, that opposes everything that has to do with God, His Kingdom, His Word, His Son and His Holy Ghost. He works, and that spirit works against the saints of God's Household to keep you and hinder you from encountering the face and the glory of God. Okay? It leaves us when you make Jesus Christ, your Lord and Savior. That's the great exchange. You say, "Oh, I didn't know I had that." Yes, because you were born in sin. The devil is against Christ. You understand? He was our father, the devil. We had his spirit, which is an antichrist spirit that opposes the grace of God. Once you're born again, you come out of his kingdom and come into light. Now you've received the Spirit of adoption. You've received the glory. It's unfolding. Isn't that beautiful? You hear it? What gratitude.

Now, if you could put Psalm 23 up for me. Most people on the planet have heard of Psalm 23 at either a church or at a funeral service. It's just the truth. I want us all to read it out loud together. Okay, let's read.

"The Lord is my shepherd. I shall not want. He makes me to lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness, for His name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death. I will fear no evil, for You are with me. Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil and my cup runs over. Surely, goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell and the house of the Lord forever."

Now just reading that you should feel the Holy Spirit. You should feel the comfort of Holy Spirit. You should feel that there's hope from the Lord of the House, the One who has gone before us. Not just to rescue us from the Earth and get us in Heaven, but to reveal to us the glory of God. To reveal His heart, and what a table He sets for those who are His. What a feast, if you would, what a delight. What a covenant to know that when you've been taken out from an antichrist system, the devil himself, and sin. To come into a place where the Lord is always and will always be your shepherd. He will always be your apostle. He will always be your pastor. He will always be your evangelist. He will always be your teacher. He will always be your prophet. You understand? He will always be your guide, helper and administrator. He will always be Lord and Husband over you. Father will not change. Jesus Christ is an exact representation of the Father. With the Holy Ghost, they are all one, amen. What a family. Gratitude, thankfulness, and victory in the House of God. To know that we are charged to, "see and know the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ." To see the glory of God and see Him every day in your own heart as you go through life. Even through difficult times, He's here.

The angels are here. They're always here. Wow, there they are. Okay. They watch over the word to perform it. They are watching over you and your household. You have been assigned Heaven's agents, angel armies. Everyone has their own body guard angel when conceived in the womb. But, the angel armies are guarding over God's Household. He's watching over the flock. The angels are watching over the flock. You see, there's no room for being alone. You're only alone if you choose to be alone, right? We're going to read a little testimony here. This is a beautiful testimony of the temple with King David and Solomon coming up. We're going to read this whole testimony. My little subtitles said, "Offerings for the Temple."

First Chronicles 29:1-20 NASB

"Then King David said to the entire assembly," all the house of Israel, "My son, Solomon, whom alone God has chosen, is still young and inexperienced, and the work is great for the temple is not for mankind, but for the Lord God. Now, with all of my ability, I have provided for the house of my God. The gold for the things of gold, the silver for the things of silver, the bronze for the things of bronze, the iron for the things of iron, wood for the things of wood, onyx stones and inlaid stones, stones of antimony and stones of various colors, and all kinds of precious stones and alabaster in abundance." Verse three, "In addition in my delight in the house of my God, the treasure I have of gold and silver, I give to the house of my God, over and above all that I have already provided for the Holy Temple, namely, three thousand talents of gold from the gold of Ophir and seven thousand talents of refined silver to overlay the walls of the buildings." Verse five, "Gold for the things of gold, and silver for the things of silver, that is for all the work done by the craftsman. 'Who then is willing to consecrate himself this day to the Lord?' Then the rulers of the father's households, the leaders of the tribes of Israel, the commanders of thousands and hundreds, with the supervisors of the King's work, offered willingly and for the service of the house of God, they gave five thousand talents and ten thousand darics of gold, ten thousand talents of silver, eighteen thousand talents of brass, a

hundred thousand talents of iron.” Verse eight, “Whoever possessed precious stones gave them to the treasury of the house of the Lord in the care of Jehiel, the Gershonite.” Verse nine, “Then the people rejoiced because they had offered so willingly, for they made their offering to the Lord wholeheartedly and King David also rejoiced greatly.” Verse ten, This is a prayer of David. So David blessed the Lord in the sight of all of the assembly. And David said, “Blessed are You, Lord, God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. Yours, Lord, is the greatness, the power, the glory, the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that is in the Heavens and on the Earth. Yours is the Dominion Lord, and you exalt yourself as head over all. Both riches and honor come from you. You rule over all, and in your hand is power and might, and it lies in your hand to make great and to strengthen everyone.” Verse thirteen, “Now therefore, our God, we thank You, and praise Your glorious name. Verse fourteen. “But who am I and who are all my people that we should be able to offer as generously as this? For all things come from You and from Your hand, we have given to You. For we are strangers before you and temporary residents, as all of our fathers were. Our days on the Earth are like a shadow, and there is no hope.” Verse sixteen, “Lord our God, all this abundance that we have provided to build You a house is for Your holy name. It is from Your hand, and everything is Yours. Since I know my God, that you put the heart to the test and delight in uprightness, I, in the integrity of my heart, have willingly offered all of these things. So now with joy, I have seen Your people who are present here, make their offerings willingly to You. Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, our fathers keep this forever in the intentions of the hearts of Your people, and direct their hearts to You. And give my son, Solomon, a perfect heart to keep your commandments, your testimonies and your statutes, and to do them all, and to build the temple for which I have made provision.’ ‘Then David said to all of the assembly, ‘now, bless the Lord Your God.’ And all the assembly, blessed the Lord, the God of their fathers. And bowed down and paid homage to the Lord and the king.”

You hear the heart of the Father? This is before Jesus Christ, who left the glory of God to become a man, and come to the Earth. God's greatest wealth is in His Son, and He chose to send Him to us. Before Christ came, this is the Spirit of God working with His chosen people, humans. A king who didn't just keep it all for himself, but he was given revelation of the glory of God. I mean, humans can only do so much. They can bring all the gold and all the silver and all the glorious things that they have on the Earth, because God gave it. They offer it to God. It's building Him a house, and it goes on and on. There's only so much you can give, but it can't outdo Heaven. This is just a mirror of who God is. Generous, yes, and perfect in all of His ways. Look at the worship. This is for the temple, for the Lord, not us. The Household of Faith is for the Lord. The Household of Faith is for the Lord. They're in the temple. They're building a temple, and they're giving it all they have, with all that they've been given from God. He acknowledges it. Every good and perfect gift comes from God above. They're acknowledging this and they're undone. Look at the enormous wealth of what God had entrusted to a Household of Faith in that hour. Look at how the Spirit of God revealed the glory here, because they themselves were willing to give it freely. It was offered willingly. All was offered willingly. Offered willingly for the service of the House of God. The people rejoice because they offered willingly. They volunteered in the day power. You understand, they gave their hearts to God. They gave generously.

Christ, the Son, comes and says, “You're My House,” and each one of us is saying to the Most High, “We offer ourselves willingly to Him.” The day you make Him Lord and Savior, you're no longer your own, truth. Okay? Now every day is a day to offer willingly, everything above and beyond that you hope, think or imagine. Everything you possess, your loved ones, everything that is yours is His. Amen. You're the Household of Faith. Now you have just entered into a Kingdom that cannot be shaken. You have just entered into a Kingdom that can never be destroyed, because Jesus is King. Amen. He bought us back. Look at the heart. Look here, the heart of worship. Hear the heart that they gave generously. They offered, “It's Your house.”

Then they said, "But God, You gave us the abundance. You gave us the abundance, so we give back to you. Here's your tithes and offerings." Correct? It's not just something you're supposed to do when you go to Church. It's of the Household of Faith. God has given us all things freely to live and enjoy, including the gifts of the Spirit. Then we give back by serving the Lord in the Household of Faith. We come back by serving the Lord, and to go complete Jesus's mission. To preach this glorious gospel, to seek the lost, to save the lost, to heal, to deliver, to cast out demons, to overcome, and to be good stewards of the planet which is our role and our responsibility. But, we know that all these things have come from God. Wow, I would like to see the movie one day. This is what it looks like. This is one story. Yet, He picked a guy that wasn't perfect, but God gave him a revelation of who He was. God gave him a revelation. The face of Christ shined on him, and he started to identify so much that we know King Jesus came from King David's bloodline. It was prophesied. Understand something here, this is a Household of Faith. There is a kingly anointing on God's house. Say, "Amen." It's not just priestly, it is kingly. We recognize as kings and priests, that this abundance has come from God, our Father, to host His glory, to steward His presence, to accomplish His will in our day.

What would happen if the rulers, the kings and the presidents and the leaders around the globe got a revelation of this? Right now, it's all theirs, truth. But, *there* comes a time when the Household of Faith will inherit all, and it's going to be far better than anything we can imagine. We sang *about* that this morning, right? David had to bless the Lord. It just overflows when you see this. David blessed the Lord in front of everybody. Yes, that's important. David said, "Blessed are you Lord, God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever and ever." It is an eternal praise. It's an eternal covenant, and he knew it. "Yours, Lord, is the greatness." You hear the praise? "Yours, Lord, is the greatness."

Every day when you're looking at Psalm 23, you jump over here and you see in this word, "Oh Lord, Yours is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty." You see, you just went up a notch. You understand? This is a kingly anointing. Jesus is King, okay? We are of a kingly household, truth. He gets all the glory. Everything comes from Him. He has given to us, and we give back to Him. He wants you. He wants your household. He wants your children and your grandchildren, and your great, great grandchildren. He wants those who are alone and have nobody. All of this is Yours, Lord. All this dominion is Yours. Yours is the dominion, Lord. Yours is the dominion, Lord. Y'all hear it, Yours is the dominion, Lord. You can have and give Him the dominion of your own soul, your own body, your temple, your house, your household, your jobs, your careers, your passions and your joys. Correct? We are of the Household of Faith. We don't just go to church. We belong to somebody, and He is good.

Somebody got revelation by the Holy Ghost, and it overflowed out of a man that didn't even have the Holy Ghost in him, yet. He wasn't even born again. Yet, he was in covenant with God, and the Spirit of Grace came to him and gave this to him. Wow, isn't that glorious? "Both riches and honor come from You, Lord. You rule over all. In your hand is power and might, and it is in your hand to make great and to strengthen everybody." Don't you need this? I need to be strengthened, do you? Yes, I need to know in whom I believe. God, we're so thankful. We say, thank you. When you start to decree these things and you pray this way every day, you don't have to wait for church. You don't have to wait for a tragedy. This is our lifestyle. Say, "Amen." This is the believers awesome inheritance, to give our God glory and praise every day. We're the Household of Faith. Notice it said the, Household of Faith. It was by faith that you believed in Jesus Christ, yes, but it's called a Household of Faith. We believe Jesus. Jesus is the Word of God. We believe the Word of God, and we are not ashamed of the gospel, amen.

If you read all of Deuteronomy, you're going to see blessings for obeying the Lord, and you're going to see curses for not obeying God. We're going to read you a part of this story. It's going

to show a result of sin, and where they didn't obey the Lord. You can read all of it at home for fun. It's pretty rough. Thank you, Jesus who fulfilled the law, yes.

Deuteronomy 28:45-47 NASB

“So all of these curses shall come upon you and pursue you and overtake you until you are destroyed, because you would not obey the Lord your God by keeping His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you, and they will become a sign and a wonder against you and your descendants forever. Since you did not serve the Lord your God, with joy and a cheerful heart in gratitude for the abundance of all things.”

Sin is willful disobedience to God. Sin is falling short, yes. Without Jesus Christ, we would still be dead in our sin and under a curse, because none of us would be able to do this, not even this Israel stubborn, rooted in rebellion and witchcraft and disobedience. Yes, no matter the signs and wonders, it's in the heart of humans to rebel against the Household of Faith. You see one little clip. “Since you did not serve the Lord your God with joy and a cheerful heart in gratitude for the abundance of all things.”

Whoa, now I'm getting to that gratitude. I'm getting to that willingness. Not only to just serve the Lord all my days, and to walk with God, but with gratitude in serving with a cheerful heart. God likes cheerful obedience. If you're a parent, you know what I mean. You tell the kids to empty the trash, and they're like... We have all been a child. We all understand this because we're born in sin. That's what it looks like with God. Here was a result of that. But the blessings overtook it because of, say, “Jesus Christ.” Now, we are blessed, amen. Say, “I am blessed and not cursed.” Say, “I'm above and not beneath. I'm the head and not the tail. I'm blessed when I come in, I'm blessed when I go out. I'm blessed in the city. I'm blessed in the field.”

You see that kind of good news is in the Household of Faith, because we believed on the only begotten Son of God, who was perfect. God supplied Jesus. God supplied the wealth. God supplied the offering. God supplied something that was better than any resource on the planet. He gave Himself. You talk about joy and gratitude. “For God so loved the world.” We say that, “He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believed would not perish but have everlasting life.” We read it, but we have to understand, “Oh the glory, in the face of Christ.” What has He really done? If you look back over here to David's prayer. “Oh, Blessed be the Lord God Almighty.” You know what I'm saying? “Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. Yours, Lord is the greatness, the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that's in the Heavens and on the Earth. Yours is the dominion, Lord. You exalt yourself as head over all.”

Christ is the Head. We are His Body. Whoo, so in the Body of Christ, some kind of glory is going to come out of the saints. It's His glory, it's His gifts, it's His goodness, it's His provision, it's His health, it's His healing, it's victory over evil. It goes on and on and on. Oh my God, You're over all. You're over the Heavens, and you're over the Earth. I mean, *David* didn't know where else to go. He gave it all he got. If there was something else out there, he would have quoted it. He's just says, “You're the Lord over all.” How much more is He not Lord over me and our household. When we pray in faith the Word of God over us, “For me and my house, we will serve the Lord.” That's a big statement. “As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.” This is Who we're talking about here. When you make Him Lord of your household, get ready. Amen, there's a blessing coming, no matter what the table of sin is like. You understand, we are called to the Lord's table, to His house, to serve Him with love and joy and gratitude of heart.”

That means, “every saint is a minister.” Every saint does, and every saint has. “To those who have, more will be given.” You will have enough abundance, right? “As you give, it'll be given

back to you. Press down, shaken together, running over in your lap.” Sounds like something we just read in Scripture. You're the one He wants. We're the ones He wants. He wants to reveal His glory to us. You see, once we receive this inheritance, then, “Oh my goodness, I'm of the Household of Faith. Of course, I'm going to go into all the world and preach the gospel. I'm going to tell everybody I can about Him. I'm going to share this good news and not be afraid of what they think about me.” Your Father is the Father of glory, and He wants to reveal Jesus to all.
