

## Title: Fullness Today

The Lord's so good to us, isn't He? We really don't have one thing to complain about if we are in Him, because "He's our all in all." Even though we go through fires and difficulties, "He is our all in all," hallelujah.

### Isaiah 53 NKJV

What a testimony of Jesus Christ on the cross and what He's done for us. This is a testimony that we know. The scripture says that, "If you believe in your heart and confess Jesus as Lord, then you shall be saved." This is a part of this. It's not just a statement. It's not just a word or a scripture that you read and just believe. There comes repentance in the heart. There comes repentance in our soul, so that we can really know what God Almighty has done. We were all born in sin. "The wages of sin is death." The scripture says, "There's none that do good, not even one," and, "We have all fallen short of the glory." God Almighty, in His goodness and grace, chose Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, to come into the world, to die for us and to bear, not just our sin, but the effects of it. Truth.

This passage identifies the fullness of our salvation. He has forgiven our sin. He says, "He has removed it as far as the east is from the west. He remembers it no more." Hallelujah, He bore our sin. He was crushed. He was bruised. He was beaten beyond human recognition. "By His stripes, we are healed." There is deliverance in what Jesus Christ did, both from evil and from ourselves, and from sin itself. There is freedom at every level. There's nothing too impossible for God. "With God, all things are possible." There is forgiveness, there is healing, spiritually, emotionally, physically, and financially. There is healing for everything in our lives. "By His stripes, we are healed." He was stripped. He was born naked. He was accursed and judged and hated, mocked and ridiculed. He was righteous in all of His ways. He did nothing. He was the Lamb, perfect in all of His ways, led to the slaughter in order to redeem us and call us His own. This is a great, great salvation. When you lay hold to the fullness of it, beyond just sin, the effects of this was, "Oh, my God, He makes me whole!" The desire is that we may be made whole, spirit, soul, body, mind, will and emotion, and that He can give us a peace that will settle our heart and our spirit. If there's torment, it will be removed from us. We will be delivered from any evil. Yes, this is the fullness of the gospel in which we preach and stand in. We know in whom we believe. This will not stop, beloved, until we go see Him face to face.

Then the journey of love opens up when we really see what we have been saved for. We really see what our son-ship, daughter-ship, family-ship, looks like, when we step into the inheritance that He died for us to have. It goes way beyond just one thing. It is a beautiful, beautiful, beautiful manifestation of the Father's love for us to make us whole. As family members and fathers and mothers, we know what we want for our family and one another and our children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. We only want to do them good. Yes, we want to save them, help them, and encourage them. Sometimes it doesn't always go real straight in the world, but there is a God who is pursuing. He will make us righteous and just, amen. I want to encourage you today in what He is saying.

### Hebrews 13:8 NKJV

He is so good to us. This is one statement that is so powerful. If we get this in us, we cannot be moved, because we're going to know in Whom we believe, and know that He is rock solid. "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever." This is something you can pray every week in your prayer, your declarations, and worship to God. Just get it out there.

“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.” Religion will disappoint you. Mankind will disappoint you. Humans will disappoint us. Have you ever heard, “Well, they’re one way, one day, and the next day, they’re somebody else. But, “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.” He is who He says He is, amen.

#### Hebrews 3:1-15 NKJV

We love you Jesus, and we are grateful people. I encourage everyone to thank Him and love Him and worship Him. We worship Him every day of the week, not just on Sunday mornings. Okay? It's our lifestyle, and He loves that. Today is the day of salvation and fullness. God is here today. He's with us tomorrow. It says “He is the same yesterday, today and forever.” We serve the God of today. He's right in the middle of your now moment. He knows everything about us. He knows exactly where we are. He knows what we're fighting against. He knows what we need. He knows where He's taking us. Unbelief is an enemy of your today when you worry about tomorrow. Okay? The Lord has called us to believe Him and His word and not to be unbelieving. Correct? “Today is the day of salvation and fullness.”

Christ is a Son over His own house. Who I am, say, “Who I am.” Okay? He is over *us*. He is Lord. He is God. He is so amazing. He's not going to let go of us. “He is the same yesterday, today and forever.” He is faithful to God who appointed Him. He is faithful to the Father. That encourages me. Jesus Christ is faithful, full of faith, and obedient. “He was obedient unto death.” Look what He went through, and He was raised. We sang about resurrection this morning. He was raised from the dead, and we have the same promise of our body being raised from the dead. We have been born again. Our spirit was dead. We were dead in our sins, and He raised us from the dead when we were born again. Our spirit was dead and dark, and God brought us back to life. Now we are one Spirit with the Living Lord. He lives in us, and He's pouring out of His Spirit into your soul, into your mind, your will and your emotions, and He is hitting your body with the glory of God. Amen. #### John 1:16-18 NKJV

How wonderful. This is so powerful. “Of His fullness we have all received.” Received, we have already received the fullness of God in Christ Jesus when we are born again. That's a mighty dominion. That's a mighty explosion of dunamis power, within our spirit, of resurrection life in our spirit. Fullness, you didn't just get a piece of Jesus. He did not just give you a tenth of glory. He came in fullness. It says, “Christ in me is the hope of glory.” Okay, He has brought me back to life. I'm new, yes. “Of His fullness, we have all received.” Yet, as a Body, there is a fullness, a completion, that He's bringing us into, amen. “Grace for grace.” Thank God for grace. He forgives us, and yet He empowers us to overcome. Grace is an empowerment to overcome. Grace is not just something where you sin, repent and get forgiveness of sin, and go back. It's not just that. That is weak. Grace is power. Grace is glory. Grace is in this fullness. That's why we go from grace to grace. We have received that fullness.

Then there is another revelation of His grace. There's another unveiling of His goodness. There's another moment of awe where we see God, and we see what He's done for us. We see all the sides and attributes of Him when we just get one glimpse of the glory. You know how undone you are when you just get one glimpse, and when you get one fresh revelation from the word. My God, what's it going to look like when you see Him face to face? That's why everybody in Heaven usually bows down, falls on the ground and worships Him. All the angels of the Lord go, “Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was, is and is to come.” This is the King. This is the Living Lord inside of us and not a dead religion, amen. “Of His fullness, we have all received and grace for grace.” Thank you, Jesus. Today is the day to worship God. We know this. This is vital for the believer. It's vital for the believer to worship God every day. You may be one of those that cranks up that radio in the car. People think you're nuts when you're

driving down the road, because you're just getting after it. You may be on your face in a quiet place giving Him all worship and glory and honor and adoration in a very still, quiet moment. Yes, either way, is high praise to Him. It's worship to Him. Today is the day to worship God.

It doesn't matter if it's even an issue that you got kind of ticked off on and hard about. Listen to Him today, because He's always giving fresh revelation. He gives us hope for the future. The future begins when? "Today, if you hear His voice." The Kingdom of Heaven is advancing in us. That is amazing.

#### Matthew 3:1-2 NKJV

John the Baptist is the forerunner, and a prophet before Christ. This is what he said, "Repent," change the way you're thinking. Turn from your wicked ways, and think and know that the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand while we're on the Earth. The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand, is near. This is the day of salvation and fullness. Right? He wants us to have His fullness today. "The fullness that you've received today." "The fullness that I've received today." Now, Heaven is pretty full, and He's the Lord of Heaven. John the Baptist said, "The Lord of Heaven is about to come, and you're going to receive His fullness." You better get ready, because Heaven is moving in. That's what He's saying. #### Matthew 4:17 NKJV

Both of them are saying, "Repent, you must be born again," right? "Repent." Change the way you're thinking. Come into alignment with the fullness of what Heaven is doing. Yes, that's why it's okay to long for Heaven, but not until our days are up and we have fulfilled all that He has written of us, amen. "Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." I have an ear to hear. Yes, "The Kingdom of Heaven has come near." How near? That near, that's pretty close. "Look up, the Kingdom of Heaven is soon approaching."

We know that there is something greater coming. You know it. You've all said it before. "Man, Heaven was in that place. Heaven came. Heaven showed up." What are you saying when you say that? You are literally saying, "Heaven is coming. Heaven showed up. Heaven manifested." When one soul comes out of hell and repents, Heaven came. When one person gets healed, Heaven came. When there is peace in the soul, Heaven came. When you get direction for your life, Heaven came. When goodness came to you, Heaven came.

It's not hell doing you good. The devil is not for us. He's against us. He's working day and night against us. But, Heaven is greater! I want to be attentive to the fullness, now, today. "Of His fullness we have all received." We read what He did, and because of what He did, I can have the fullness. That's what I'm after today, right? "If you hear His voice," okay. He gives us hope for the future, but the future begins, today. Today, when you feel Him, don't neglect Him, don't ignore Him, and don't brush Him off. Don't think, "Well, whatever." Okay, today, will launch you forward, which is what we want. Your today will launch you forward. Your today will launch you forward into the Kingdom of Heaven. "Repent, the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." It is present. It's at hand.

Oh, the day is near approaching. It's approaching, and you can feel that. You can feel that from one generation to the next. One generation imparts and gives that baton to the next in hope. Looking for the blessed hope, yes. The return and coming of the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth through Jesus Christ, amen. We want to apply the Word of God to our lives today, and it not just be somewhere in Heaven or in the future, because He meets us today. We have the Bible to read today. Today, we need the word of God today and forever, because Jesus Christ is the Word of God. "He is the same yesterday, today and forever." Hallelujah!

#### Daniel 7:27 NKJV

This is a glorious statement. There is a glory that God is going to wrap up, and every knee will bow, and every tongue shall confess that Jesus is Lord, amen. "Then the kingdom and dominion and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole Heaven shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. All dominions shall serve and obey Him." This is good news. When He came and He said, "Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand," He came to the Earth. It's right here, now. "Of His fullness He gives us, now. But, this is what's coming. "Of His fullness, He gives me, now. But, this is what's coming from one generation to the next.

We have been called to, "Heed wisdom, really live, and don't just survive," right? He spoke that very clear a few years ago. I think it was in 2020. Imagine that. He said, "Today, really live." Don't you back up, right? We are not of darkness. We once were, but no longer. We are lights that shine in the darkness, right now. We give hope and salvation to anybody that would hear and receive. We constantly, every day are open to give this light, this Kingdom of Heaven, to anybody that would listen and anybody that would hear us. We are constantly moving in hope. We are constantly walking in this great salvation from glory to glory. No matter who is around us, we have the opportunity to share a part of that story with someone. There's that testimony. "Well, as a matter of fact, I've gone through the same thing. Here is what Jesus Christ has

done for me.” That is how it spreads. You hear this? “Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.” It is right there at work, in your family, and along the way. There is the Kingdom of Heaven manifesting truth. The light is and will always be greater than darkness. We have to have a revelation of this. If He said, “Of His fullness you have received,” I've got to know how bright that light is. I've got to know, “Christ in me the hope of glory.” I've got to know how much glory is in there. You know, we just get a little peek, and it blasts us just a little bit. You're in euphoria, and you're lifted up into heavenly places with just a little glance of that glory.

He is strong. He is magnificent. Did I say it? He is magnificent? You understand this. That's why we won't settle for a “form of godliness that denies the power,” or the fullness of the Spirit. We believe in the fullness of the Spirit, and the baptism in the Holy Ghost and fire. We go from fire to fire to fire to fire. I'm not the same as when I first was baptized in the Holy Ghost, and neither are you. I hope we've grown up. Yes, say, “I'm maturing.” His glory is here and now, and within and upon His holy ones, His saints, His children, His family, and His ministers of righteousness. We just have to believe this. When you open up your heart to this, you open up your mind to this, and you open up your whole being to this. You have revelation. He just comes on in. We get revelation of the glory, now. “Lord, how are you filling me right now? What is the glory you're working in me right now? Show me your glory, Lord.” He comes to these holy ones, now. These are the saints who are going to have the Kingdom forever with the King. It starts now.

How horrible it would be if we just get it when we all get to Heaven. Like it was wasted time on the Earth, right? No, no, no, we're receiving the Kingdom now. Isn't that wonderful? Grace to grace, thank God. The light is always greater. The old is gone. New things have come. Aren't you glad? We are being transformed into His glorious image. Now, that's amazing. That's a miracle. It really is, that He would take us and transform us into His image and likeness. That is amazing. We're created in His image and likeness. But, it's that soul that's being changed. It's our will. It's our emotion. It's everything about us. Man, to be like God, that's a high call. Yes, that's a high call to have a Holy Ghost that lives inside of you. I'm just saying. Thank God He is there doing the work, because we can't do it in our own flesh, can we? We are being transformed into that glorious image. What a miracle. “It is no longer I that lives, but Christ, Who lives in me. Christ in me, the hope of glory.”

He remains the same, but we're changing, and that's something. I read it to you earlier, “Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever.” But, we're changing. Holy Ghost, He wants to heal us. He wants to heal us. He wants to heal us. We can feel His burdens and desires and His great joy. We know when He's disappointed. When you walk with God, there's a scripture that says, “Do not grieve the Holy Spirit. Do not quench the Holy Spirit,” because the Holy Spirit is the fullness. He knows all things. We know that when we don't give attention to the Spirit of grace, and when we don't give full attention to Holy Spirit, when He's working or speaking, we grieve Him. Even out of our own disobedience or arrogance or pride, you know that we can grieve Him. We can quench Him. It's like pouring water on a flame. Yes, we can hurt His feelings. Do not grieve the Spirit of God by Whom we've been set apart with. We want to be open. He's Lord, yes, He's the Lord of liberty. Truth. Do not grieve the Spirit of Truth. Don't shrink back. Okay?

We're called to walk in truth. Every day we're going about His way of doing things, correct? We're not supposed to shrink back. We're not supposed to quit. We only press forward and onward and upward into the high call of God, that fullness. Yes, we don't retreat. It's kind of a dangerous thing when Christians have a “retreat,” get it. We need to rename it. We don't want to retreat. We are more than conquerors in Christ, who died and gave Himself for us, because His love never fails. “Of His fullness we have all received.” There's revelation of the fullness.

We're growing in that. You cannot shrink back. You cannot quit. You cannot grow weary in doing good. It's not an option for the believer. You can quit and leave Him. But, I don't encourage it. Don't quit. If you're in sports, you have the coach and they are pumping you up, saying, "Don't quit." Right? "You can do it. Finish the race." Well, so does our King who says it is a race that He will finish with us, amen. Scripture says, "We are more than conquerors."

#### Romans 8:31-39 NKJV

You can read all of it at home. It's so good. Verse 31, "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who could be against us?" There it is. Okay, that's it. But, God is for me. If God is for me, who can be against me?

Verse 32, "He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all," (Isaiah, 53), "how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" Fullness, if He did not spare His own Son, if He had Him go through what He did, yes, and He did not spare Him... His whole goal is for us to come into that fullness, into the family, to be redeemed, to be brought out of sin and saved from hell, death and the grave. Yes, but there is more to it. There is a fullness from the Godhead that He knows that He has planned for us.

Verse 33, "Who shall bring a charge against God's elect?" These saints that are promised a kingdom. "Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies."

Verse 34, "Who is He who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen," Praise the Lord. "Who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us." We see the fullness of God, Jesus Christ, come into the fullness of His own call to accomplish what God wanted Him to do. To raise Him and seat Him at the right hand of God, where He has all authority, all dominion, all glory and all power over all, in all and through all. Christ is Lord of all, yes. In that place, He intercedes for us to come into the fullness, every one of us. Can you imagine? You know that's God, that's Jesus, that's the love, that's the heart of the Godhead. Holy Ghost is thinking fullness, fullness, fullness. He's not thinking lack. He's not thinking, "Well, just get by." He's not thinking retreat. He's not thinking unbelief. He's not thinking give up. He is thinking conquer, overcome, and take dominion. Truth, right here. I'm not a dominionist in theology. I don't believe we're going to get everything right and absolutely perfect for Jesus to come back. That is settled, okay? But He has given every saint a spiritual dominion, and that's the fullness that we're called to walk in now, while we're on the planet. He will prepare the way for the Lord. Yes, He will prepare the way for the Lord. His Kingdom shall come on Earth as it is in Heaven. Truth, hallelujah! Hallelujah!

Verse 35, "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?" That's a big statement. Who is able to do that? "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?"

Verse 36, "As is written: "For your sake we are killed all the day long. We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." Those who follow Christ in this world, you will have tribulation and you will be persecuted. You will be hated by all for My name's sake. Yes, because the kingdom of darkness hates you. The kingdom of darkness opposes the Kingdom of light and the Kingdom of Heaven, truth. Here He is lifting us. Is there really anything that can separate us from this fullness and this love in Christ? No, thank the Lord!

Verse 37, "Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us." Who did what? Who loved us. In all these things. You can fill in the blank. For all and in all these things, we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. The Apostle Paul wrote by the Spirit.

Verse 38-39, "For I am persuaded." He's convinced and you cannot talk him out of this. "For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus, our Lord." That is a statement that Heaven rejoices over when you pray this. When you pray this, hell is trembling, demons hate you, angels are following you, and they're bringing it to pass. We're encouraged and we're built up, because I know, that I know, that I know. I believe in Who I believe in, and I am receiving the fullness.

He didn't give us the spirit of lack, but we're growing up. When we first were saved, as for me personally, I had no idea what this meant. I was just really, really concerned that I was for sure going to Heaven. Okay, I really wanted to get rid of the fear that I had that I wasn't going to make it. The enemy has probably lied to some of you too, by doubting that salvation and asking will I really make it to Heaven. You get saved about fifty times, okay? Finally, you lay hold of this, saying, "Oh yes, Lord. We are more than conquerors. We are abounding." Say, "I am abounding, increasing, and we're taking dominion over sin." Okay, we're taking dominion over sin, all of its fruit and the effects of it, sickness, lack, poverty, and evil. Whatever that might be. We are called as the saints of light, hosting and waiting for a dominion that shall come. We are abounding, increasing, and taking dominion over the sin and its fruit.

Thank God for repentance. You and I cannot grant repentance. That is from God. Repentance is a gift from God. He gives and He grants repentance. We pray, we teach, we lead, we rebuke, we instruct, we help, we show, and we prophesy. But, I cannot grant repentance. It comes from God. I have been given authority to forgive sin. I have authority to forgive sin. I have authority to repent of sin. Isn't that glorious? But, we are not God, yes? You have to hear it. We are taking dominion over sin and all its fruit. We walk in His righteousness. He says that we are the righteousness of God, in Christ, now. He calls us His very own. Isn't that something?

Great is His faithfulness. We won't make it without Him, because He is our all in all. I love that. That's a scripture. "Christ is my all in all." Okay, He didn't leave anything out of the equation. "Christ is my all in all." I'm receiving the fullness. Every day you're shifting. I receive the fullness, Lord. I allow you to manifest. I allow you to reveal yourself. I allow you to take me into glory. I allow you to grant me repentance, and to go in those places that I don't want to give up. Yes, I allow you to bring a conviction to me, to get in the Bible and read it. I allow you to draw me near in worship. Yes, it looks like that, because He's working on us, isn't He? Amen, wake up.

Isaiah 42:1 NKJV

Isn't that something else? Grant spoke on "My servant," our bond servant, Jesus Christ, who is devoted to God to fulfill all of His Word. Yet, we are called to the same journey, yes? The same Lord in us, with us and through us in the body of Christ to serve. "Behold! My servant," Jesus Christ, "whom I uphold, My Elect One, in whom my soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him. He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles."

We know that Jesus Christ was baptized in the Holy Ghost and fire. He received the fullness. On Earth, He received the fullness of the Holy Ghost. As a man and God, He received the fullness, and from that point forward, He continued to walk in that fullness and prepared the way for us. He gave us the same salvation. Man that's glorious! We're not just going to church or doing religion. We want to know Holy Ghost. He is rejoicing over the life of Christ in us, the One that will never leave us as an orphan. I'm glad that we're not alone, and that was why we have a body of Christ. We're not supposed to walk alone. He didn't have to do it that way, but He chose to.

John 14:15-18 NKJV

This is Jesus talking before the cross. Jesus Christ, before He left, had to encourage His saints that the fullness of the Spirit was coming. He had to encourage them of His fullness He's received. He says, now of my fullness you will receive. The Holy Spirit is coming. You are not orphaned. I have to go. He will come. He knows of the fullness we must receive. Wow, wow. They are just trying to catch up with what He's saying, right? I mean, it's just what it is, "Of the fullness we have now all received." He says, "This is the Spirit of Truth." Okay, the world can't receive Him. Does it see Him? Does it know Him? But, you will know Him, because He dwells with you and will be in you, fullness. Fresh, baptism, okay? *Baptismo*, right? In the Holy Ghost and fire, which we ask for, "a fresh infilling and a fresh anointing."

When you read and abide in the Word of God, the Spirit of God is imparting to you, Heaven. He's imparting to you life. The Holy Spirit is teaching you. He'll help us in our day to day. He'll help us in what we're doing and going through on this planet, right? In the Holy Ghost and the Spirit of truth, we are not orphaned, but in the fullness therein. I don't know how He did not leap out of His skin. He is so happy to know that the Spirit of God would literally come inside of us, because at that point Jesus was with them, but He was not in them. You get it? What a promise. Jesus's fire, His zeal, His passion, His will, His desires, His plans and His call live within us. Hear it again. The fullness, and Jesus's fire, I want that. Jesus's zeal, I want that. Jesus's passion, I want that. Jesus's purpose, I want that. Jesus's will, I want that. Are y'all getting it? Jesus's desires, I want that. Jesus's plans, I want that.

You say, "Oh, but not that cross." Don't worry. We don't have to do that. He already did it, amen. Hallelujah, but He says, "Now you take up your cross daily and die, so the fullness can live in you." Hallelujah, Jesus has called us to live and to live life abundantly. He beckons us to go forward. He beckons us. He pleads with us to go on, to go forward, to succeed, to prosper, to overcome. That's Christ in you. Just as He has overcome, we will overcome. Wow, because He's in me now. Thank God, I'm not an orphan. Okay, so we have Him. Apart from Him, we know we can do absolutely nothing, and there's so much more. There's so much more to know, and the time and place is now. It's today. "My sheep hear My voice." He says it over and over again. "Attend to My words." Live in them, by them and with them, as I do with My Father.

Okay, if you're having a hard time reading the Bible, or if you never read the Bible, or if you have a hard time reading the Word and meditating it, or if you go to sleep when you read it and you can't even get there, we will pray for you. We will help you, because the Lord wants to remove that veil and that slumber, okay? Only God brings hunger, but you have to say, "Yes," right? I mean, how horrible it is that you have to make somebody read the Bible. Today there's a great falling away. The apostasy is already happening with a great falling away. People don't read the Bible. People don't believe the Bible is the Word of God. Nothing new under the sun, but it's going keep happening. It is all the more urgent while it's called today. I'm going to devote myself in reading the Word of God. Amen, hallelujah. Why? Because you love Him. Because we love Him, we attend to and abide in His words.

That's what He said. "Attend to My word," and the words that He speaks to you every day. Yes, by the Spirit of God, you know His still, small voice. He says, we'll hear it and just do it. Just do it. You say, "That's a big one." Just do it. Just do what He says, right? Amen, believe Him for big stuff. "God is not a man that He should lie." We're called to live by every word that comes from the Father. We're called to live by every word. "He's not a man that He would lie." Thank God, "He is not a man that He would lie." There are battles in the flesh, but we're one breath away from victory. Okay, there are battles in the flesh, but you're one breath away from victory. When we repent, and when we're changing the way we're thinking about something, wow, Heaven comes. He's working on these strongholds. He's working on our mindsets and that

pride. We don't know everything, beloved, I'm just saying, but the Holy Ghost does, doesn't He? Your battle is in the flesh, but it's just one breath away from victory.

### Acts 3:19

This is from Peter, I believe. He says, "Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord." "From the presence of the Lord," that's not dead religion is it? "From the very presence of the Lord." When we repent, when we turn, and when we allow the Lord to speak to us, we receive the fullness. It's like you have a child, who is five years old and you're trying to convince them that they're your child. Every day you say, "Little Sammy, you're my son, you're my son." "Little Sarah, you're my daughter, you're my daughter." Everything I have is yours. How horrible that you have to convince them every single day, "I love you, I love you. I love you." You see it? We have to believe and receive the love that God has for us as of now. I have to receive the fullness of that conviction of who I belong to. Yes, and that's where you're transformed. That's called repentance. That's called revival. That's called restoration. He said, "Be holy, as I am holy." That's a high call. Thank the Lord. He gave us a Holy Spirit. "Be holy, as your Heavenly Father is holy. Set apart for the Kingdom of Holiness." That means something in the flesh is going to die *for* a life full of joy in His presence, even now on Earth, as it is in Heaven. Remember, He said, "I am in you, and you are in Me, and we are one."

I minister to folks every single week. The strongholds are great and the unbelief is great. It can be the smallest area where they just haven't received revelation of that yet. Then, once the veil is removed, and they eat that word, they eat that bread, they drink that blood, that wine, they receive that word, and life comes. Fullness comes, and it delivers their soul. Yes, fullness comes in, right there. Fullness, say, "Fullness."

You have to know that everything you do for others matters. If you are a mama teaching your daughter in law how to do the books, it matters. Everything we set our hands to do matters, because we're bringing the Kingdom of Heaven to Earth. We are operating out of the fullness of God, together. That's amazing. Yes, we are operating out of the fullness of God. He did not shrink back. Thank you, Jesus. When we repent and turn from our flesh and wicked ways that don't line up with the Father's glory, truth will manifest. His presence is so glorious. That's a manifest presence of God.

You know how good you feel when you have confessed a weakness to God, and then you receive forgiveness, right? Truth, it's just like wind came into you. When you are scared or doubting, or you're worried about finances or your future, whatever it might be, the fullness is here, beloved. We can't over complicate this, and we can't reject His words. He said, "All these words are His, and His words will always prosper us if we allow Him to have the dominion here." This is the place of dominion. Say, right here. Okay, right here. This is the place of dominion. He wants that lordship. He will restore, He'll heal us, and we will rise above and see Him like never before. It always starts with Him. He's so good to us.

### I Corinthians 6:14 NKJV

It says, "God both raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by His power." Do y'all believe that? I do. We would have no hope if we didn't believe in the resurrection. Correct? Yet it starts today. "God raised up the Lord, and He will raise us up by His power."

Let's stand and acknowledge this fullness and pray and honor His word.

"Father, we admit it. We admit it, Lord. We repent for all doubt and unbelief and of not understanding that we have received of your fullness, the Spirit of Truth, within us. Lord, you have not orphaned us. We thank you for taking us from glory to glory. We receive your words,

Lord, today. Today is the day of this great and awesome salvation. We receive the Kingdom of Heaven. We receive your exhortation. Today, we receive life and life more abundantly. Renew our minds. Lord, your blood has certainly paid the price, and we receive your power. We receive Holy Ghost within us. We ask that you will continue to fill us over and over. Bring us into revelation knowledge of who you really are, Lord. We bless our brother today as he's baptized in water and confesses you as Christ and Lord of all, as a new creation. We celebrate with Heaven in Jesus' name, amen. Amen.
