Title: God Is Greater

How blessed are we to be able to hear the Spirit. Seeing what He is saying and hearing what He is saying. Hallelujah.

Genesis 8:22 NKJV

This is a promise. This is one of the things that God has said and it's beautiful. This is a covenant, basically, that He has made with creation. God said this, "While the Earth remains, seed time and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease." Praise the Lord, "while the Earth remains." That is an eternal promise for our planet. On the Earth you have seed time and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night. This life, very strategically spoken by God, *has* seed time, sowing and reaping. "Seed time and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease." Everything revolves around the cycles, the harvest and the sowing, from the morning to the evening. Constant, constant, constant, you understand? From season to season, God is constant.

This is a powerful verse. I pray this verse every day when I walk. I decree this because, there are shakings and crazy stuff going on the planet with droughts, famines, floods, this and that. But, the bottom line is this, and is backed by His eternal Word. If God would say, "While the Earth remains, seed time and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease." You know that this is an encouragement. Jesus taught us about how faithful He is. Jesus is called Faithful and True, the exact representation of the Father. "If you see Me, you see the Father." Correct? I just want to leave that with you. 1 John 4:1-4 NASB

"Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God."

That's clear. If you're for Me, you're for Me. If you're against Me, you're against Me. Jesus is Christ, isn't He?

- 2) *"By this you will know the Spirit of God. Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God.*
- 3) *"And every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming, and now it is already in the world.*
- 4) *"You are from God, little children, and have overcome them, because greater is He who is in you than He who is in the world.*
- 5) *"They are from the world. Therefore they speak as from the world, and the world listens to them.*
- 6) *"We are from God. The one who knows God listens to us. The one who is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the Spirit of Truth and the spirit of error."*

"We know by the Spirit of God, that every spirit that confesses Jesus has come in the flesh is from God. If not so, it's from the spirit of antichrist." Okay? "You are from God, little children." You have overcome them. You have overcome the world, through the Blood of the Lamb. You've overcome Satan by the Blood of the Lamb. Amen, "Because greater is He who is in you, than he who is in the world." We believe God is greater. Sometimes it takes a journey for us to really get this, and we really lay hold of this. Saying, "No, God is greater." God is greater. Right? God is greater. "God is great and greatly to be praised." I'm not of the world. I'm not of an antichrist system. I have the Spirit of Truth. I don't have the spirit of error. "We are from God, and he who knows God listens to us." Those that know God will listen. If we know God, we're listening to Him, "Yes!" The Spirit of Truth and the Saints know God. Others will listen to us, because we know God. "But, those in the world are of antichrist, and they will not listen." That's your battle, the Spirit of Truth and the spirit of error. You hear it? Jesus is King.

1 John 5:1-4 NASB

"Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God," say, "I've been born of God," and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him.

- 2) *"By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments.*
- 3) *"For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. His commandments are not a burden." 'Oh, I have to obey God.' "They are not burdensome.*
- 4) *"For whatever is born of God overcomes the world." Did He just say that whatever is born of God overcomes the world? "And this is the victory that has overcome the world,"—our faith.*
- 5) *"Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God." Truth.*

Now you can read all of First John. It's just loaded. But, the Spirit draws attention to this. *"You are from God, little children. You have overcome the antichrist system, peoples and those enslaved and still in error, because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world."* We walk in the Spirit of Truth. There's no confusion in the Spirit of Truth, which is Holy Spirit. Whenever you get confused, you know that the spirit of it comes from error. That's where confusion comes from. Okay? It just spins around and it makes you confused, because you're looking for truth. You're looking for the right way. You're looking for the right response. You're looking and believing for something that only God can do, and it's only found in the Spirit of Truth. Error will not get us there. Amen. Antichrist certainly doesn't want us to lay hold of it.

We believe Jesus, and we are born of God. Whoever is born of God overcomes the world. Here is your singular focus. Just think of this incredible focus. I remember in elementary school when we were doing experiments with magnifying glasses. The sun had to come through it, and it had to focus on a target, so it could burn it. Did anybody do that besides me? That's

what it looks like. Light comes from the sun through that glass, and it is focused. When the sun light is magnified, what's going to happen? There is going to be a burn, okay? Think of that focus right now. We're supposed to have an incredible focus. We are not supposed to be disoriented. We're not supposed to be confused or fragmented in our minds. We're to have purpose, hope and be confident in this.

We're going to read some powerful, powerful testimonies. May we hear what the Spirit is telling us today. Say, "I am of God, I yield to the Spirit of truth, and I have great focus."

Luke 7:1-10 NKJV

This is a marvelous testimony of a heathen Gentile recognizing the authority of the Word of God. He says, "*Say the word.*" He knew he wasn't worthy, but said, "*I know if you say the word, it'll be done.*" That's the faith that you see in Genesis. "This is My covenant. This is My word. This is the Way of the Lord. This is the Spirit of Truth." This man laid hold of the Lord of the promise in this passage. This is where we find great faith. Where he didn't even have to see Him get there to do it. He just said, "*Say the word and it will be done.*" It happened just as he asked for, amen.

Luke 7:11-17 NKJV

Oh, wow. "*It happened the day after He went to this other city.*" There was a funeral procession with a mama, her son, the family and the friends. "*Jesus was moved with compassion on her.*" He had compassion on her, not the dead son. He had compassion on her. That is God. This is resurrection life. God is greater still. In that moment, God, through Jesus Christ, is moved with compassion, sovereignly towards this widow, this mama. Sovereignly, the Creator God is about to move in resurrection power to come and raise the son. He speaks, "*Young man, I say to you, arise.*" The centurion recognized, "*You just say the word and it will be done.*" Now, Jesus continues to demonstrate that out of His compassion, He's moved to dead things. If there's no hope, He's moved to us, who are all born in sin, and dead in our sins.

Scripture says, "*We were dead in our sins, and He was moved compassion in His resurrection life to come and save us,*" correct? Only Jesus, in the Spirit of Truth, can make things live. God is so great. God is so great. There are a lot of dead things around us. There has been a lot of death and dying. But, Jesus has moved with compassion to whom it is affecting. His war is not with death. He already conquered it. His war is coming towards the peoples, for them to believe Him, to look to Him, and to come out from antichrist and error and receive the Spirit of Truth, of which He is. The greatest revival is resurrection. One day, all of us will get to encounter this, whether we're caught up to the Lord in the air or whether we actually go to sleep. One day, all of us will receive resurrected bodies. That's what the Scripture says, hallelujah!

The greatest revival is resurrection. Would you say, "Yes?" I had a resurrection service. But that is the ultimate. That's the end game, alright? Jesus said, "*I am the resurrection and the life.*" The greatest revival is resurrection. Yet, Jesus was doing that prior to the cross. Then He gave His disciples authority to go raise the dead. It continued on. As a matter of fact, He heals them. He heals them of whatever infirmities they have. He heals the sick, so that they don't die. Right? He's right there. "*As long as the Earth remains, seed time and harvest, cold and heat, night and day.*" You understand, there is something backing every word He says. He is a covenant keeping God. We understand that's where we're headed, but we have to receive and know resurrection power, now. Amen. When people encounter Jesus Christ, there's such a transformation, that it literally affects every aspect of our life as soon as we encounter Him. Notice I said, encounter. That's a big word. We pray that, Lord, we would encounter You. When this funeral is going down, that mama and her dead son encountered Jesus. He came to them. There was an encounter. Somebody woke up. It takes an encounter. When people

encounter Jesus Christ, there is such transformation that it affects every aspect of their life. That's why, I won't say all, but most of us might have attended church for years. Then we had an encounter with Jesus Christ and everything changes. Truth. People in the world always try to battle through their flesh. That's all they have. People in the world always try to battle through their flesh, the world system and the world's way of doing things.

I John 4:4 NKJV

"Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world." This is the resurrected King, who is looking upon everything that is dead with compassion, because there is hope. As long as there is an Earth and there is a Word on the planet, there is a hope. People in the world are trying to battle, in the flesh, the world system and the world's ways of doing things. But, only the Kingdom of Heaven can bring the transformation through faith in Jesus Christ. That's where everything begins. By faith, we believe. They are trying to fight all these areas, all these strongholds, these battles, these wounds, these traumas, this unbelief system, false ideologies and all these evil things with their own mind, will and strength. Yet, they are subjected in, with, and to the spirit of antichrist.

They are against the Anointed One, in His anointing, great Holy Ghost, and the Spirit of truth. They can only operate in error and are constantly looking for ways to be great. But, God says, *"Beloved, I have made you great because the Greater One lives in you."* Amen. Transformation can only come through Jesus Christ. You see what we're battling against? You know that they cannot come into the full truth without Christ. There is no other way. No one can come into the full truth without Christ, period. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. Correct? He has told us that knowing this is reality. It's a reality. It's not just a teaching. Okay, this is a reality. This is real. We must understand why we labor with God's family to know, "Christ in you." That Christ would be formed in you, and that Christ would be fashioned in you.

There is that focus, because there is transformation at hand. There is resurrection power at hand when the Saints minister to one another, and as you pastor, as you shepherd, as you care for, as you teach, as you instruct, and as you raise your families in Christ. This is the whole goal. We must understand why we labor like this. What is in us to make us labor for God's family? What is in us? What drives us? What compels us? What compels us to know that Christ, the Anointed One, is real and must be formed in you? Transformation, "Christ must be formed in you. Christ must be formed in you. Christ must be formed in you." There is that focus. There is that drive. There is that zeal on fire. Once you are saved, you come out of that world of darkness. You are not in it anymore. You live on the planet, but you are not in the world of darkness. Hallelujah!

Everything that remains in the world will torment the righteous soul, to draw you back into that. Thinking that if you go there, that will help you win your battle. There is no strength from the world, or those in the world. They give no strength. They will suck you dry, because they want to destroy you. "Satan comes to kill, steal and destroy." Christ says, *"I have come to give you life and life abundantly."* Whoo! *"You are no longer of the world, little children. You have been born from above."* Here is this Greater One that's living inside of us, wow! In the world, but not in love with it, truth. But, it is what we do, "in Christ," that wins our battles. What you do, "in Christ," is what wins our battles. We love the song, "The battle belongs to the Lord." Yes, but He's working with us. He's working towards us, in us, with us, and through us. He empowers us, and that's how we win our battle.

What we do, "in Christ." Notice I didn't say, "my flesh or without Him." Every day, that's the focus. "I'm in Him. I'm of Him. I'm from Him. He's in me." The Spirit of Truth is in me. The

Greater One is in me. *"Now, fear not little ones, I'm not of the world."* You recognize that. You feel grieved when it's a worldly thing. Correct? What we do, "in Christ," wins our battles. It's in our submission to His Word and His Holy Spirit. Notice I said, "submission." That means lordship. That means 100%. If you have a little toe in, that's not going to do it. You have to be all the way in. I have to be all the way in. Amen. The Lord says, *"I'm so fervent on you receiving the fullness of His Spirit and His Word, and you must be changed by it,"* says the Lord. He is so fervent on us receiving the fullness of His Spirit and His word. He is fervent. He burns with fire. He is the Zealous One. He is Jealous. He is Fervent.

"What else are you injecting into your body? It opposes the Creator and the Spirit of the Living God. What do you inject into your minds, your eyes, your ears? They're an abomination against the anointing, and the Anointed One." Huh? That's what it looks like. That's the war. *"What are you eating? What are you drinking? What are you feeling? What do you see? What are you listening to?"* He says, *"Come out. You are not of the world system. Beloved. You are in truth, not error. You are not of this world. You have nothing to do with the spirit of antichrist."* Instead, He says, *"I need you to be changed by this. There is a fervency. There is a now moment. You must repent. You can't change apart from this. Humans cannot change each other."*

As much as I love everybody, I can't bring change to anybody. Only Christ in us brings change. Amen. We encourage each other. But, life transformation only comes by the Spirit of Righteousness. In Christ, life transformation only comes by the Spirit of Righteousness. The Spirit of Righteousness found in Christ, the One that walked up and had compassion on that mother and then raised the son. Amen, it was an impossible situation.

"You cannot change apart from this." You can't even be just a good person. A good person doesn't mean that you become righteous, correct? Because, that's all I knew. "Well, they're such good people." Praise the Lord for good people. But, there are a lot of good people in the world that have not yet confessed Christ as Lord. Those good people will die and go to hell unless they've been born again. You hear it? Don't be deceived. God is not mocked. He knows those who are His. You can be a good person, okay? But being a good person doesn't make you righteous. We know it's only by the blood of Christ. We must be born again through the blood of Christ. That's why all are sent out into the world. It should be every saint, not just the evangelist and missionaries. We are assigned the mission of the Great Commission of, *"Go into all the world and preach the gospel."*

Demonstrate it, pray it, do it, heal it, and seal it. Right? We go. That's our job. Amen. I can't change those good people if I don't give them the gospel, and if I don't give them the truth. I can't do it. I can't bring anybody out of darkness with just goodness. I can't and it won't work. Many, many have tried. As a good person, it doesn't mean that you become righteous. We must be born again through the blood of Christ and the confession of faith in Him. We must confess Christ. That's why you say you believe in your heart and confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and you shall be saved. Because this is in unity. That's where the Kingdom comes. He comes in the heart first, not the mouth. There's a lot of talk out there, but nothing is in the heart. You're going to know the tree by the fruit, period.

Revelation 3:5 NKJV

Jesus said this. There's more to the story. You can read it at home. "He who overcomes." These were letters to the Churches. This is a letter to the Church. *"He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments. I will not blot out your name from the Book of Life, but I will confess."* Who is confessing now? Jesus will confess, *"his name before My Father and before His angels."* What a day! You must be born again.

You know, we can't play games with God. We can't just be good. Oh, my God, this is so serious, and yet you have a whole bunch of lost people believing the lie. Right? Some people do good works and confess the works, but they can't confess Christ. They tell you all day about their good works, but they can't confess Christ, as Lord. You confess good works, but you must confess Christ if you want to be saved. Many people still try to fight all their battles out of their own flesh, and have not gotten to the only One that has won the fight once and for all for us. You know, it's like, "this is how we fight our battles." We sing it, you know, but you're not on your own. You do the best you can, but we do it with Christ.

We overcome. You know this, by the Spirit of God. *"Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God. Every spirit that does not say that is the antichrist and it has not come, it's in the world. "You are of God, little children. You have overcome them, because greater is He who's in you than he that's in the world."* I'm of God. The Greater One lives in me, the One that has compassion on the dead, that One. The One, that only One, that is the Resurrection Life that can bring us back to the Father. He did good works. He sacrificed Himself. That was His work that led to eternal life.

Many people have fought good fights in the flesh, and they don't win. They just lose without Him. They fight and fight for 50 years, whatever it may take. You may die in vain, yes? You may one day die without Christ. But, they fought. They fought, but they never laid hold of the One. They never laid hold of the Greater One. That's our job, to see that they know about the Great One. Amen. Once we get in Him, we can see where our victories are coming from. Oh, okay, wait a minute, "Christ in me." People can be lured into other ways, especially in the battlefield of the mind, because you're looking for some kind of relief. You're looking for a victory. It's the battlefield of the mind. You're looking for something that will relieve you in your distress. But, Christ showed up for the mother who was beyond distressed, coming by with a dead son. He had compassion, and He spoke to the son, "Live." You hear it? That's what our Christ can do. He hears your prayers. He sees your weeping and your mourning. He sees what you've done. You've done everything you can. Then He sees and He comes and He says, "Live, get up and walk." Right? That's our Lord. Isn't He marvelous? Amen.

We can be lured into other ways. There has to be another way. It's kind of a good way. But, yet He is the way. Humans cannot even overcome their own thoughts without Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is renewing our mind. People are looking for some kind of peace of mind. People need peace. They are literally being tormented. The only way they can get their peace is through the Lord Jesus. Here we are Saints, the "bearers of light." The ones that are empowered and anointed to bring the revelation of the Resurrected One to them. There is the compassion, because it's not you doing the deal. It's Christ in you. The focus that we have to see is Christ formed in us. Till Christ be formed in us and we believe it. We believe it, as sure as it said in Genesis. I believe that. You have to believe it, just like that. Amen.

There are those who will have deathbed salvations. I know of some. Maybe you do, too. There are those who have deathbed salvations, and they encounter true peace. They are renewed as they arrive safely to Heaven. Don't you love that? Because, somebody prayed for them their entire life. They could never get to them. They could never convince them. But somehow, Jesus Christ showed up before they went. He doesn't always use the Saints to do that. He will come. He'll send angels. He'll come. He'll come Himself to some in the grace and mercy of God. God comes before they step over into eternal fire, even that close, and they say, "yes." They are going to reap the same glory as us. There are different rewards in Heaven for our work, but they are going to reap the same great reward of salvation. Praise the Lord for deathbed salvations. It's important that you pray that. Even if you have loved ones that you're thinking, "Man, they just won't come in." You just keep praying, because Jesus may step into

the room at the end. As believers, we must know Christ and that He is all in all, with all and through all.

Galatians 3:26 NKJV

We must know Christ. We have to know, He is in all and through all, right? We have to know He's in everything. Christ with us. He never leaves us, Beloved. If you're in your journey, He doesn't step over here and leave you. Christ will never leave you, fail you or forsake you. I pray this for people every week, because they've lost hope. You understand? Okay, we have to know in whom we believe. We have to know that we know. We lay hold of the truth of this. He says, "*For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.*" That's simple. That's how you get in. There's that confession. "I believe." You become sons, family, daughters of God through faith in Christ Jesus. There is no other way. We have to know Christ, and know that He is in all, with all and through all. Okay, that's a big deal. That changes the way I'm thinking. He's always with me. He's always working for good, and the Holy Ghost is in us, the Spirit of Truth. We see the error, all right, and we see the antichrist system. We see the ungodliness and the worldliness. But, our focus is not even our mission in life in God. Our focus is Him. Our focus is God, our focus is Jesus, and our focus is Holy Ghost. Our focus is the Kingdom of Heaven. Our focus is His glory. That's it. Our focus is Him.

Ephesians 4:4-6 NKJV

That sounds like dominion to me, amen. "Oh, I'm not alone. I'm not in this battle alone." But, those who are still lost, they are alone, because even the world doesn't want to partner with them. You think they're with you. The true Church shall continue to seek God and seek His ways, His power and His Kingdom. The true Church will never stop. The true Church will seek His ways. The true Church will seek His power. The true Church will seek to His Kingdom always, all of our days.

Satan wants to keep the believer from really going there. He'll use anything. But, encountering Christ and the Holy Spirit shall bring transformation and true deliverance. Encountering Christ, I pray constantly, Lord, "encounter and reveal." "Yes!" Because that's what it's going to take, "Encountering Christ and the Holy Ghost shall bring the transformation and true deliverance. Our minds will be renewed and transformed, and we're still being renewed. Our thoughts and our patterns of thought are still being changed." I don't think the same as I did a year ago, and neither do you right? We're going from glory to glory.

We as a Church family, have to remember, "He is worth seeking His glory. He's worth it. He's worth seeking His glory, His power and His presence. He's worth the pursuit. He's worth the honor and the worship. He is worth abiding in His word. He is worth it all." We sing, "He's worthy of it all," but, "He is worth it all. He's worth it all. He has to be worth it." Is it worth it to you? As a Church family, we are seeking His glory, power, and presence. There is a pursuit with honor of our own lives. We are abiding in His Word. Where I see a tremendous lack is Saints not abiding in the word, not abiding in the words, not abiding in the messages, classes, anointings, impartations, or whatever it might be, but not abiding. Okay?

John 15 NKJV

"*Abide in Me and My word.*" Then, fruit will eventually come. Yes, that's how we grow. But, it is that focus. Because, if people want to really change, they are going to get in that word. Say, "God gives me hunger."

Matthew 6:33 NKJV

We are transformed by the Lord's anointing, and in turn, He transforms others through us. Isn't that amazing. We're being transformed by the Lord's anointing and in turn, He transforms others through us. That's just grace! My goodness, "*Christ in me, the hope of glory.*"

John 11:25 NKJV

Jesus said that in the raising of Lazarus, another resurrection. "*If you believe in Me,*" even though he was four days dead, he will live. Even if it is your journey in life and and you went and you died to yourself, there's a resurrection there. Yes, there's a resurrection there. Because when we die to ourself, He lives, and the blessing comes in. He says, "*We both can't be Lord here, someone is going to die,*" okay? It's usually me, us. Everyday, because of this resurrection from the dead, we can "choose life." I told you all I can hear right now, in this season, is "choose life." Boy, is it a battle? "Choose life," in every aspect of every situation. You say, "I choose life." Yes, His resurrection changes everything in our lives. Thank God. People are trying to find hope without resurrection power, and it's just heartbreaking. Remember where we were. Without His resurrection, all is vanity. There is no hope. There's only striving for a better today or tomorrow. Humans argue and they debate, and they're all led into error, confusion and deception, which leads to more lawlessness.

Scripture says that "lawlessness will abound in the last days." We have been in it for a while. The Body of Christ has the mission and authority and blessing from our God to show those in need, those humans, the true way of life. God sends His angels to us to rescue us in our battles and lift us up into His presence. The angels literally will come to you and lift you up. It's euphoric. They will come lift you up when you cry out. The world, and those of it in the world will try to beat you down by the scepter of wickedness. They can curse, control and lie to oppress you. But, Beloved, you are not of the world. You are not in the spirit of error, but you have the Spirit of Truth. The world, and those of it and in the world try to beat us down by the scepter of wickedness. They curse, they control, and they lie to oppress. Remember, we talked about the scepter of righteousness rules the land. That's the goal.

Matthew 5:11 NKJV

That's what the world system gives. Correct, that is what the lost will do. "*Blessed are you.*" Happy is the one empowered to prosper. "Oh, wait a minute. '*Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake.*' 'I'm in the world, but I'm not of the world.'"

Luke 6:22 NKJV

There it is. The above scripture said, "*for My sake,*" this verse says, "*for the Son of Man's sake.*" That's what it looks like.
