John 4:24 NKJV

"God is Spirit, and those who worship Him, must worship in spirit and truth."

*"God is Spirit, and those who worship Him, say, "That is me." Okay, "Those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth." This is all about giving Him the highest place. He should be first in our hearts. "Those who worship Him," it's not just about going to church to sing songs and praise and worship Him. It's from the heart. Worship comes from the heart. "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him, must worship in spirit and truth." We worship in the spirit with Holy Spirit and truth. It's sincere. Christianity sometimes calls it, "lip service." You know, you're just singing the song, or you can get wrapped up in the high praise on your radio. Yet, really, nothing is coming from your heart. Nothing is flowing out of your spirit man, correct? God's always looking at the heart. He is always drawing us into that place. "God is Spirit," okay, capital S. He is Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the One that enables us to worship God. John 8:32 NKJV

This is a very simple statement Jesus made. He says, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life. He says, "You shall know the

truth.” Covenant people, “*You shall know the truth.*” That is intimate. That is a place of worship. That is a place of encounter. “*You shall know the truth and the truth,*” that you're encountering, and that you know, “*shall make you free.*” Once we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, that is the greatest encounter of all. Once we make Him Lord and Savior, that right there, saved us, healed us, delivered us, made us free, right? There is nothing greater than being born again from above. We were dead, beloved, dead in our sin. He made us alive in Christ. Worship Him, because we are His, now. We belong to Him, now. He could demand our worship. But instead, the Holy Ghost leads us into this place. The Holy Ghost is the One. He is truth. He leads us into all truth. Okay, He is leading me to into all truth. He leads me into all truth. The truth that I know is making me free. “*You shall know the truth, and the truth that you know shall make you free.*” Because when you're in bondage, you don't know freedom yet.

But, when you start to worship the Lord in spirit and truth, He begins the process of liberty, layer after layer, deep after deep, depth after depth, right? He knows *us* from down to our toenails, up to the very hair on our head. He knows every hair on our head. He knows everything. Yes, and we have to see this. This is a holy God. He wants us to encounter fresh truth. He wants us to encounter Him. He doesn't want us just to hear about Him. He doesn't want us just to know about Him. He wants us to know Him. That will never change. All of us know Him better today, in a more real way, than we did when we first were saved. It's just the truth. We've all grown. Say, “I've grown.” It's the truth. You have been encountering the Lord from the moment you made Him lord and master. You have been encountering Him every day.

If you shift the way you're thinking, you wake up in the morning and say, “All right, Lord, you and me together, forever. Yes, “Encounter me today, and show me your glory.” The Lord will never disappoint us. Hope does not disappoint. Remember, we've been talking on this. “Hope sees.” Hope says, “Yes.” Hope is welling up. Hope will not disappoint us if you take a chance. You go, “Okay, God, I'm going to put all my hope in you. I want to encounter you. I choose to worship you in spirit and truth. I choose to align with your heart. I want to know the truth. It doesn't matter what part of my journey or my soul it *concerns*. I want to know the truth.” Then the truth is right there. It's not hidden from us. We have the Bible, okay? “*Thy word is truth.*” But, we have to be willing to embrace that. It's not under condemnation. It's under liberty. It's about encounter. When you encounter the truth, it's like you're born again, again, right? You're alive. You're fresh, and you're flourishing. Remember, we don't want to be dead and stale. We sure don't want to do something just because we're supposed to, right?

The Lord encourages all of us. “*This is the day that I will develop within you a new vision of My Spirit.*” Okay, He is encouraging us. This is the day, say, “today.” Okay, there is a song, “This is the day that the Lord has made.” It is from scripture. “*This is the day that the Lord has made. I will be glad and rejoice in it.*” That is what it looks like. The Lord says, “*Today is the day.*” Today is the day, and fifty years from now, if we're still here on the planet, He says, “*Today is the day for fresh encounter in truth.*” When He brings truth to us, Holy Ghost is the One, because He leads us in this worship. He leads us into that truth. He draws us to that truth. Maybe you knew five points of that truth, right? But there was one you weren't too sure about. That one thing right there He will work on to bring us into revelation knowledge of Him. I can know about Him all day, but I want to know Him. We are all growing up and all knowing Him. Hallelujah.

“*This is the day which I shall develop within you, a new vision of My Spirit.*” When He says, vision, two things work. Vision is where I just saw a vision of such and such, in an “open eyed,” or “inside,” of our spirit man, we saw something. By God's grace, we saw something, correct? I can have a vision of the mountains any day, right? You find yourself there. No matter what vision, He is talking about Himself. He is going to develop in us, “*A new vision of My Spirit.*” Vision is not only something you see, perceive, look into and can go towards. But true vision is

something of the Spirit that He will manifest, impart and reveal. *'Without vision, we perish.'* Okay? Everybody knows this. Even in the marketplace and the workplace, you have to have vision. *"You have to have vision,"* the scripture says, *"or you will perish."* You will die if you do not have vision. God, is a visionary. He is always bringing vision. That is not just to those who are in the five fold ministry leading or those who own their own business. It is to every saint. Every saint, from the eldest to the youngest, is a minister. God can impart vision.

Do y'all remember the story of Samuel in the Bible? It's in the book of Samuel, and he is with Eli in the temple. God had a call on Samuel, who was one day going to grow up to be the Prophet, Samuel. In my estimation, he is off the charts. No word of his fell to the ground. Everything he did and said that God told him, came to pass. Every single thing that God said. I mean, he was "bad to the bone," amen. He wasn't a wimp. He was war like. He was something else. Y'all can read all about Samuel for fun. But, I'm just saying, that guy had vision. He was called. That was the Spirit of God, encountering you as a child. Yes, that was the Spirit of God, drawing you as a child.

It's the truth. He is always giving us vision and understanding. He is leading us to God all the days of our life. He is giving us fresh vision. I need new vision. We need new vision of His Spirit. I say, "Yes sir." What am I going to tell Him? "Yeah, we have enough." Oh no, that is not a good thing to say. But, "Yes." He says, *"I see all things that pertain to you."* Now, you have to individualize this. He says, *"I see."* That is visionary. He can also see, *"in the flesh."* *"I see all things that pertain to you, everything and all things."* Say, *"all things."* God says, *"I know all things that pertain to you."* He doesn't just see it. He knows it. He knows it, because He knows us. He knows us. He is our God. He is our Father. He is our Lord. He knows us. The Spirit of truth knows us. He says, *"I hear what your heart longs to see, hear and know."* That went a little deeper. This is the day that He said, *"He will develop within us a new vision of His Spirit. I see all the things that pertain to you. Everything, I know all the things that pertain to you. I hear what your heart longs to see, hear and know."* Say, "Thank you, Lord." If you will just meditate on that and think about that throughout the day. You say, "God is for me. He is with me. He loves me. He is working for my good. He is imparting to me life every single day. He is delighted in us." Amen. This is the day. Thank you, Lord.

II Peter 1:2-4 NKJV

"Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus, our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises that through these you would be partakers of a divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."

This is so loaded. All right, Church, *"Grace and peace to you."* Now, *"Grace and peace, God's grace and His shalom peace, His wholeness, be multiplied to you, Church."* Do you see overflow multiplied to you? He has not given us leftovers. He is not being stingy. Okay, *"Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God."* To know God, *"Grace and peace be multiplied."* You can know God, and *"Grace and peace be multiplied to you."* You can know God, because this God, *"knows everything that pertains to you. He sees it, He hears it, He*

knows it. He knows everything that we long for, we long to see, we long to hear.” Every good and perfect gift comes from the God above. What goodness is in us, is because God put it there. He knows these things. *“Grace and peace be multiplied to you, (me), in the knowledge of God and of Jesus Christ, our Lord.”* Here's God, the Father, and Jesus Christ and His divine power. This is bringing in Holy Spirit, and His divine power. Notice, He said, “divine,” that is God, Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Yes, oh, my goodness, *“Grace and peace be multiplied to us to know God, to know Jesus, to know Holy Ghost and divine power.”* His divine power, not my strength. *“His divine power has given to us all things that pertains to this life and godliness.”* His divine power has given me everything according to life and godliness. That is walking in this life with God. Godliness means, “aspects, attributes, and fruit of walking with God.” The fruit of the Spirit is love, peace, patience, goodness, kindness, gentleness, faithfulness, self control, correct? That good stuff that the flesh cannot produce. You know it's truth. Only by divine power can we receive these attributes and these empowerments and the fruit of His Spirit. “Through the knowledge of Him, Christ, who called us by His glory and virtue.”

Christ Jesus called us, *“by His own glory and virtue.”* Christ Jesus called us out of His goodness, out of the glory, out of His heart. He knows everything that pertains to us. He sees everything that pertains to us. He hears what our hearts long for. He knows where we're missing it. He knows where we're falling short. He knows our next step in our journey, because it is a journey, okay? It is a journey, and as long as we're alive on the planet, we're still on the journey with Him, correct? So, just know that this is a powerful prayer and statement. This is the introduction here, *“by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises that through these you can partake of a divine nature.”* Through His precious promises, He wants us to partake of the divine nature. *“He knows everything that pertains to us.”* He wants us to partake, join with, eat, participate, have, receive His divine nature, His divine nature. This is God's nature, His way of doing things.

Because the way of the flesh doing things is always opposite. His divine nature leads us into more godliness, *“having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.”* That is the life of sin in the world, correct? All you get is what's through the eye gate, all right? You lust after this. The lust of the flesh, the lust of the pride of life, and all that according to First John, right? But in God, there is encounter in God, and there is truth in God. *“He has given us divine power in all things that pertain to life and godliness.”* I have divine power. I don't just have knowledge. I have divine power. I have Holy Spirit. The One I am going to worship in spirit and in truth. The One that is going to show me the truth. The truth that I know is going to set me free. That is why you go around the tree a few times. You go around the block a few times, because He is working, working, working, until you get it. Once you get it, you're like, “Oh, now I understand. Now I see. Now I hear. Now I know. Now I believe that. Now I stand here,” yes?

Whatever part of His heart He revealed to you, if it's provision, if it's financial, or if it's spiritual, no matter what it may pertain to, He wants us to have a fresh encounter with truth. *“This is the day which I shall develop within you a new vision of My Spirit. I see all things that pertain to you. I know all things that pertain to you. I hear what your heart longs to see, hear and know.”* He is saying, *“Yes and amen.”* *“I've given you a divine nature, and I am working overtime. All of us are working overtime to see you come in to receive this.”*

Revelation 3:20 NKJV

Christ says, *“Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him and he with Me.”*

What a sweet invitation. Yes, you know what it's like. You're invited, and you say, "Yes, I'll come." Okay? He stands at the door of our heart, and He knocks. When you hear His voice, He says, "*Don't harden your hearts, but open them.*" Say, "Yes, Lord."

When the priest had to tell Samuel, "This is God talking. Here is what you are going to say. Here I am, Lord." Get the point? Well, "Here I am, Lord, I'm hearing you speak something to me." The divine nature of God is speaking something to me. God Almighty is speaking something to us. Can you imagine humans redeemed from hell, sin, death, rebellion against God, in our own ungodliness? Now, He chooses to allow us to encounter the truth, to encounter Him, to worship Him, and to know Him. I mean, what grace, right? This is not just going to church because you have to. This is divine relationship. He says, "*I'm standing at the door of your heart and I'm knocking.*" That wasn't just when you were saved. It's like, "How can that be? *He is Christ in me, the hope of glory.* He lives in me. Why is He knocking again?" He is knocking and saying, "Come away," (knock, knock), "Come away," (knock, knock), over and over again." Right? It looks like that. You say, "Somebody's knocking at the door of my heart." He just waits until you understand. "Oh, my Lord is drawing me, so, "Here I am, Lord. Speak Lord." When He speaks, don't despise it. Don't discredit it. Don't say, "Well, that is too much." Or, "You want me to do what?" "You want me to go, where?" Or, "You want me to repent of what? You want to baptize me in who? You want to give me more?" Because the flesh is always growing to receive from an almighty God, amen. "*His divine power has given us all things that pertains to life and godliness.*" Walking with Him, yes? When He is knocking, I'm going to answer.

He says, "*Do not shrink back in fear.*" He always has to address fear first, and usually, it's against yourself. You're thinking, "Oh no, Lord, I could never do that. I don't know this. I don't know that much, yet. Why would you be speaking to me, or giving me a vision right now, or a prophecy or a word for somebody? I just got saved." Well, as soon as you entered into the Kingdom of Heaven, His divine nature is already bringing you in to the Spirit of Truth. Why would I want to love God, praise God, worship God, or get a banner out, and shout and praise? Why? Because, His divine nature has been imparted to us. All of a sudden, we're being transformed from the inside out. Intimidation and fear is the number one thing that knocks the feet out from underneath us. Because you say, "Oh Lord, not me. I can't." But He says, "*I chose you. Actually, I'm going to tell you great and mighty things that you don't even know yet. Do not shrink back in fear.*" I know when that is hitting me. I know when it's hit me. So, I'm encouraged and seasoned enough to know to go onward, upward, high, yes! That is my response. Now you may feel that *fear* at first, but then you say, "Yes," and you hold on to *Him*. Say, "Hold on."

He says, "*Develop your inner strength with Me, not without Me.*" Okay, "*Develop your inner strength with Me, not without Me.*" You know what that means? When you're just trying to do it, because you're supposed to. The Bible study reading plan, where you're supposed to be reading your Bible every day, right? You're a Christian, right? You're a leader. You really need to be reading your Bible. He says, "*Develop your inner strength with Me, not without Me.*" He wants to give us strength in all things. Yes, He lives in me. He is the one that causes the growth. He says, "*You cannot do anything apart from me that will bear fruit, that I plan for you to produce.*" We know that, "*Abide in Me. Remain in Me, and in My word, and you will bear much fruit.*" That is the life of the Kingdom for every believer. We know this. Remember, as long as the Earth remains, there will always be fruit and growth that leads to life as long as we're on the planet. Then when we leave the planet, it's still happening on the planet, until God says, "*We are going to change some things up.*"

Everything that is alive and remains on the Earth has an opportunity to produce life. *“Choose you this day, whom you will serve, life or death,”* correct? We choose life. Say, “I choose life.” Death didn't do us too much good. There will always be fruit and growth that leads to life. Always, that is the divine nature. Even mature Christians can be content and satisfied with where they are. “I'm content. I'm satisfied. I know God. I'm blessed.” Yes, we sang all about that. I'm so blessed. It can be over done as Christians. “He is blessed. Be blessed. I'm just blessed,” right? But, we are receiving.

He said, *“We are receiving from the Spirit of Truth, revelation knowledge of divine encounter with Him, and new vision.”* You keep growing, growing, growing, but the Lord is causing that growth. I want to be positioned to always let Him do that in me, correct? Okay, there's always going to be fruit bearing. There's always going to be growth. Always, say, “Always.” That is like having an eternal garden in your backyard. It never dies. It's really bearing fruit and vegetables and it never dies. It's like having a dog or a cat that never die. Maybe a famous tree that you love so much and it never dies. God's fruit never dies in us, you understand? His word never dies. He does not decrease. He is only about increase. That is the blessing of the Lord. That is divine nature.

He says, *“Today, I'm developing within you a new vision of My Spirit.”* We want fresh encounters with truth. Amen. *“Today is a new day for many, and as you begin to see with new eyes and hear with new ears, what my Spirit will speak to your heart. I have a new season for you that is wonderful. The old season is over. New things have come.”* Yes, the old is gone, but you're still reaping fruit from the old. That doesn't mean all this up to now is gone and just over. No, no. He just builds on it. Yes. The old is gone, but you are still reaping from the old fruit from one day to another, one week to another, one month to another, from one year to another. You see, I'm always increasing. That is God. That is the increase of His government. It has no end. *“My government is one of increase. It has no decrease.”*

When you know that about God, you're thinking, “Okay, I guess I'm growing up. I'm be being filled. There's so much more of God to know.” When you feel that knocking, or you hear that stirring, you better jump in, because He is right there waiting on you. He is right there waiting on us. Yes! We want to encounter truth, and it's daily abiding. When He tells us truth, you say, “Wow, that is a hard way.” It's truth, and *“The truth that you know will set you free,”* correct? I don't want to hear lies right? That just puts me in bondage. I don't want to obey lies. I don't want to follow what the lies say. I want to know the truth, and the truth that I know sets me free. It's always about freedom, always about increase and new life, because that divine power is working in me, in everything that pertains to life and godliness.”

1 Samuel 12:24 NKJV

“Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth with all your heart. For consider what great things He has done for you.”

See, it's always about the heart. *“For consider what great things He has done for you.”* That is looking back and seeing the testimony. “This is what God has done for me.” There is the book of remembrance. That is the joy of where we've come from, but He puts fear of the Lord first. Fear the Lord first if we don't have the fear of the Lord. We have to be in line with that, and that will be with us to the end. Remember, Jesus' greatest delight was in the fear of the Lord.

Isaiah 11:3 NKJV

He wants us to come up into Him. He wants us. He wants to lead us upward. Yes, He wants us to let Him level us up. He wants us to rise up, correct? He wants us to come into the fullness. He doesn't want us down here lacking. He wants to fill us up. Y'all getting it?

Deuteronomy 32:4 NKJV

This is beautiful. It says, *"He is the Rock, His work is perfect. For all His ways are justice. A God of truth and without injustice. Righteous and upright is He."*

Now, that is a mouthful. *"God is Spirit. Those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and truth, the truth that I know is making me free."* He says, *"He is the Rock. His work is perfect. All His ways are justice. He is a God of truth. A God who is Truth. Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Truth. He is perfect justice, no injustice. He is always right."*

You say, "Oh man, I missed it." Yeah, you missed it, but God didn't. God is always right. God wins every time. He is always right. Period and end of discussion. Whatever His word says, that is it. That is where the fear of the Lord is. The fear of the Lord is you saying, "I'm going to make a choice to go in the flesh here, but my spirit says, "Better obey God." Okay, follow this, because this will prosper you, right? This will bless you. He is showing us these things. *"His divine nature is raising us up in everything that leads to life and godliness. It's a new day, amen!" Don't shrink back. "Righteous and upright is He."*

I love these verses. It's good to pray these things. It's good to bless His name in these things. It's good to just worship Him for this, especially when you're going through a rough spell. He says, *"Each one of you, My children, shall encounter Me in an entirely new way."* Now that should be us saying, "Pick me, pick me!" Right? If I did an altar call and said, "God's coming, and He is up here, right now, "Come, come, come." I'm pretty sure everybody is going to get up here. We have to have that attitude every day. Yes, He wants to encounter us in truth every day. He says, *"Each one of you, My children, shall encounter Me in an entirely new way."* Now, don't try to figure it out. That is what we do first. You think, "Well, it's probably going to happen like this." No, just say, "Here I am, Lord. Speak, Lord. Your will be done, Lord. You're speaking a fresh encounter. Yes, I want that. We need that."

"My children shall encounter Me in an entirely, "new way." The highlight is on, "new way." *"Are you willing to allow Me to reveal Myself to you?"* Oh, there's the will. You can say it all day. You can say it all day, but then something's going to happen in that process. Will you yield that heart and your time and your presence and your person to agree and receive in your heart? He wants to reveal Himself to us in a beautiful, new way. Amen.

Psalms 25:5 NKJV

"Lead me in your truth and teach me. For you are the God of my salvation. On you I wait all the day."

That is a daily abiding. I am expectant. God is speaking to me. He is changing me. He is healing me. He is delivering me. He is showing me great and mighty things. I'm growing in the Word. I'm receiving fresh revelation. Okay, "Lord, lead me in your truth. Teach me." If we come in like this and read something thinking, "Oh, yes, I already know that." We missed it! We can

miss it if we just go to Psalm 23, which most of you can probably quote, "The Lord is my shepherd." Right there, you can note that. Then there comes an encounter with this, and it's fresh every single day. **"The Lord is My Shepherd. I shall not want. He leads me beside still waters and in green pastures. Yes, His rod and His staff they do comfort me."** Okay, it does not matter what aspect. I just picked one chapter, and one verse that is very familiar to all. Yes, we have to understand. He is leading me in truth. He is teaching me. The Shepherd has highlighted this to me. He is teaching me. He is knocking at the door. "Behold, open the door of your heart. I want to come in. I want to you. I want you to encounter me in a fresh, new way."

That is what we want, fresh encounter, fresh revelation. Yes, *"You are the God of my salvation. On You I wait all the day."* If you have all day, go for it. If you have to go to work, but then in your heart you are meditating. Yes, you're aware. You know, have lots of potty breaks. Maybe you go into the lunch room. Maybe take a few extra moments.
