

## Title: Kingdom Growth and Focus

I want to exhort you in what the Father has shown us today. I entitled it, "Kingdom Growth and Focus." All summer long, He was really working on our focus. On Wednesday nights, we've been bringing what the Father has been saying to give.

### Ecclesiastes 5:1 NKJV

This scripture was a very direct word which was the theme. You know, sometimes you just need to say to yourself or someone else, "focus," right? In your employment, jobs, career, family, life, whatever it may be, it's just, "focus." Well, that's what the Spirit of the Lord has been saying.

### Ecclesiastes 5:1 AMPC

"Guard your steps and focus on what you are doing as you go into the house of God and draw near to listen, rather than to just offer the careless or irreverent sacrifice of fools. For they are too ignorant to know that they are doing evil."

*This is a very direct passage.* "Guard your steps and focus on what you are doing when you go to the house of God," versus we have to go to Church. Yes, He puts us in families. He aligns hearts. He connects people. The house of God is global, right? The house of the Lord is in the saints. Yet, He has these homes, these huts, these places of dwelling, that He gathers peoples together, and then He puts you in those families. You say, "This is where I want to be." I'm not where I was first, when I first got saved. I'm not in the same Church. Most of you weren't. Most of us started in a Church, maybe as a child. We grow up, life happens, and you may move from here and there. But, it is the Father that has been directing your steps in the house of God all of your life, looking for your own heart.

Sometimes you can go to Church for a long time and not be saved. That's what happened to me. I had been going to Church for *awhile*, and then it was like, "Why do you call Me Lord, Lord? You know you're not doing these things that I say. I don't know you." Uh oh, all of a sudden you say, "Oh, you want my life?" He wants to be my Lord. This is from Matthew seven. He wants to be our Lord, the Lord and Savior, not just the One we go see at Church. It's individual. It's personal. He died for each and every one of us. He knows everything about us, and He died to save us. He loves us, hallelujah. So, He puts us together.

The devil has always tried to bring division, divide, kill, destroy and keep you apart from the family of God. No matter what the excuse, they are just lame excuses, right? We go through things in life, but He's always laboring here with you, personally, to abide in you. Then to bring you into fellowship with other believers in Christ, amen. When we're sent out into the world to preach the gospel, we are sowing seeds into those hearts that God is going to cause growth in and get them connected into the body of Christ. Hear it. So, no matter what mission field you're on, in the marketplace, at home, as you go about your day, every day of the week, we have to always remember this, "focus on Kingdom growth." Focus, "Guard your steps and focus on what you're doing as you go to the house of God and draw near to listen, rather than to offer the careless or irreverent sacrifice of fools. They're too ignorant to know that they're doing evil."

We're drawing near to learn from the Lord in your quiet place as you seek Him, as you pray to Him throughout the week. "Abide in Me and I in you." Let the Word abide in us and we grow.

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Yes, we don't go to our secret time with God, just because you have to do it, check it off, and then go about your busy day. He's calling us to Himself. He always calls us. He loves us. He longs to be with us. Amen, that's the dwelling place of God in the Spirit. So, "Guard your steps and focus when I call you to Myself, beloved, you and Me. You and Me, and then you and us, and them, and those that are coming in." Oh, God is so hungry and so eager to bring others in. Then He will put us where He wants us in time and season. Glory to God, amen. King Jesus, we must remember, is our model in everything in the Kingdom. Jesus is Lord. Jesus is King. Jesus is the model. He is the first born among many brethren. Yes, He is the One that made a way for us to come to God and be a part of the family of God.

Isaiah 11:1-2 NLT

"Out of the stump of David's family will grow a shoot— yes, a new branch bearing fruit from an old root. And the Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him—the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord."

I love how that says, "Out of the stump of David's family will grow a shoot, yes, a new branch bearing fruit from the old root and the Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him." Our focus is King Jesus. Our focus is His heart, His will, His kingdom, His purpose, and His zeal. His zeal for the house of God should be our zeal for the house of God. His desire for the people of God should be our desire for the people of God. What burns in Him should burn in us. What He loves, we should love. What He hates, we should hate. What He desires, we should desire. What He does, we do. What He speaks, we hear, and then we say what He says.

He's transforming us by the Spirit of wisdom and revelation and knowledge and counsel and might and the anointing that's upon Him. Because, He's been set apart to anoint our heads with oil. Our cup overflows, and then we end up in line in the house of the Lord, focusing on what pleases Him, listening and learning. We don't know it all, beloved, but He does. Yes, we are all growing up, which we'll talk about in a moment. You hear the heart. So, we honor Holy Spirit in fullness, known as the Spirit of God, that enables us to come into the Kingdom of Heaven, amen.

The Scripture says, "there should be no lack in the house of the righteous." Say, "amen." He says, "My God shall supply all of your needs according to His riches and glory," amen. It says, "The Body of Christ, where every part does its share, brings together to fill the house of God with His will, His glory, His presence, His counsel, and His might. All together, there's no lack in the house of the righteous." Now, "we've been made right with God through the blood of Jesus." We do not have our own righteousness. That will not work. No, it won't work for anybody. We can only be made right through Jesus Christ. He is the righteous one. He says, "Guard your steps and focus," because I've come into your house. I'm the Lord. I'm here. I live here." We sang all about it, "He's in the room." Well, "He's in you, and He's in me, and He's in us, and when two get together, oh the glory." But, "there is no lack in the house of the righteous. My God shall supply all your needs, Church, according to the riches of glory."

Now you can't tap Him out. You can't. You cannot exhaust God's provisions, amen. As the Body of Christ, every one of us are doing our part as His home and as His house, correct? We are full, and we are rich and we are prospering. Lacking nothing, but yet we're growing. Isn't that amazing. When you're where you are, you're where you are, but yet there's growth needed. We all understand this. We were conceived in our mother's wombs. Some growth has taken place, correct? We are not through growing. There's always room for growth. There's no lack in the house of the Lord. So, you probably said this once or twice, or thought it at least. Maybe saying to someone that was probably giving you a difficult time, "Why don't you just grow up?" Anybody ever said that? Or is it just me? Saying, "Grow up already?" You know, "Dude, what are you thinking?" We say that because the Spirit of God is in us. He's the one

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that does it. He causes the growth. Yes, you feel that. You know when there's growth needed. You know when you can feel, "I really need to grow in that area." You know what I'm talking about? Raise your hand if you know I'm talking about. "Man, I really need to grow in that area." But, Jesus doesn't come as the King to condemn us. He draws us. He woos us. He loves us. He goes right to Himself, His word, and He brings truth. But when you hear, "wahh, wahh, wahh," that's the enemy talking. We've heard that recently. But, you have to press through that to the voice of the One. This Bible that we have is the voice of God written for us, amen. So, we attend unto His Word. When you attend unto His Word, you see it, hear it, feel it, read it, speak it, preach it. The Holy Ghost is the One that's causing the growth. "There's no lack in the house of the righteous," amen. Kingdom growth and focus. If you've been born again, God's desire is for you to grow, to not be alone, to be a part of a family near or far, and to be connected so that the growth can come. Because we're a body, and we are not all pinkies, correct? We're not all a big toe, true? That would be a little awkward. Say, "We are a body."

#### James 1:4 NKJV

Okay, we're talking about Kingdom growth and focus here. "Guard your steps and focus on what you're doing when you go into the house of God." Guard your steps and focus on what God Almighty is doing in you, because He says, "There is no lack in the house of the righteous." There is no lack in the saints of God. There is no lack. "If you let patience have its perfect work," you know how much we all love patience. Yes, "you may be perfect and complete." That's what my Bible says, "lacking nothing." So, patience, why do we have to bring that in the topic here? Because, you all know your scale of patience. Now, I've grown in my patience. Have you? We all grow in it, especially when you start having babies. Wow, that's when it's really tested. You have your first baby. There it is. You realize how much patience you don't have. Am I the only vessel that understands this? Once you're entrusted with this little soul, and that baby cries, "Mama!" It's like, "Okay, here we go." But we are His children, and He's so patient to grow us, to tend to us, to nurture us as we're sucky babies. He's taking care of us and we grow and we grow. We continue to grow until we step over into glory. "He will perfect what He has started in us," amen. "Let patience have its perfect work so that you can be made perfect and complete lacking nothing."

#### Proverbs 12:7 NKJV

Wow. The wicked are overthrown. Now, God knows those who are His, amen. "The wicked are overthrown and are no more. But the house of the righteous will stand." Say, "I have a righteous house, and it starts right here with our own soul. I am a righteous house. I'm a righteous vessel of honor." We've been redeemed, washed and forgiven by the blood of the Lamb, amen.

#### Proverbs 15:6 NET

"In the house of the righteous is abundant wealth, but the income of the wicked brings trouble."

Now, that is truth. "In the house of the righteous is abundant wealth." Don't try to go and search that out in the the Strongs concordance. It means what it says. In spirit, soul and body, spiritual, physical, financial, in every area, God prospers the righteous, amen. Say, "Amen." I have a Bible to prove it. Because, He did not forsake me in my mother's womb. He has fathered me, and He will father me until the end. The Father of glory does not leave the saints of the Most High, never, ever, ever. He will never leave us, fail us, nor forsake us. We are the most wealthy people as children of the Most High God forever. "In the house of the righteous is abundant wealth, but the income of the wicked brings trouble." There are so many scriptures about the righteous and the wicked in Proverbs. Have fun reading them all yourself.

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"It's better to be in the house of the righteous. It's better to leave the house of the wicked." You must be born again, and then, "the blessing of the Lord maketh one rich, and He adds no sorrow to it. The blessing of the Lord goes upon the children of the Most High God." You may be ignorant for a little *time*, because you didn't understand and focus on what the truth was in the journey. When you find out, "Whoa, I didn't know He heals today. I was told He didn't. Whoa, I didn't know there was still a baptism of the Holy Ghost. Oh, I find out there is. Oh, I didn't know that He shall provide all my needs according to His riches in glory, until now and you experience Him. I didn't know that He can travail and answer and deliver me from strongholds and demons until, He showed up and did it. I didn't know He could heal my physical body. I didn't know He could answer my prayer for my household to be saved." You see it? "There's no lack in the house of the righteous." This is a good, good Father, and righteousness dwells here, amen.

#### Matthew 16:18 ESV

"And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I'm going to build my Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."

Now that is a radical statement from Jesus. He was building something. This is a foundation. It's the house of the Lord. "Guard your steps and focus what you're doing when you come into the house of the Lord." You say, "Oh My God, I thought I was just going to go worship Him," but now you're standing on a Living Foundation. It says, "and the gates of hell shall not prevail against My Church." Your praises are doing something in the heavenlies you've just entered. You're not just on the worship team, right? We are saints of the Most High in the house of God, listening and learning. "The gates of hell shall not prevail. On this rock I'm going to build My Church. Christ, He's the cornerstone. He's the foundation. He's the sure One." Yes, we're building our house on His words. We're taking everything from His word. "He's not a man that He would lie," amen.

"Satan's a liar, and the father of lies," Jesus said. But, Jesus is Lord, and He is the truth, amen. "On this rock I will build My Church. The gates of hell shall not prevail against it," all the way to the end. That's it. So, when you're in a rough place, pull it out, pull out the Word, pull out the Scripture, decree it and declare it. God's going to do what He's going to do, and I want to be in line with His will, amen.

Holy Spirit gave the Church revelation of God's wisdom in building the Church. This is amazing to me. Jesus demonstrated by making disciples. Okay, He called twelve to Himself, and then He called more and more and more. He commissioned those twelve to go into all the world, preach the gospel, and make disciples, correct? A disciple is someone who has been born again from above, given their heart to Jesus Christ, as a laid down lover, right? You follow and abide in His teachings. Yes, you are learning and growing. This is truth. I'm sold out to obey the Word of God, of Jesus. Yes, I'm learning, focusing on what He's saying, and then I teach it to others. Right? It's not just the five fold ministers job to do that. Every saint is a minister, truth. He showed us. He gave us wisdom and how to build the Church. Okay, that's beautiful.

#### Ephesians 4:1 NKJV

Now we're going to read this, and I want you to listen, because this is about Kingdom growth and focus. Ephesians four, verse one, "I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called." Now that's individual, right there. Yes, that's not just the corporate body, but yet it's the corporate body, because individually, we make the corporate body. "I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you, to walk worthy of the calling in which you were called." So, that's where if you have anything against yourself, you say, "Well, I really don't do much, I really don't know much. I'm not very good. I'm not very worthy." He settled that, and now we have an ear to hear what the Spirit of the Lord is saying.

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I'm not going to come in here as a fool. I'm going to listen to what God's saying. He's telling me I'm supposed to walk worthy of the calling in which I was called, chosen, appointed, and anointed. He called me. He has purpose for me. He has a plan for me. It's not to the world, and it's not the spirit of this world that's passing away, but it's to Himself, in which the gates of hell cannot prevail against it. He continues. That's just verse one. You can spend all day on that.

Verse two, "with all lowliness and gentleness, with long suffering, bearing with one another in love." Now we went from me to you, great. Now we have to do this thing, right? You know that "she bear, that husband, that aunt, that sister, that brother in Christ, that one you know." Lord, it was good when it was just you and me, glory to God, but now, "Walk worthy of the calling in which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with long suffering." There's that patience. "Bearing with one another in love." There it is, right there, marriages, families, life, and just what it is as long as we're still on the planet, we have to bear up, correct?

Verse three, "Endeavoring," I love that word, "to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." "Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit." That's Holy Ghost, and to walk in the Spirit. We have a Bible full of, "renounce the flesh. Don't walk in the flesh, but walk in the Spirit at all times." You say, "That sounds great. That's a memory verse on my refrigerator, but I have no idea what you're talking about," right? Well, don't worry, because you, "Guard your steps and focus on what you're doing when you come into the house of God," and you're listening. God is teaching us, and the Holy Ghost is saying, "No, no, yes, yes, and let's change that. You know what you said over there? It really wasn't from my heart, right? What you're doing right now really isn't pleasing to the Father." We hear Him, and here comes the unity of the Spirit. All of us are all in this journey. Can you just imagine, globally, every saint that's alive right now, and the work in the unity of the Spirit that is endeavoring to bring us into the Father's will? What an awesome job of Holy Ghost. We're not talking about the lost people, yet. This is just those that are born again and alive right now. What a work. Yet, He calls you by name. He chooses you. He loves you. He's endeavoring to perfect what concerns you, because you're the house of God. You're the dwelling place of the Spirit. Then He encourages us to walk in the unity of the Spirit. Can you hear it?

Verse four, He says, "There is one Body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, through all and in you all." That's very clear unity of the Spirit. "One God, one Lord, one way, one faith, one word, one spirit, and one mission. Hear it, there's a unity there and oneness. Consider, "Guard your steps and focus when you go into the house of the Lord." Coming in to learn, to listen, to walk in the unity of the Spirit, and to receive correction and rebuke. Yes, we're granted repentance. Thank the Lord. Thank the Lord. We don't want to be hardened so that there's no repentance. That's the most fearful place to ever be. But, the Holy Ghost is with us to bring us into fruitfulness and repentance. He's going to finish His work. He's got a long time timetable until you cross over. He says, "Grow up," right? Say, "I'm growing." You see the unity of that purpose. We must have Kingdom focus. We know that God has established Kingdom government and authority. We're not isolated. We're not alone. That comforts me, and it should comfort you. We're not alone.

Ephesians four, verse eleven, "He Himself gave some, to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and some teachers." Why? "For the equipping of the saints, for the works of the ministry." Now, that's personal, that's every saint a minister. "For the equipping of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the Body of Christ." So, the work that God does in you is going to affect many, many others. They may not only be in your sphere. Just one encounter in the store with somebody else, may change the course and destiny of their life. Truth. You may be with someone for a time, but you gave them all you had, and then God moves them on to complete their journey, amen.

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Verse twelve, “For equipping the saints, for the work of the ministry for the edifying of the Body of Christ.”

Verse thirteen, Here it is. “Till we all come to the unity of the faith.” Now that's the Father's heart. Okay, “till we all come to the unity of the faith and knowledge of the Son of God.” It gets better, “to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.” What is He thinking? God is saying this about humans who just came out of darkness and being translated in darkness and the flesh and the devil, and He puts us into the house of God. Now, He tells us these wonderful things. It's His order. It's His governance, it's His government, it's His Kingdom. There is focus. He distributes His gifts as He desires. He calls these apostles and prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers to minister to the saints, to teach, to impart, and to give everything the Spirit is saying, to help us understand and grow up. Then the saints are all growing up, and the whole goal is for “all to come into the unity of the faith.” That is a miracle.

It's a miracle that two people can agree on anything, even scripture. “Well, Brother, I don't believe that.” Once in my life, some person didn't want me preaching and teaching on faith. They were scared of me talking on faith for real. Okay, that's truth, because faith is what makes God go, yes. The devil does not want you to have faith in what I'm telling you right now. We have to believe what He says. We're all going come into the unity of the faith. That means I have Jesus's faith. I have the faith of my Father. I have the faith of the Holy Ghost. I have the faith of what that Bible tells me, and we're all lining up to this. That Bible's not lining up to what I believe. That Bible is telling me, “You line up with what my Father believes, that's why we do what we do.”

Yes, that's why we equip and train to teach and impart. Hallelujah, to the faith and the knowledge of the Son of God. “If I just had the faith of Jesus.” Just say, “I do.” Why? Because He lives in you. Stop kicking against the goads. He says, “I told you to do this.” You're like, oh no, no, that's too much, Jesus. You can do that. But I don't see me doing that.” It's Him in you saying, “Do it.” Yes, truth. It doesn't matter what it is. We are all coming into His faith, and the unity of the faith and the knowledge of the Son of God, to the perfect man. But, He's perfecting that Body. He's bringing the Body of Christ into perfection, into whose measure, whose stature of the fullness is Christ. That's the fit. That's the work that's going on from generation to generation to generation to generation. The Father of glory is over all of this. He is overseeing this amazing work. He knows the last one that's going to come in. We don't, but He does already. He sees, and He knows us from afar, amen. The unity of the faith.

Verse fourteen, “That we should no longer be children tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine.” That's what I was trying to tell you. You just get going and religion can come in. Jesus showed us. He had to rebuke the religious of His day, right? He says, “Here it is,” and they're doing something else. He rebuked them, and He taught them the ways of the Lord. There is nothing new under the sun, beloved. Okay? He doesn't want us to be children, little babies, just tossed to and fro, carried about by every wind of doctrine and the new doctrine that says something against the word of God, truth. Error is increasing of course. Lawlessness is increasing of course. So, what's new under the sun and it will continue into the end. That's why He needs saints who are being unified by the Spirit and in line with the Father of glory.

Wow, where “the gates of hell cannot prevail against the Church,” lining up with what He says. We're going to flow with what He says. Then you grow up into that. Once, you just didn't believe that God did miracles today, until you got your miracle. You say, “Well, there you go. That's a testimony of Jesus. I believe now that Jesus Christ could still heal bodies to this day.” It's the way it looks. Every one of us understands this. We are “guarding our steps when we go into the house of God.” We're focusing to learn, to grow, to let Him correct us, yes. Wow.

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We don't want to be “tossed to and fro, carried about with every wind of doctrine by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting. But speaking the truth in love.” That's the other one who's bearing with one another in love. Love wins. Love is Jesus. God is love, correct? So, love is the center of everything He does, and He proved that to us by giving His own Son, right? He didn't just talk it. He demonstrated it. He continues to demonstrate it.

Verse fifteen, “Speaking the truth in love so that we may all grow up in all things, into Him who is the Head.” We speak the truth in love. We teach in love. We correct in love. We counsel in love the same as Christ. Because we're “all growing up into the head, Christ.” Say, “I'm growing up. We're growing up.” It doesn't matter if you just got saved, you are growing. Yes, as soon as we get saved, He starts to fill us, teach us, empower us, and grow us, and change our identity to who we are now in Him, hallelujah! Because the past can just condemn us, but the future is bringing the glory. Amen. “We are growing up in all things into Him, who is the Head.” Remember, He's the One. He's the perfect man. He's the full measure of the stature. He's it. This body is lining up with that. We're not just going to Church. This is Kingdom focus.

This is a Kingdom work. That's why you can read a passage that you have read a million times, and it's like there is fresh oil on it. Because the living Christ is speaking to you, encouraging you, healing you, delivering you, and bringing you into the fullness. When you come into the fullness, and they come into the fullness, and I come to the fullness, guess what? The whole body grows. There's that corporate, eternal growth from one generation to the next. Sometimes we just ride on the heels ahead of others. Sometimes we have to go back a little, bringing it back and forward again. But, the truth will never be put out. “The gates of hell shall not prevail against the Church.” Say, amen!

Verse sixteen, “From whom the whole body joined and knit together.’ ‘From the whole body, the whole body joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself, in love.” Constantly, all of us working together, hosting the presence of the Lord, and allowing Him to cause the growth. Being obedient in everything He's put in our hearts to do. Yes, we are living vessels of honor. There's no lack in the house the righteous. “Well, I don't know enough yet.” No, if you've been born again from above, Christ is in you. Right now you can serve Christ. Say, “Here I am Lord, however I can help, however I can serve. Here I am Lord.” He knows, but that's what it looks like. I love this.

#### Ephesians 4:16 NLT

“He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.” You say, “Well, I'm not needed, I'm not wanted. I can't do that. I don't have any gifts or abilities.” Yes, you do. If you've been born again from above, we step into that, and we're all growing. We'll keep growing and growing and growing, wow. We've got a whole Bible full of testimonies of people. “Every joint, every ligament, every part, coming together in Christ to serve the living God to accomplish His will,” amen. “He makes the whole body fit together perfectly.” He's doing it. “There's no lack in the house of the righteous.’ ‘He makes the whole body fit together perfectly.” Say, “Perfect.” He needs you, and He needs me, and we work together, amen.

There are a lot of bodies in the nation of the United States of America, and He's looking at everybody. He's looking at every saint. Just keep going down to the state of Texas. Keep going down to San Angelo, Texas. Keep going down to your street. That's how He sees it. He is able to bring these joints and ligaments and parts together to host the glory in the presence of the King, Who rules with justice and righteousness. Who rules right, and Who has wisdom and counsel and knowledge and power and glory. Yes, that's the work He's doing. He causes the growth of the body. Say, “I'm growing.” Each part does its own special work.

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It helps other parts to grow. Yes, God's causing the growth. God is causing the growth, and that's something else.

I Peter 2:1 NKJV

What are they drawing them into? *They are* drawing them into the words of God. Yes, drawing them into the Word of God, into His heart, His desire. He says, if you don't have a desire for the Word of God, ask for it. He'll give it to you. If you feel dry or dead or slumbering, or I really don't care anymore, ask God to revive you and to forgive you. He will come and you'll be revived. We won't be able to keep you out of it. That's truth. Okay? He says, "lay aside all this flesh, malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy and all evil speaking, just the love of this world. As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word," and the will of God for your life. Desire the will of God for your life. "I desire and I come into the house of Lord and I focus. I desire the will of God for my life." Just like that, everything changes, and we grow.

II Peter 3:17-18 ESV

"You therefore beloved, knowing this beforehand, take care that you are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose your own stability. But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him, be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen."

You see, there is no end to this growth. "There's no lack in the house the righteous." He says, come together. Grow in grace, grow in the knowledge of Jesus, and grow in the anointing. Yes, say, I'm growing up." As a body, God wants this. He needs us all to do our part. He needs us. It's not, "Thou shalt have to go do it." He wants us. He desires us. He needs us. He knows where to put us, and He connects us right where He wants us to be, amen.

This is a beautiful passage. I listen to the Holy Ghost. He's right. The Holy Ghost is right. God is not a man that He would lie. So, what He says is right. Don't argue with Him. What He says is right, amen.

Hebrews 10:23-25 TPT

"So now wrap your heart tightly around the hope that lives within us, knowing that God always keeps His promises! Discover creative ways to encourage others and to motivate them towards acts of compassion, doing beautiful works as expressions of love. This is not the time to pull away and neglect meeting together, as some have formed the habit of doing. In fact, we should come together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward as we anticipate that day dawning."

Let's stand up and give Him praise. If you need prayer, we will pray for you afterwards here. But we are all growing. It's Kingdom growth, not religion.

Father, God, we honor you. We receive and adhere to your words from beginning to the end. We're yours, Lord, we are yours. We receive your words today. You love us. You chose us. You called us. We thank you for using us for the glory of the Lord, and uniting us in love and putting our hands to work and to serve.
