II Corinthians 4:1-6 NKJV

Hallelujah, amen. "The light of God in the face of Christ." This is the glory of the Lord. "The light of God in the face of Christ Jesus," is the glory of the Lord. He sent and He revealed His glory through Jesus Christ that mankind could look up and be saved. Oh, the glory of His presence.

The god of this world, of this age, has blinded the minds of all humanity. God sent His Word and healed us. He sent His Word, Jesus Christ, to save us. He destroyed the spirit of blindness that not only blinded our physical eyes, but our soul, and our entire being. We were separated from God because of sin. Sin separated us from God. We were all born in sin, conceived in sin, even in our mother's womb, from one generation to the next. God, in His mercy and grace, sent His only begotten Son into the world to save us. This is the story. This is the testimony. The gospel of Jesus is not veiled. It is not hidden. It is open. It has been revealed. It is called the revelation of Jesus Christ. He is unfolding. He is revealing. He is taking us from glory to glory.

When we first got saved, when we first saw Him, we came out of hell into light, hallelujah, and became citizens of heaven. We are sons and daughters of the Most High God. He has given us many, many names, but the one I love the most is that we're His own. Hallelujah, we're no longer alone. This is a testimony of how the god of this world, the devil himself and his kingdom have blinded those who do not believe. That's why God hates unbelief. He hates unbelief, because it keeps us from believing and receiving His Word, Jesus Christ, His truth and His Spirit. Because he knew that the Light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, the glory of Christ, the Light of the gospel, is Light itself. It's not hidden anymore. The spirit of blindness is literally upon every soul that is not yet born again.

There's a testimony I was reminded of during worship. Years ago, I was at a ladies conference in Abilene. I was leading in it. There was a woman that some ladies were trying to lead to Jesus. They had given her the gospel, and they were working really hard for her to come to know Jesus. They had done everything they could have done, so they asked for a little help. I heard the story. As I walk up, the Holy Ghost, says, "Rebuke the spirit of blindness." I said, "Yes, sir." I rebuked the spirit of blindness. I commanded it to leave in Jesus name. Then I gave

her the gospel, and she believed, and she was saved on the spot. But you see, we're not wrestling against flesh and blood. We are dependent upon Holy Spirit who searches and knows every heart. For many souls since that time, I say, "Yes, Lord." You learn, and He teaches you. From that point on, I have been rebuking some spirits of blindness as we intercede for the lost, for your loved ones and those who may be a little stubborn. Even when a stranger comes up, you have to understand how it works in the Kingdom. But, when you carry so much light, there is much power in Jesus' name. He takes cares of the spirits of blindness when you just walk up and you present Christ.

There are times He says, "I've given you authority. I've given you authority and power to trample upon snakes and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy and nothing by any means will harm you." He says, "I've given you authority to cast out demons. I've given you authority to bring the sword of the Lord, the Word, in order to destroy the works of darkness." Jesus Christ came to destroy the works of darkness. Hallelujah, it is a war. It's a battlefield. We were snatched out of darkness and placed into the Kingdom of the Beloved Son of God. Each and every one of us are called, chosen and appointed to share this glorious gospel. Amen. Oh My God, thank you, Jesus, for the glory in the face of Christ. The Spirit says this morning, "Let the blind see!"

Luke 4:18

This is a testimony from Isaiah 61, of the Messiah, the Christ, and Jesus is the One.

Say, "That's us." He sent His Word, and He saved us. He heals us. The great Holy Ghost is the One that goes into the hearts and removes the veils, so that we can receive this great anointing from Jesus to be saved. As soon as we are saved, it's just the beginning, because it is an eternal work. But, it starts on this side of glory, on the Earth. He heals you, and He delivers you, and He renews your mind. He delivers you, and He restores, and He makes new. He is there to bring a conviction and truth. He is here to renew us, revive us, refresh us, encourage us, and to bring us words of life. That's why we read the Bible. That's why we teach His Word. It's the ministry of the Word of God. We are blinded until the veil comes off. It's like, you know how many times you tried to read the Bible through and you couldn't get past Genesis two? It takes the Holy Ghost to give you desire for the word. You cannot come to God, unless God draws you, He'll draw all to Himself. He knows who He's drawing. It's even the grace of God, that we said, "yes." Because He gave me the ability to believe and He gives conviction. Isn't that amazing?

Jesus said, "The Spirit of the Lord is on Me." I've come to save you, and I'm not going to just get you out of hell and bring you to Heaven. But, while you're still on the planet, here's what we're going to do. We're going to work on spirit, soul and body. We're going to bring the Kingdom of Heaven to spirit, soul and body. Then you're going to take those miracles I'm doing in you, and you're going to go do the same for others. That's the it's the commission. Now go present this gospel and heal sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, and cast out demons. Freely you receive, freely give to lead all to Christ. This is Luke 4:18, and it's imparted to His body.

Hebrews 13:8

This is a beautiful passage, pretty much hits the nail on the head. "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever." He never changes. Yet, His face is new every morning. His glories are new morning by morning. It's just because He's revealing another aspect of who He is to us. You say, "I never knew that. I never saw that. I've been reading this so long, and all of a sudden there's a fresh wind on it. There's fresh breath on it." You've never seen it before, and you go around telling everybody your "new scripture." They say, "Yeah, that's awesome."

Psalm 146

Don't save your praises for when you get to Heaven. We are here to praise the Lord. Individually, we are called to praise the Lord. You don't just praise the Lord in church. You praise the Lord all the time. Amen.

Matthew 11:1-6

Praise you Jesus. He said, "Let the blind see!" Jesus is a man of His word. He is the Word. Whatever He says happens. Whatever He speaks comes forth. Whatever He does, is done by the Spirit of God who leads Him.

Matthew 9:27-31

Classic disobedience, yes? "Tell nobody," and you tell everybody. "Jesus sternly warned them saying, "See that no one knows it. But when they departed, they spread the news about Him in all that country." Yes, a country, a region, that's big, okay? Hallelujah.

Matthew 12:22

Son of David, have mercy. "Blind and mute," double trouble, and He healed him. He spoke, and He saw. We believe you, Jesus.

Matthew 15:29-31

Hallelujah.

Mark 8:22-26

A testimony of Jesus.

Do you think this testimony went out as well? Oh, absolutely.

John 9:1-7

Hallelujah, Holy Ghost directs each prayer that Jesus said, and every act that He ministered. The Holy Ghost directed Him in all things. Before Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, this was said of Him.

John 11:37

This is the story of where He raised Lazarus from the dead. If you've not read it, go for it. But, they see this man, Lazarus, is dead, and this is one of their statements about Jesus. "Some of them said, 'Could not this man, who opened the eyes of the blind, also have kept this man from dying?' Right? He's doing all these amazing works. So, why did Lazarus die?"

John 11:40

Jesus said to Lazarus's loved ones, "Did I not say to you that if you would only believe you would see the glory of God?"

John 11:43-44

Isn't that amazing? He was four days dead, and God raised Him. Jesus raised Him from the dead. He is the resurrection, and He is the life. Jesus, Himself was raised from the dead by the great Holy Ghost. But, in this discussion, I think it's so interesting that this was drawn out. "This One, that could open the eyes of the blind." I mean, sickness is sickness, infirmity is infirmity. Whether you're blind, deaf, or mute, it's all the same. But, there was such a miracle, especially if you had been born that way. If you were born deaf, if you were born blind, or if you were born maimed, it was even a greater miracle. They're looking for who do we blame for this? Yes, but the glory that you must see, that Jesus always pointed to, is to the glory of God.

All things are for the glory of God. "Did I not tell you, if you only believe?" That's all He asks of us. Our job is not to try to figure it out. Our job is to believe Him. Show us your glory, Lord. Oh, and the glory of the Lord was revealed. Amen. "Did I not say to you, if you only believed you would see the glory of God?" See the glory of God. See the glory of the Lord, that is it.

God said, "Let the blind see!" So, any area in our own soul where we're blinded to the truth, He wants us to see. Any area in our mind or thought life, or whatever it may be. Anywhere we are maybe a bit stubborn or haughty, or powerful, or religious, or unbelieving, or not too sure. "I tried that once, but it didn't work." He's always working. "Let the blind see." That's tangible. That's a manifestation. It's literal. Okay, to see means, "I see it. It happened. I see it. I know it. I heard it. I felt it. It's there."

"Let the blind see," no matter what level we're walking in with God. That is the cry of the Spirit. That is His voice this morning, hallelujah. As you go beyond the veil into the glory, "Oh, the glory of His presence." We see God. We know God. We come to know Him through His word and by the Spirit. This is truth.

Revelation 3:14-22

This is Jesus's word to the church of Laodicea. There is a spiritual sight. The greatest rebuke and the greatest reward is that if you open the door, if you will see, if you will release and come to me, if you receive my zeal and my fire, if you receive my great love, if you will... Come alive! Do not be lukewarm. Be hot. Fire is hot. Ice is cold. Lukewarm is *spit out*, right? That's what He said. Okay, fire is hot. It is the fire of the Holy Ghost. It is the glorious One that has come to rebuke the spirit of blindness, in spirit, soul and body, so that we can see. That was the cry even here. He had many things. He's trying to remove their shame, their nakedness, their humility, their humanity, of just their sin. You're wretched, you're miserable, you're poor, you're blinded and you're naked. You have not let Me clothe you. You have not chosen to wear My garment of praise. You have not chosen to wear the garment of the oil of gladness that destroys the works of heaviness, gives sight to the blind, and eyesight to see beyond yourself.

He says, "Church, I've called you to abide with Me and in Me. Let My Spirit work through you. I'm the One that opens the eyes of the blind." We can't do it. He's rebuking them because they did not receive the words of the Lord. They're being rebuked, because they've gone lukewarm, and have become religious. In deafness and blindness and a muteness so they couldn't even speak. But, He's calling them back. The glory of this is He says He's going to remove the shame of nakedness, once there's repentance. He will anoint the eyes with salve that you may see. That is the Lord's heart, to anoint our eyes. "Oh Lord, open my eyes. Anoint my eyes, physically, spiritually, emotionally, in every way. Let the eyes of my soul be open. Let the eyes of my mind be open. Let the eyes of my heart be open. Let my physical eyes be open." "Taste and see that the Lord is good." Yes!

Then the promise, because it's a rebuke, He said, "Because I love you, I'm rebuking you. Because I want you to see Me and all My glory." Amen. So, He says, You have to be zealous and repent. Repentance is not "whatever." Zealous is genuine repentance before God Almighty. Crying out to Him, "Lord God, forgive me." He'll come. He's standing at the door crying out, "Open, I'm going to come in. I'm going to have fellowship with you, and dine together."

"To Him who overcomes." Here's your reward. "I will grant to sit with Me on My throne." This is Jesus Christ, King of kings, Lord of lords. This is what the Bible says. "I overcame, and I sat down with My Father on His throne." He gives us the grace to overcome. You understand this? There is authority and there is blessing. There is a glory laid up for those. Yes, "Oh, the glory of His presence." The Spirit says, "Let the blind see!" As we receive these words, I encourage you to ask the great Holy Ghost, "Where have I been blinded? What have I not seen about you?"

Where have I been kicking against the goads? Where have I refused to believe that part of you? Ask the Holy Ghost. He's truth. He will show you. That's what I do. He shows us. Yes, and then you repent. "Repent and be zealous," and there comes the salve and the anointing of the Holy Ghost. He heals you, and He fills you. He empowers you to be His witness. To go out with this glorious Gospel and continue to rebuke the spirit of blindness and the god of this age, in order to bring others out and into the sight of Almighty God. "We are His people, the sheep of His pasture." Yes, we are the family of God. Of course, His eye is on us. We sing the beautiful song. It's a scripture. "*His* eye is on the sparrow, and *His* eye is on me." He sees us. He says, "Let the blind see!"

"Father God, we receive your word today. We're encouraged, Lord Jesus, that you're with us. You're in our midst, Lord. We rebuke the spirit of blindness in Jesus name from every soul listening. Father, we thank you for bringing the light of the glory of the gospel of the face of Christ to all. That we may see and keep on seeing. That we may believe and keep on believing. That we would know and keep on knowing, as you increase us more and more. In the physical, Lord, when those people are blind, or when they have infirmities, God. That you would move through your body and give them sight. Restore their soul, heal their bodies, bring deliverance, comfort those who mourn, deliver them from evil, and manifest your glory in Jesus' mighty name, amen."
