

Title: Receive My Instruction

Today I have entitled this, "Receive My Instruction," per the Holy Ghost. I want to encourage everybody that we believe that God speaks to His people. I mean, that would be horrible to have a God that didn't talk to you. That's called dead religion. It's called dead works and a false god. But, we have a God who is living. God, the Father, Jesus Christ, the Son and great Holy Spirit, work together as one to reveal the Kingdom of Heaven to us every day. That's why Jesus Christ, the Son of God, said, "Pray this way, My Father, who lives in Heaven, holy is Your name. Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven." That's truth. He has invited us into Heaven with Him, now, while we're still on the Earth. Truth.

We have to get saved here. It's on Earth that we get saved. We don't have to get saved in Heaven. We only get to go to Heaven if we're saved. On this planet, God chose to send His word, bring people and have a family on the planet Earth. Say, "Earth," in Jesus' name. My God, He's good. While you're here, you've been born on this Earth. Proverbs 1:2-5, 7 NKJV

This is from the Lord today. He says, "Receive my instruction." Now that is a lot, but I'm here to tell you, it is God's Holy Spirit that imparts to us humans, the born again ones, and those redeemed of the Lord. He gives us His instruction. God Almighty gives us the born again ones, the saved ones, His family, His instruction, understanding, wisdom, justice, judgment, equity, prudence. My God, He gives us all these words that are normally kind of on the boring side, like, knowledge and discretion. He says, "A wise man is going to hear and increase in learning." He says, "A man of understanding is going to attain wise counsel." You say, "I thought this was for everybody over 80, right?" No, but when you get born again, you get the Holy Ghost in you, who is wisdom, who is counsel, who is might, who is power and glory, who is knowledge, who is the fear of the Lord, who is instruction. He is the one that guides us and leads us and teaches us. He tells us, "No, no." He says, "Way to go." He congratulates us, He celebrates us. He rebukes us and He corrects us.

Amen, thank God that He grants us repentance. My goodness, if we weren't granted repentance, we would not be here today, alright? The end result of that, if we're not granted repentance, is an eternity in hell and separated from God. Through Jesus Christ, He bought this great salvation. Listen, He is saying, "Receive My instruction." So, Proverbs chapter one, "To know wisdom and instruction." There is an ability to know wisdom. You can say, "Well, I have wisdom on this matter, but it is His heart to know wisdom. "I have received instruction," but it is His heart to know instruction. "I know that He is instructing me in the way that I should go. I know that He is teaching me right now. I know I'm listening to the Father's instruction." This scripture says that we are to perceive, understand, be enlightened with words of understanding. You see, if we take these words out of our life, wow, that would be horrible.

Every day we are open to the Father God to reveal His will to us, His understanding, His wisdom, and His instruction. We need guidance every day. Usually people wake up and say, "Oh, Lord, lead me and guide me. Help me. Lord," right? You know, especially when you're in trouble. You say, "Lord, I really need your help. I need help today. I need guidance today. I need to know what to do. I need to know what's right and what's wrong. I need to know what's prudent. I want to know what's a waste. I don't want to waste my time." You hear it? There is so much of this involved in our daily life."What decision do I make? Do I go left or do I go right? Do I do this or do I not? Do I accept this offer, or do I decline it? Do I go or do I stay? Do I sit or do I rise?" In all these things, the Spirit of God is moving. We are receiving instruction every single day, whether you know it or not, when you've been born again. Hallelujah. We're not fools. We're not orphans. We have been adopted. We belong to Jesus now, so He is going to instruct us. It is our desire and heart to receive that instruction. He gives us ears to hear and eyes to see and a heart that will understand. That comes by the Holy Ghost.

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You can't do it without Him. You can't make it happen. It is grace. Say, "Grace." Grace gives us these things. Hallelujah! Justice, judgment, and equity. "God is perfect in all His ways. To the young man, He will give knowledge and discretion." From the eldest to the youngest, God is moving. You can't say this is for old folks. It is from the youngest to the eldest. We need this, correct? When there's a young man, you say, "He's mature beyond his years," correct? Or, a young woman, and you say, "She is mature beyond her years." You understand that a wise man and woman is going to hear and increase in learning. A wise man and woman are going to hear and increase in learning. We're all growing, everyone of us. I love this, because you can join with the Lord to increase. You can join with the Lord to hear Him. We work with the saints constantly in how to read the word, how to abide in the word, and how to hear God.

People are hearing God way more than they give themselves credit for. He's not that difficult. Not at all, hallelujah. "You hear a word behind you saying, this is the way walk in it." You find yourself in the right path, because of His grace and goodness. "A wise man will hear and increase learning. A wise man will hear." I need wisdom. It will help me hear. I need wisdom to increase in my learning. I need wisdom. He said, "If any man lacks wisdom, let Him ask of God, and God will give generously." Right? This is not just when you're in trouble. This is daily bread. You're asking to abide with wisdom and understanding every single day of your life. Hallelujah. It's not just when you hit 70 and above. "A man of understanding will attain wise counsel. A woman of understanding will attain wise counsel." A man and woman of understanding, when their heart is open, say, "I want to understand. God, you're going to give me wisdom. I want to understand."

The thing I remember the most growing up was algebra, in seventh grade, at Bowie school, in Amarillo, Texas. Sitting there in my chair crying while thinking, "x plus y equals z." You get my point? Who invented this? Why? I mean, where did this come from? There are things in this life, like x plus y equals z? Why, God?" Life looks like that. Does it not? I remember the day that I got understanding. I remember the day it, "clicked," so that I could do the class. Now, I've got a husband that actually understands how this stuff works, and I don't have to. Hallelujah but, this is amazing, that God is giving us wisdom and counsel. He's increasing our learning and our ability. When we first see it, we don't know what to think about it. When we first hear it, we're not too sure about it. When God first tells us something that's glorious about His nature, we hear it, and we wrestle with it. Then somewhere, the Holy Ghost opens our hearts to lay hold of that truth.

It says that God is good. You say, "I don't understand that. I don't believe it. I've never seen it." But then He starts working relentlessly to reveal His goodness to us, correct? These are powerful words a wise man and woman will hear and increase in learning. We are increasing. We're not going backwards. We are not decreasing. We are always growing. Amen, "A man and woman of understanding will attain wise counsel." We're attentive to His counsel, hallelujah. The fear of the Lord is what starts it all. It is the fear of the Lord that is the beginning of knowledge. The fear of the Lord. It is the fear of the Lord that gets us saved, because, remember, "He draws all men to Himself. No one can come to Me unless the Father draws Him." Truth. That's scripture. We know it's by grace that we've been saved. By faith, we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken.

The fear of the Lord is the thing that's going to draw you into Him first. With the fear of the Lord, that's different than a dead religion. Dead religion torments. Dead religion tries to make you do something in your flesh. But, the fear of the Lord will draw you into the intimacy where there is increased learning, instruction, fathering, mothering, care, and nurture. Yes, He brings us and calls us His own. That's where I want to be. I want the fear of the Lord. We need the fear of the Lord. The world needs the fear of the Lord. Correct? Oh, my God, the fear of man is the opposite of this. He said, "A fool will despise wisdom and instruction."

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We were all once fools before we were saved. It's the truth. Without the Lord, we were fools, dead in our sin and pride. Arrogant in every way. God granted us mercy. Hallelujah. We don't want to be immature.

Instruction, He said, "Receive My instructions," so we all understand what instruction is. It can be discipline. It can be correction. It can be admonition and giving advice and counsel as I'm speaking. We understand how to instruct and furnish somebody with knowledge. No matter what we're teaching and training them in. Trying to educate them. We're allowing God to direct the course. Instruction, even the Book of the Law in the New Living is called the Book of Instruction. His commands are instructing us. Jesus's commands are instructing us. God is always teaching us, but He's not just teaching. He interacts with us, shows us, leads us, empowers us and guides us in what He's instructing us in. He does not leave us alone. Amen, say, "Amen." We understand that.

Job 22:22

It says, "Receive, please, instruction from His mouth, and lay up His words in your heart." Good old Job, with lots of friends giving advice, and in the middle of that, says, "Please receive instruction from God's mouth," Right? "Lay up His words in your heart." How about that? Even in the middle of a situation, and nobody knows who to blame. Right? Nobody knows what to do. The cry is by the Holy Ghost. "Please listen to the words that God is going to bring from His mouth." God gives instruction. God gives. He's laying up His words in our heart. That's why, when you have one word in your heart, the Holy Ghost takes you back to that scripture. You remember it, you stand on it, and you're guided by it. He leads you. He directs you. He instructs you when you're about to make a decision. "God, do I go left or right?" There it is in your heart. It comes bubbling out of your heart. I would love it if an angel came down every time and said, "This is Him. Do it." But, it comes out of the heart. It comes out of your spirit. I love when the angels come to me, hallelujah. But, this is the Holy Ghost in you that is giving us instruction. He said, "Receive My instruction." Please receive instruction from His mouth." That's His word, correct? "Lay up these words in your heart."

Job 33:14-16

God can visit us while we sleep. It says, "For God may speak in one way or another." We've clearly covered that. Yet man's not recognizing it. Mankind's not recognizing that God is directing their steps. God is actually intervening. God is actually speaking to them. Most are like me, ignorant, dumb, x, y, z equals b, whatever. "I don't know? Is that God talking to me? Is that God convicting me? Is that God telling me the way to walk? Is it God all along who is ministering to the people on the Earth, even before the grace came to be saved? He's eternal. How good is God? Everybody should be so happy today that God saved you. Amen. So, "God can speak one way or another, yet man's not perceiving. In a dream and a vision of the night, even when deep sleep falls upon men and women while slumbering on their beds. He opens the ears of men and seals the instruction." It's like He put the stamp on there. He closed and sealed the envelope of what God imparted in our spirit even while we sleep. That is amazing, because really, we have 24 hours in a day. To think that God can only speak to us in a matter of five minutes during the day is very shallow and naive. God is always speaking. You may say, "Well, I'm not a dreamer." It doesn't matter. The Holy Ghost, if you've been born again, is speaking to you even while you sleep. He gives to His Beloved, even in our sleep, and He seals this instruction.

This is what the Lord is saying to His Garden. He says, "*I'm going to give you instruction.*" If God is saying very point blank, "*I'm going to give you instruction.*" Every ear is listening right now. Amen. "*I'm going to give you instruction, Beloved of My heart. My guidance is fresh as the morning sun that rises faithfully every day.*" Amen, "*All you need is to adhere to and seek My*

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heart in order to hear and perceive.” He's always asking us to seek His face, to look for Him, to hear Him, to know Him, and to follow Him. He says, *“I will guide you moment by moment, all the way.”* What a grace to know that God guides us. The devil would want to tell you that you're all alone. God would say, *“No, I'm with you. I'll never leave you, fail you, or forsake you, and I'm guiding you every step of the way. You have heard not to look this way or that, or to look to the left or to the right, but look only into My heart and will and hear my intentions for you.”* We want to know the intention of the Father. We want to know His intentions for us. Sometimes in our past, we may say, *“But, what's your intention? What are your intentions in this relationship?”* Right? Well, we know that Father's intentions are always good, correct?

He says, *“You have heard not to look this way or that or to the left or to the right, but look only into My heart and will.”* When we read His Word, we're seeing His heart, and we're seeing His will. You know, by the Holy Ghost, who's instructing us along the way. You can feel His presence guiding you into truth. You know when it's just a hair off. You know when it's a whole bunch off? You know when that's another voice. I will not listen to that voice, because a stranger's voice we do not hear. Amen.

He says, *“I will instruct you more and more in the night seasons.”* When He's saying this, He's showing you I'm coming more and more through revelation knowledge in the night seasons. Don't limit this only to dreams, but realize this instruction is literally being imparted in the night season, while you sleep. I've done my best to set you up for that, and for you to know and believe these words that the Spirit of God is saying that, even while we sleep. He is imparting to us instruction, even in the night, amen.

He says, *“My work is not exhausting. I will not exhaust you, but I will fill you to overflowing. You have asked for fresh fire and a baptism in fire in order to do the works of My Father, for My name's sake, and in order to accomplish with power and authority His sovereign will.”* We must have power. We must have the fire. We have to have the fire of God. You understand, we have to have the fire of God? It's not a pentecostal slang. It is a reality of the living God.

He said, *“God is a consuming fire.”* We want Him to consume everything in our being. Hallelujah. He says, *“I know you asked for that.”* We're decreeing and praying for it more and more. It's all about His will being done to accomplish His perfect will, individually and corporately. He says, *“I will instruct you.”* We are learning, and you have much to learn. I love it, *“We are learning and we have much to learn.”* Say it, *“We are learning, and we have much to learn.”* All right, *“those who have ears to hear.”* He says, *“You have been awakened. As I look into the hearts in this Garden, I have brought and will continue awakening to all who seek My face.”* Yes, because once you turn your eyes to Him, you're toast. You're just toast, right? Because those who seek His face, there it is, He will continue to revive. Yes, He will continue to awaken.

He says, *“As I look into the hearts in this Garden. I have brought and I will continue awakening to those who seek My face.”* How do you draw people to seek My face? How do you do it? He says, *“You don't, I do.”* What we do is we say, *“Oh, Father, baptize them with the Holy Ghost and fire, awaken them from slumber, and heal them. Oh Lord, we ask that you save them. Draw them near. Draw their hearts to you, God. We join with the Great Intercessor of Heaven for the souls to be saved, for family members to be saved, and for the city to be saved.”* Yes, we cry out to God, but it's God Almighty who does this. Do you understand? *“God causes the growth. Apart from Him, we do nothing.”* You understand that, *“Every good and perfect gift comes from Him above.”* But, we join Him in prayer. It is only God that draws to Himself. It is only God that brings life. *“Christ in us, the hope of glory,”* works through us, His Church, to awaken, to heal,

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to save and to deliver. Amen, "No one can come to the Father unless I draw them." Yes, "I draw all men to Myself. Yet, those I've drawn have been chosen." Oh, thank you, Lord. Thank you, Lord. If you are born again, you are chosen before the beginning, before the foundation of the world, to be His. Yet, He gives us a choice, that is something else. Say, "Thank You, Lord."

"I love the weak in heart and spirit." He says, "because I can boldly move. Pride always repels growth and humility." We don't want anything to do with pride. We want to say, "Yes, Lord, search me and know me," right? "I love the weak in heart and spirit." God loves the weak. Yes, He loves the weak. He loves to come to the weak in spirit, soul, body, in every way. He says, "Oh, I can move there. But, pride repels me." Correct? A haughty spirit, that's one of the things that God hates it says in Proverbs six. Why? He can't get into your heart, because you're repelling. You don't need Him. There's no, "fear of the Lord," correct? Thank the Lord, He loves weakness, but He says, "Let the weak say they're strong." Then He takes the weakness and He makes you strong. Say, "Hallelujah."

He says, *"I can overwhelm all with My presence, which is really what you're asking Me for." He says, "I can literally overwhelm everybody with My presence, which is what we are asking Him for." Literally, yes, that's what we want. That's the truth. I mean, you can pray for your friends, your family, your office, your neighbors, your street, your city, your nation, and not just the mission trips, correct? Everybody you know, "Lord God Almighty, overwhelm them with your presence." You know, I'm joining Heaven there, but I can't do it, right? It is by the grace of God. It's by the Spirit of God, that He draws all people to repentance.*

He says, *"I will overwhelm the Garden with My presence. Oh, I will overwhelm the Garden with My presence. As you seek My will, I will instruct you in the way. I will instruct you in the way. I will instruct you." How wonderful to know that God is saying, "I will instruct you." Especially when there are a lot of irons in the fire and there is a whole lot of high level stuff at stake. He says, "I will instruct you." Thank you, Lord. We are not orphans.*

He says, *"As you seek My will. All I need from you is a heart that is totally surrendered in order to hear My instruction." "Receive My instruction." It's one thing to hear it. It's another thing to receive it. Truth, I can hear it, but that doesn't mean I want to do it, right? I can hear it. "Oh, the Lord spoke to me this week." Did you do it? "No, no." Oh, "He told me about that three years ago." Did you do it? "No, no. I heard it, but I didn't receive it." Because when you receive the instruction, you're going to do it. When you adhere to the instruction, it's going to happen. It's going to manifest when we do what the Lord says. That's how the Kingdom increases. "He had been talking to me for 20 years, but I didn't receive the instruction. I didn't apply it." That's truth. We see that all the time. He wants our heart. He wants our heart.*

He says, *"As you seek My will, I will instruct you in the way." That's a comfort, isn't it. "As you seek My will, I will instruct you in the way. All I need from you is a heart totally surrendered in order to hear My instruction. Lay aside preconceived ideas." An interesting term, "preconceived." "Human thoughts, ideas, plans, inventions of the flesh, pride and self abasement." Ooh, I don't like that word. "I hate self abasement. It only leads to more pride, and it is not from My heart." Self abasement is when the flesh kicks in and tries to make God work according to the flesh. You can manipulate Him with any spiritual thing. You can manipulate with how much you read the word, how much you abide, how many verses you have memorized, how many trips you take, how many good works you do, how much fasting you do? In all these good works, you can try to manipulate anything. It's all self abasement. It's not just how you punish yourself, saying, "Oh, woe is me. I wound myself for you, Lord."*

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It is a religious spirit that will work against the Spirit of God and His instruction. Gets you offline, into your flesh, to draw God to yourself. Truth. So, He is illuminating, *“Lay aside preconceived ideas of how you think it's going to happen. Human thought, human ideas, human plans, inventions of your own flesh and pride as well as self abasement.”* See, that's what gets through. Cuts through all the way down into the heart, and gets in there to where God says, “I see that.” You say, “Well, I thought that was holy.” He goes, “No, that was self. No, that's self abasement. No, that's religion. No, that has nothing to do with My spirit. It has nothing to do with My power. It has nothing to do with My glory. As a matter of fact, it's seeking vain glory. It's seeking the glory of men. It's seeking glory from others. It's seeking that you'll actually get the credit for what you're doing.” It's really God doing it. That's deep.

He says, *“Receive My instruction. These are the things of the flesh and the deception of how I can come against you through religion. He says, ‘I hate self abasement. It only leads to more pride, and it's not from My heart.’* Jesus Christ is the perfect model of this, correct? We have a model. It's Jesus Christ, and He lives in us. Holy Ghost is going to show you dead works, right? He's going to show you that's your flesh. You think, “I'm going to do this for God.” He's says, “No, that's not Me. That's just you.” Usually there is a selfish motive behind it. I know He's speaking truth.

He says, *“I did ask you to die daily by taking up the cross.”* He said, *“Crucify the flesh and its desires, etc, but not to do the works of abasement, to try to overcome in the flesh by the flesh. The works of the flesh work against the flesh, but the work of the Spirit has dominion over the flesh. Flesh is going to profit nothing.”* I'm quoting you scripture. “Flesh will profit nothing.” It's like, “I'm going to do it. I'm going to do it.” He says, *“Receive My instruction and just do what I say.”* That self, that pride, that vainness, that haughtiness, that religious spirit wants to get you into the rut of human works. Wow. See, God's going to light a fire to that.

He says, *“Take up your cross daily and follow Me.”* Those words are from Jesus. *“I die daily, but He lives. It's no longer I that lives, but Christ that lives in me.”* I recognize that. We honor that. We teach that. “It's Christ in me, the hope of glory. It's Christ in me.” I can smell a rat a mile away, when it's just a little bit off. That's what the Spirit does, and we have to lean into His heart to choose to reveal more by the Spirit. We're vessels of honor who hear by the Spirit. We're vessels of honor who attend to the Spirit. We're vessels of honor who say, “He's so holy and I am nothing, but you are everything. Instruct me in the way that I should go.”

He says, *“I choose to reveal more by the Spirit to those I have chosen to reveal them.”* Now that is something else. We could go back. We weren't Daniel in the Bible, correct? I wasn't Moses in the Bible. I wasn't even Jonah in the Bible. Thank the Lord. I wasn't Mary in the Bible, right? I wasn't Peter in the Bible. You are who God called you to be. It is by His Spirit that He's saving all these humans. It's His Spirit that says, “This is what I've ordained for you.” It's like, “Oh, there's the book of Kimmi,” right? Because, it's all about your journey. God sees that, and He's working to reveal and bring and give the instruction to bring Kimmi into the fullness that God has ordained for her. They come before the beginning of time, correct? Yet it is the same Spirit that was in Daniel, that's in us. The wonderful thing about Daniel was He came upon him, but He wasn't in him, yet. We have the Holy Ghost inside of us, because of Jesus's death and resurrection. Hallelujah. How good is this? We are not orphaned. We are not orphaned. We have a God giving us instruction. Wasn't that good news? “Deep calls to deep.”

Isaiah 30:21

See, God is revealing by the Spirit. He's wanting to reveal. He's wanting to lead us. He's wanting to instruct us, even now. He prophesied through Isaiah, “Your ears shall hear a word behind you.”

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I was talking about coming up out of you, around you, and into you. He's always guiding us. "This is the way walk in it." There's that instruction. "Do this. Go here. No, no, no. Yes, yes, yes." Yes, whenever you turn to the right or when you turn the left in any area of your path, God Almighty is there. We are not orphans. We are receiving instruction from the Father to accomplish His will, personally and corporately. He gives the instruction in the night. He's really emphasizing that. When He says that to me, I'm like, "Yes, sir. I submit to that. I receive that." Then you wake up in the morning and you go about your day. Who's to say that the word and the manifestation of life is coming out of you, because it comes from the season in the night where God has been imparting that. God has been sealing that. God has been giving you insight. Then it bubbles up and it comes out of you. You find yourself walking in the way that is right. Hallelujah, you're like, "That sounds like cheating." No, it's awesome, because God gives you the answers in the night, even before you ask Him. How good is that?

He knows what He put you here for. He knows the desires in your heart. He knows you're bent. He knows your weaknesses, and even in the night seasons, He's always working. Hallelujah, *"I give instruction in the night, and direction and revelation are brought to light during the day."* Whoo, hallelujah. Sometimes you say, "I don't know what happened. I just woke up in a good mood today. Yesterday was hell. Man, I worked *hard*. I woke up good mood today." Why? Because somebody's been talking to you while you sleep. Somebody's been ministering to you and healing you and restoring your soul, even while slept. Someone's given you counsel, Someone has given you all that boring stuff called wisdom and revelation and knowledge and counsel and the intent of His heart. Somebody's instructing you in the night seasons. Your spirit man is up front and center. One with God in Christ, in heavenly places. You are seated in heavenly places. We are literally ruling and reigning with Christ it says in Ephesians, truth. That direction and revelation are brought to light during the day. I'm going to manifest it. Amen. I'm going to do it. I'm going to follow that instruction. Truth. Some of you have been looking for answers for a while. Be encouraged. Amen. It's like the seed of the man planted in the womb of a woman, it's always working. God, put it in there, and He causes that growth. Correct?

He says, *"I have planted My word in you, and you conceive and you bring forth My good intention, purpose and plans."* What an amazing thing to know that we are being used to do the Father's will, and to bring forth His good intention. He instructed us, we do it. We find ourselves in the path that He has directed for us. I know when I'm out of it. I know when I'm on the wrong path, and you do, too. For the most part, we know it's like, "That was not the way to go. That was not the right response. That was flesh." We all know this, but it is the Spirit that's working with us to adhere to the instructions of the Lord. He will bring forth His good intention, purpose and plan. When we ask God, what is your will here? Know and believe He's going to reveal it, but it may not come while you're thinking of it and trying to find it in your journal that day, but as you sleep.

He says, *"I will instruct you in the night. I'm coming to you, I'm imparting and giving you instruction."* He's making up for a lot of lost time. Amen. *"All other plans are distractions to My will and Spirit in this time and season and region. Follow the course I have set for you. This is a regional move here, and I'm Lord of it. I will continue to lead each step as you confidently rely upon My grace to envelop every step, decision, thought, dreams and plans."* Say, "The Lord is the leader."

He says, *"I know the way. I am the way, and you shall walk in it. 'Walk with Me in white.' Yes, meditate on wisdom, counsel, knowledge and receive My instruction."* Now, He gives us a warning to beware of diversion. *"Beware of diversion, not listening to My instruction and the way of the Spirit. It will lead you on another path and Spirit that I did not give you, nor did I instruct you in."*

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Diversion, everybody knows what a diversion is, right? *“Simply allowing self to lead, guide and direct out of the mandates of your own heart versus Mine.”* So, we need the Spirit up front and center. We're following the Spirit of God. We're following His truth and His word. You know when the flesh steps in and says, “No, I want to do this.” Correct? Pretty simple, *“Don't allow the self to lead. Diversion opposes My instruction and the way of the Spirit. Where the flesh has dominion versus following the instructions of the Lord, the flesh will take you wandering in the wilderness for 40 years.”* Oh, yuck. We don't want that. We don't want death. We don't want that at all. We don't want doubt and unbelief. I want to be in the path of the Father's instruction. Right there, in that word, believe it or not, He's instructing us. Even if you just read one chapter that day, He has instructed you. *“Beware of diversion. Don't try to add to it. Just be obedient and do it. It takes great faith to simply believe Me. Don't miss the mark, which is sin. Be faithful and consistent.”*

Proverbs 14:12

That's just the truth. That's humans. When we think that's right, and a lot of people think things are right right, now, and they're not right. Is that right or wrong? Well, okay, thank God we have the Holy Ghost in us to tell us these things. *“Beware of diversion. There is a way that seems right to the man, but the end thereof is destruction. Beware of self gratification in the Spirit or trying to appease people, because of the compromising spirit.”* Don't be a man pleaser. Please God, serve man, right? Watch out for that man pleasing compromising spirit.

He says, *“Fear me. Don't fear men. Beware of self gratification.”* Because you know, when you're in the flesh. You know, I'm talking about your flesh, that kind of puffs up like a rooster. “Boy, I felt good.” You know, you just feel so good about yourself. The Lord's says, “Yeah, it was all you all right.” There it is, okay?

“Be aware of self gratification in the flesh and trying to please people by a compromising spirit. It starts out slow and deceptive, and then it leads you away from the course that I have for you.” This keeps me in line. This keeps me humble. It keeps me in need for God, because the whole wide world lies under the sway of evil one, and we are light in a dark place. We have the Spirit of Truth. We have the Spirit of God in us. We're receiving instruction in the night. We awake morning by morning as His disciple. We hear the word, saying, This is the way walk in it. We fear God and we keep His commandments. When we're off, we repent, and He forgives us. Then we get back on track. Yes, be yes. No, be No. We follow the Lord. He's instructing us, Beloved. He's telling us. He's instructing us overall.

As I wrap this up with a summary from a whole bunch of verses of truth, listen to this. It says,

“God opens our ears to instruction, and He commands that we turn from iniquity. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools will despise wisdom and instruction. Hear My children the instruction of a Father. Give attention to know understanding. Take firm hold of instruction. Don't let go of her, for she is your life. For the commandment is a lamp and the law a light. Reproofs of instruction are the way of life. It is a part of life, correct? Receive My instruction, and not silver, and knowledge rather than choice gold. Hear instruction. Be wise. Don't disdain it. Give instruction to a wise man. He's going to be wiser still. You can't out give God. He who keeps instruction is in the way of life, but he who refuses correction goes astray. Whoever loves instruction, loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid. That's what the Proverbs say. A wise son heeds his father's instruction, but a scoffer does not listen to rebuke. The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom, and before honor is humility. Listen to counsel, receive instruction that you may be wise in your latter days.”

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Apply your heart to instruction and your ears to words of knowledge. Buy the truth. Don't sell it. Also wisdom and instruction and understanding. I said, surely you will fear Me, you will receive instruction for all scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, reproof, for correction and for instruction in righteousness." Amen, amen.

We will have this out for you to hear and meditate upon. We say, "Yes, Lord." Now when the Father's telling us, "*I'm imparting instruction to you in the night season,*" we get to say, "Woohoo, Yes, Lord." We get to humble ourselves and say, "Here we are, Lord." When we've been in the flesh and self abasement of religion, we have to repent of that mess. Get in the fire and line up with what He's saying. He will instruct us along the way, even when you need answers and a decision.

"Father, we thank you for your word. We're listening. Thank you that we're not orphans. Thank you that you instruct us in the way that we should go. Thank you that you will instruct us in the way that we should go because you're so good to us. We receive your instruction. We receive your instruction. We receive your wisdom and counsel and knowledge, Lord. We receive the fear of the Lord. We receive your guidance. We receive your glory. We thank you for the refining work you do in your Bride and how you prepare us to hold the glory of the Lord. We love you, Lord. We treasure your heart. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen."
