

Title: Living Revelation

Today, we are going to talk about glory in the Lord and His presence. Every day we receive living revelation. If you have truly been born again from above, then Christ is in you. If you have been born again from above, if you have made Jesus Christ, your Lord and Savior, if you worship and serve Him only, if He is your King, your God and Savior, there is Living Revelation that God imparts to us by His Spirit every day. It is not just something you do at a conference or maybe on a Sunday morning or a special class. Jesus Christ is living and He is revelation. He is revelation. He is truth. So, we abide with and indwell with "Living Revelation." God is not dead. I love how only the Lord can minister to every soul. We are all different. We are all in different places in life. Yes, not just *in* age, but in our walk, our journey, where we are at, what difficulties we may be walking in, what joys we are just rejoicing in, where we may be with struggle, where we may be with victories, or where we are just growing.

You know, God plants the seed in the woman, yes, and there He creates a human being by His word. He comes and He implants His word inside of us, and from that moment forward, we are living, breathing, born again, new life, and a new creation. He is always transforming us. There is Living Revelation inside of us, Living Revelation. Christ is not dead. He is alive and He is living. He lives in each and every one of us. He knows where we are at, and He knows where He is taking us. He knows the revelation you need today, tomorrow, next week, and in 10 years or 30 years from now. He knows the future. He knows our past, and yet He still calls us into revelation. He calls us into knowledge. He calls us into understanding. He calls us into wisdom. He calls us into His Kingdom. He calls us into the Kingdom of Heaven. He calls us saints. He calls us kings and priests.

Every day is a new day to be able to encounter God. Yes, we want to encounter God. We want to know God. We do not want to just know about Him, right? Because, that won't get me to Heaven. It won't get me to Heaven. There is only one way. My soul gets to repent. My soul gets to lay low, repent of my sins, call upon the name of Lord and be saved. Then the Spirit of God comes and lives inside of us. Once the Spirit of God comes and lives inside of us, you are joint heirs with Christ, kings and priests, children of God, and born again, ones. Every day is new, and one day we go to glory. We all graduate and get to go on to Heaven, hallelujah. But, the journey is just continuing on. Okay? It is not like the time on Earth was just a waste. Let us just get to Heaven and start new, right? No, this is where we start, because He is redeeming all things from the Earth where He sent His Word. Yes, and from that point forward, He is continuing to bring Living Revelation. We will do that for all eternity, correct? This is the truth. We do not want to be dead. We do not want to be without life and courage and hope. That is why it is called, "Christ in you, the hope of glory."

Revelation 1:4-6 NKJV

We love this passage. Say, "I am living, breathing, fresh, in Living Revelation." Amen. Everything I was discussing with you earlier is represented by the fullness of the Holy Spirit, the sevenfold Spirit of God.

Isaiah 11:2 NKJV

In this passage, it is introduced and then in the book of Revelation, which is a revelation of Jesus Christ. That is why it is entitled, Revelation, right? It is not just a revelation of the end times. It is "revelation," of Jesus Christ. If you have been born again, there it is, right there. Revelation of Jesus Christ, all the way until God calls us home, is what the Lord is doing. He is doing this with us as soon as we are born again. He is removing every veil, every block, every

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evil mindset, all unbelief, doubts, bad self worth, bad self image, all self, self, self. The moment we step into the Kingdom, "revelation of Jesus Christ," has come.

Revelation 1:4-6 NKJV

This letter starts out, "Grace to you and peace from Him," Jesus Christ. "Grace to you and peace from Him," Jesus Christ. "Grace to you, and peace from Him, who is, who was and is to come." He is the fullness of all things. This is who we love. This is who we worship. This is who we praise. This is why we do what we do in our own personal time, corporately together, in small groups, or wherever you may go. This is the believers call to walk with, in and through God and Jesus Christ, the One. He is revealing Himself every day. No wonder He had to say, "Grace and peace be multiplied to you. Grace and peace be multiplied to you." Because, the Revelator, Jesus Christ, is revealing every day who He is to you. It is not just something in the future. We are carrying living hope. Yes, the Gospel is Living Hope. It is the Good News of salvation. "Grace and peace to you from Him," from God, Jesus Christ, and Holy Ghost from Heaven, being manifested and revealed by Himself as soon as you are born again. It is His grace and goodness as saved, just to start with, because the Spirit was moving and the Spirit was hovering the moment you were conceived in your mother's womb from that day to the day and moment that you breathed in life and were born again from above. Because, Jesus said you must be born again.

John 3:3 NKJV

"You must be born again." That is the truth. Something is happening in us, Church. Something is happening. You may have given your heart to Jesus when you were six. You may have just given your heart to Jesus last week. Some give their heart to Jesus on the deathbed, when elderly and over 80, because grace and peace is coming forth from Heaven constantly to those on the Earth, to give hope and opportunity. You say, "Well, they did not have an opportunity on the Earth to really come to know Him." Boom, they were launched right into the same glory that we will be launched into, yes. If I have lived and walked with Him all my life for 80 years, and they got born again on their deathbed at 85, they stepped into the same inheritance. They stepped into the glory of God, because grace and peace is coming from Him to bring people into revelation. We have just got a better testimony on the Earth, right? We said, "Well, once I was lost, but now I am saved. Once I was blind, but now I see." Then God uses that testimony while we are on the planet to get others in. It is not just for you. Truth.

"Grace to you, and peace from Him who is, who was and who is to come, Jesus Christ, the Word of God, and from the seven spirits who are before His throne." There is constant revelation coming towards us. That is why we have been stewarding His word. We all have eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand. As we go about our journey and our walk in this life, we are not just going along the same old, dull, have to go to work, in a drab life. We are constantly being pursued by Living Revelation. We are being pursued by living understanding. We are being pursued by living wisdom. We are being pursued by the power and might of God. We are being pursued by the word of God Himself. That is why sometimes you feel this draw to the word, saying, "I just have to really read Ezra right now." You have no idea why, but you go and open the book, and the Holy Ghost starts revealing to you what He needs to talk to you about in Ezra, correct? You say, "I am remembering this verse all day long. I do not know why I am singing it. I do not know why I am thinking about it. I have just heard it all day long." That is the Spirit of God. That is the "grace and peace coming towards you from the seven spirits before the throne," who sees you, knows you, and is abiding within you. Living Revelation is pouring out to draw you in. This is revelation of Jesus Christ, truth. It goes on from the seven spirits who are before His throne, and from Jesus Christ, the Faithful Witness, hallelujah! He was the Faithful Witness.

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Then He tells us, "You are My witnesses. You are going to go around and be a living witness of the revelation that I am bringing to you now." Even if you just got born again, *which* is really when you are at your hottest time in life. You really do not care what people think at that point. You say, "Man, you know what happened to me? Jesus Christ came, and He revealed Himself to me! I have been snatched out of hell! I have been given eternal life! I was baptized into Him! I am saved now! I get to live forever, and I am on fire! So, everybody needs to get saved, right! That is the truth. Okay, we start there, and that is a good start. Then the devil comes to put you sleep. Saying, "Back off, dude. You are saving too many souls. You are a little extreme. You are a little fanatical. You are a little bit too much on fire." He works to put you back to sleep. That is his assignment. "The devil comes to kill, steal and destroy." But Jesus said, "I have come to give you life and life more abundant." So you understand the battleground there?

He is a faithful witness. We are faithful witnesses. Say, "I am His witness." "He is the Firstborn from the dead." Wow. Jesus is the, "Firstborn from the dead." We are following His lead. One day we shall be resurrected. Correct, the same resurrection that raised Him is going to raise our mortal bodies, Hallelujah! Hallelujah, but right now, your spirit is eternal. Right now, your spirit man is as alive as it is going to get. Right now, your spirit man is breathing in, breathing life, receiving the Word of God, revelation. Your spirit is like, wow. Jesus Christ is being revealed in our spirit and is invading our soul, our mind, our will and emotion. It hits that body, and all of a sudden, you become a faithful witness of the First Born from the Dead, the Ruler over the kings of the Earth.

You serve the greatest King, the King of kings, and Lord of lords. You serve the greatest God. "God Almighty, in Jesus Christ, sent His only begotten Son into the world to save us." But, we are not just "saved." Hallelujah! Now, "We "have to" go to church, and we "have to" read the Bible, and we "have to" take communion, and we "have to,... right? "No, that is dead works. That is religion. That is what the devil wants you to think." God said, "No, you have entered into a "Living Revelation." You have entered into a "living covenant," with God through Jesus Christ. You have entered into a living, breathing, fresh relationship, and are a brand new, born again, new creation. The old is gone. You are not even the same being. You have been translated, transported out of darkness and into His marvelous light. He calls us all kinds of things, but He calls us kings and priests. He calls us faithful witnesses. He calls us carriers. We are loaded with Living Revelation. Even if you wake up on the wrong side of the bed, He is still saying, "I am still here." Correct? "I am still here. I am the same, yesterday, today and forever. I am still the same." Even if it is a rough journey and there is a struggle, He has not changed. He has not changed. He will never change. Amen, that is what we are talking about.

As the Lord tries to awaken His people, it is not about anything that is fake. It is living, breathing revelation from Jesus Christ, and you have to know this. You have to know in whom you believe. You have to "know that you know, that you know, that you know, and nothing can move you from it. Nothing can shake you from it. Nobody can talk you out of it." Yes, no apostate being, nobody can talk you out of the Word of God and the truth of Jesus Christ. Nobody, we can yield our ear to hear it, but the Living One in you has said, "No, this is the way, walk in it." He has high standards for His Bride. He does. He has a high standard for His Bride, the Church. It is constant in our hearts. "Oh, God, show us your glory." It is constant in our hearts, where we want to be in His presence, because it is where His presence is, that is where He is. Every day we are abiding in His presence. You do not have to "go over there," to abide with Him. You do not have to be, "in that seat," to encounter Him. It is a living, breathing relationship every day with the King of Glory, the King of kings and the Lord of lords.

You say, "Man, I am rich. I am special. I have been chosen. I am called. I am appointed. I am appointed to bear much fruit. How can I serve you today, King of glory?" Because, "You are in me, and I am in you, and I am carrying your glory within me." It is that living witness.

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Jesus came to the Earth to save, heal and deliver, so now you are on the planet to save, heal and deliver, period. The works that He does you will do also. "Greater works will you do," He said. "Because, I am going to go back to the Father, but I am going to give you the great, Holy Ghost. He is going to live in you and abide in you. Matter of fact, I am going to baptize in fire." Whoo, you and Him in fire. You are going to be set on fire, living fire, a flame that cannot be put out. You are going to go light everybody else up, and get them filled with the Holy Ghost so they can do these works, truth!"

All of this from "Grace and peace to you from Him who is and was and is to come," every day. Because, if you put it in the future and not your today, you miss the revelation of Jesus Christ. We need revelation of Jesus Christ today. Today, while it is called today, and that is where we grow. The flesh is always going to suffer a bit. The flesh says, "Nah, I do not know about that. I do not know, sister. That sounds too good to be true." Well, that is what the Word says. As I yield to the word, I am transformed. "Be transformed by the renewing of your mind," correct? That is what the Spirit of God is doing. He is preparing a Bride. He is preparing someone to walk with Him in glory. We do not have to wait till we die to see the glory of God. The moment we are born again, the glory of God was manifested to us. The moment we were born again.

Wow. Because, repentance is a gift from God. Okay, it is a gift. Only God can cause growth. Only God can create. Only God can bring something back to life. Only God can save us in our sin. Only God can do these things. God causes the growth. He is Creator. He is Almighty. He is the Lord God Almighty. You were formed and fashioned in His image and likeness for great things. The greatest of all is to know Him, and to be found in Him. Wow. But, here is the deal. He is a worker, He is a laborer, He is a harvester, He is a sower. He is going to go and He is going to bring in. He has died for peoples from the beginning to the end and nations. He has died for souls to come into the Father's house for the Father's glory, and the Father says, "Oh, My Son has paid the price, and I want to give Him all these nations and all these peoples."

Every day we are abiding and dwelling in that place. It is all about Him. Yet we are working with Him as we yield to Living Revelation. Say, "Living Revelation," and all we have to do is ask for it. All we have to do is shift the way we are thinking. To say, "Alright, Lord, I am in you, and you are in me, and we are one. I am walking with you. I am in you. "Christ in me is the hope of glory." So, I am going to give you all my glory, and I want to host your presence. I want to host your glory, and I am going to walk with you to the end." There is one message, "Abide in Me, and My Word. Abide and remain with Me, and in My word. The Spirit of God will rest here, and you will bear much fruit, so My Father can be glorified."

He gives you this clean heart. You say, "It does not feel very clean, God." He is renewing that mind. You say, "It does not feel like it is very renewed right now, because while I am worshiping, I am thinking about work this week. While I am worshiping and trying to praise you, I am worried about my finances. While I am worshiping and praising you, I am thinking with the accuser of the brethren about what so and so did, and I am not happy with them. I have been caught up over here thinking about that conflict while I am in praise." Well be of good cheer, because that is what it looks like. Here you are on the planet. You choose to step into the glory of God with Living Revelation. You start praising Him, loving Him, giving yourself to Him, and all those things in the soul, they just start rising up, rising up, rising up. You say, "Oh, get out of my mind. Why am I thinking about my accounting books right now?" Rising up, rising up, rising up. "Why am I thinking about vacation next week." Rising it comes up, up, up.

There are answers from the Living Revelator, the living Christ. He is going to take those burdens from you. He is going to lift those things from you. Then all of a sudden, when you are more mature in your thoughts, you think, "Wait a minute. I am going to cast down every vain imagination. I know right now that is from the accuser of the brethren. I have no participation

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with you. I cast you down and out.” There is that second Heaven hitting. Hitting first Heaven, second Heaven, third Heaven. Here you are receiving Living Revelation. All the stuff in your soul from the week is rising, rising, rising. Then, it is all taken away in a blink of an eye. You stepped in to a higher glory. You stepped in to the presence of the living God who loves you, who died for you, who sees your burden, your hurt, your pain, and your sorrow. But, you chose to have faith, and to step in and say, “Bless the Lord, oh my soul. Bless the Lord, oh my soul. Forget not any of His benefits. Bless the Lord. Oh my soul, who forgives all my sins, removes my iniquities as far as the east is from the west. Oh, bless the Lord. Oh my soul, I will not forget, truth.” That is what is happening. Yes, you know what I am talking about. I know you do. We are in and with Living Revelation.

How can somebody come up here and be waving a flag and they are in their head thinking of such and such while they are waving the flag? That is what it looks like in these fleshly bodies. I am not accusing any of the flaggers. It is just the warring of flesh in the body against the spirit. The *enemy* says, “No, you just stay right there in your mud. Don't come up here. No, you just stay stuck. You just stay worried, you just stay anxious, you just stay whatever. But, do not come up here into the glory.” Because when you get into the glory, you are going to encounter Living Revelation, wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, and the fear of the Lord. You are going to encounter His holiness, His mercy, and His grace. That is why all of a sudden you start to feel a trembling, because now your heart knows you see the King. All of a sudden, your heart has been quickened, and your love is there. You find yourself saying, “No, I just love you. Lord, I just love you.” That is all you can say. But, right there, you overcame!

We are living! So, “Grace and peace to you from Him who is and was and is to come.” This is not just a future work. It started the moment we have been born again. But, it was before the foundation of the world that Jesus Christ called you to Himself. He knows those who are His, and the devil wants to convince you that you are not. He is a liar. What do you expect? We have nothing to do with Him. That is when you bring out the Scripture. It is when you bring out the Word, I have been blood bought and sanctified. Just bring the Word. Just bring the Word. That is all you have to do. “The enemy comes and kills, steals and destroys.” Just bring the Word. The enemy will flee from you. “He goes around like a roaring lion, seeking who He can devour.” I am just saying that is what it looks like. I wish there was nothing that could come along our way and disrupt our thinking. In Heaven, there won't be any of that. But right now, we are overcoming just as our King did, yes?

The Sower went out to sow. That is Jesus Christ. God sowed Himself into the Earth. Isn't that amazing? God sowed Himself into the Earth. Say, “I am receiving living revelation and we are all growing.” Amen, thank God.

John 1:1-18 AMPC

It says, “In the beginning, before all time, was the Word (Christ), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Himself.” Wow. So, Living Revelation told that to the Apostle John by the Holy Ghost, and he writes the testimony. He did not come up with this on his own. He walked and talked with Jesus Christ. Jesus taught Him all these things, and now He writes to the Churches. This is still Living Revelation. That is why, when you read it, “whoa,” you can feel His presence. You can feel the stirring. “In the beginning, before all time, was the Word, (Christ), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Himself.” “To Him who is and was and is to come.” Wow, right there.

2) “He was present originally with God. 3) All things were made and came into existence through Him. Without Him was not even one thing made that has come into being.” That settles it to me. Father God, Jesus Christ, the great Holy Ghost. One God, Jesus Christ, the Word of God, the Messiah, the Truth, and the Helper. He has come. There it is. “All things were

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made in the beginning,” Genesis chapter one, verse one, right? That is what it looks like. Jesus is Lord. Wow. He was pursuing me from the beginning. He knew me. Living Revelation was thinking about us before we even came into being. He already knew. He knew. He knew about the freckle on your nose, the color of your hair, how tall you are going to be, and what you are going to do in life. That is amazing. So, when we worry about something. You think, “Why am I worrying? Because, this is the One we are walking with. Why am I worried?” He knows. He knows what I have need of, yes? Wow, “All things were made,” that is a big statement, “and came into existence through Him.”

3) “All things were made and came into existence through Him and without Him was not even one thing made that has come into being.” Wow, say, “I matter.”

4) “In Him was Life and the Life was the Light of men.” Okay, that shows me, in Him was Life and now that Life is coming towards mankind and the children on the planet. God wants to abide with and make His own His family.

5) “And the Light shines on in the darkness, for the darkness has never overpowered it.” Hallelujah!, “Put it out or absorbed it or appropriated it, and it is unreceptive to it.”

6) There came a man sent from God, whose name was John.” This is about John the Baptist.

7) “This man came to witness,” Living Revelation. “This man came to witness that he might testify of the Light,” which is Jesus Christ, “That all men might believe in it.” That is a big statement. This man, John the Baptist, came to witness that he might testify of the Light, that all men might believe in it.” That tells me revelation of Jesus Christ is available to all who are born on the planet period, end of discussion. Yes, this revelation of Jesus Christ is available to all. But, we know by the end of the book that not all will receive the Light. Not all will repent. Not all will choose God and what is right and righteous. There is a reserve for them, hell. An eternal hell separates them from the Mighty God and Living Revelation for eternity. But, to those who are of the Light have chosen the grace saying, “I have received it. Yes, Lord, I believe you. I give you my whole heart.” We have an eternal, glorious future in Heaven with Christ, truth! You are either in or you are out. There is no in between, “Sorry,” right? There is no holding place, right? You are either in or you are out. “This man came to witness that he might testify of the Light, that all men might believe.” So that is my mission. I want all men to believe. That is all mankind, correct? “That all men might believe in it, to adhere to it, trust it and rely upon it through him.

8) He was not the Light himself, but came that he might bear witness regarding this great Light.” There is that witness. There is that living witness. This is what happened to us as soon as we are born again from above. We become that living witness of the Light.

9) “There it was —the true Light [was then] coming into the world [the genuine, perfect, steadfast Light] that illumines every person.” Say, “Living Revelation.” Wow, it is hard to believe that someone could once encounter Jesus Christ, go to church, or maybe even confess, but then years down the road, they turn away and forsake Him. Hard to believe. Yes, you say, “Oh, but God knows those who are His.” Oh, it is the truth. That is why they call this, “apostasy.” An apostate is one who once worked and went to church and served God, but now have fallen away and do not even claim that the Word of God is God's mighty word, but call it a good moral book. That is why you see in Thessalonians that the dark one won't come until the apostasy happens first. People have been falling away from the truth for a long time. Nothing new under the sun, but it is going to increase more and more. The Light's going to get brighter. Our living witness of the glory, the revelation of Jesus, is going to grow stronger and stronger. You are committed, and you know that God keeps you. That is why it is shocking to you when

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you hear them say, "Oh we don't believe in A, B, C, D, anymore." Who deceived you? What wicked serpent spoke to you and told you that error? Because, if you do not abide and remain in the word, you will say, "Oh, I did not even know it was written." If you are in some foreign place and did not even get a Bible, when you are born again to the bone, you have got the Living Word in you, telling you, "That is not me. This is the truth. Walk in it, correct?" He has got everybody covered. You ask, "What about those who are underground living in prisons?" Yes, the Word Christ is manifesting. Living Revelation is coming to them every day. Isn't that glorious? "Where can you go from His presence?" I think that is in the Psalms. Okay, you are hearing what He is saying. Wow!

10) "He came into the world, and though the world was made through Him, the world did not recognize Him [did not know Him]." When He came to His own, they said, "I do not know who you are."

11) He came to that which belonged to Him, [to His own— His domain, creation, things, world], and they who were His own did not receive Him and did not welcome Him." How can this be Lord?

12) "But to as many as did receive and welcome Him, He gave the authority (power, privilege, right) to become children of God, that is to those who believe in (adhere to, trust in and rely on) His name." Wow, this is rich. "But to as many as did receive and welcome Him." Those who are born again. "Yes, Lord. You are Lord. I welcome you. I live with you. I choose you. You are the Messiah. You are the Christ. You are God in the flesh. You are the Son of the Most High God. Yes, this is who you are. I believe it. I repent. I receive you. I receive forgiveness." That right there, "To as many as did receive and welcome Him." Why would Living Revelation choose to give us authority, power, privileges and rights? We just came out of darkness. Why would He entrust to us His Holy Ghost? Why would He even give us a Word when we might have read it wrong and interpreted it wrong? Because, He grows us up. He matures us in the Holy Ghost, truth. He will lead you into all truth. He will tell you of things to come. "Do not worry, the Spirit of Truth, He will teach you. He will tell you everything you need to know about me. I am not going to leave you as orphans. I have come to you especially in your troubles." Oh, my God, that nearness of God is our good. "To as many as did receive and welcome Him." See, I did receive Him. I had welcomed Him, and now He has given us His "authority (power, privilege, right)." We are children of God. That is to those who believe in and hear and trust and rely upon His name, because that is our hope. Apart from Him, we are nothing. Apart from Him, I am nothing, absolutely nothing. So you can't boast in what He has given you, but you are going to give all glory, honor and praise to Him who has chosen the Truth. "I hate dead works. I hate religion." We want life and life abundantly. I do not want "have to's okay?" You won't survive very long in the Kingdom, if you "have to." But, if your desire is Him, He will lead you in the way of glory. If your desire is the glory of God, He will lead you there. He has dedicated His life to bring you into the glory of God. He has laid down His life to get the Holy Ghost inside of you. He has laid down His life and went to that cross so that God Almighty could come and live in us, and we can receive an inheritance. My goodness, this is His will. He is amazing, isn't He!

13) "Who owe their birth neither to bloods nor to the will of the flesh [that of the physical impulse] nor to the will of man [that of a natural father], but to God. [they are born of God!]" We have literally been born of God. God is our Father, Jesus says, "My Father." That is why He told us, "You pray this way, my Father, who art in Heaven, Holy is Your Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven." Oh, my goodness, "Father, Father, Father, yes!" Father, Father, Father and the more you say this, the more revelation, Living Revelation, comes into you. He, Father through the Holy Ghost, shows you the Living Revelation, the Christ. If you be in Him, He is for you for eternity. He will use you as that living witness until you go see Him. Amen. "Do not fear little flock, the Father has chosen to give you the Kingdom." Truth.

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14) And the Word (Christ) became flesh (human, incarnate) and tabernacled (fixed His tent of flesh, lived awhile) among us; and we (actually) saw His glory (His honor, His majesty), such glory as an only begotten Son receives from His Father, full of grace (favor, loving-kindness) and truth." They say, "We saw the Son of God. He came to the Earth in the flesh, just like us. He came to the Earth to save us, the families on the Earth. He came and became flesh, and then He was crucified in the flesh to save us. That is amazing. That is that revelation of this Living Word. Oh my, God, this is what He did. We saw it. We saw the glory. We know who He is. He is full of grace and love and honor and truth. There is that witness that comes out of us every day. Every saint is a minister. Wherever we are on the planet. Whatever we are doing in your home, with your family and your children, at work or abroad, and even going to play tennis for fun. Wherever we put our feet, that living, breathing Word is there, the glory is there, and He uses us as lights in the world. Not just in times of trouble, but when there is trouble, who are they going to call? "Hello, I need you to pray for me. Can you come and pray for so and so? Can you do this? Can you be there to join me in prayer?" Okay, that is the witness. They saw your witness, and now they are following because there is something different about you. There is something different about you. That is how it works. The first couple that brought the Gospel of true salvation to us, were friends that we had in college. We were newly married. They got born again to the bone, and so my awesome, fleshly lost soul said to them, "Are you on some kind of religious high?" Those were my words. I was a good Methodist girl that went to church sometimes. But, I believed in God. I really did. I believed in Jesus as God. I did all that, but I did not yet know Him as Jesus Christ, Lord and Savior in my heart. To me, that was my judgment. But that was their witness. The Holy Ghost takes over and does His work, right? Before you know it, my husband and I are on our face, repenting and making Jesus Christ Lord and Master of our lives. Truth. That is how you get in. Somebody came in your midst and was glowing. Somebody stood in truth. "Why are you not worried? Why did you choose to pray for me when I was sick, right? Why did you choose to visit me when I was in prison? Why did you come to me when I was troubled? That is what the message is of the Anointed One. He says, "If you did it to them, you did it to me," correct? This is from last week. "Now, this Word became flesh. He tabernacled among us. He is living with us, and we saw His glory."

15) "John testified about Him, and cried out." This is John the Baptist. "This was He, of Whom I said. This is the One." That is what He said. He is it, guys, that is Him. He is the One. Say, "He is the One." Wow. "John testified about Him and cried out. This was He of whom I said, He who comes after me has priority over me, for He was before me." This is a prophet. This is John the Baptist, who prepared the way for the Lord, correct? "He is the One." There it is, he too had to receive Living Revelation. Then the Holy Ghost showed him, He is the One. Truth. You hear it, okay? I am just saying it is for everyone. It is for everyone, from the greatest to the end. "He was before me. [He takes rank above me, for He existed before I did. He has advanced before me, because He is my Chief.] That is John the Baptist, and he is an awesome prophet. Jesus said, "He was the greatest of all." It looks like that. You see, "How much can I give and trust God to come? How much Living Revelation do I really want?" When we abide and remain in His Word, we are literally abiding with that Christ. The wholeness, the Spirit of Truth, He is ministering, wisdom, revelation, counsel, might, deliverance, healing, freedom, and power. He is restoring our soul. He is renewing our mind. He is raising us up to be these witnesses to believe in God the Father, truth.

16) "For out of His fullness (abundance) we have all received. [All had a share, and we were all supplied with] one grace after another, and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favor upon favor and gift [heaped] upon gift." Wow. I thought I just got saved and went to church. I have to read my Bible and pray now. No, you stepped into a living, breathing covenant with God Almighty, His Son and the Holy Ghost and the Kingdom of Heaven. All that belongs to Him belongs to you, and you belong to God, and you belong to Christ. That is truth. That is scripture. Out of His fullness and abundance, Christ, and His abundance, we have all

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received. This is amazing. Listen to this glory. "All had a share and were supplied with one grace after another." You say, "Oh, thank you for your grace, Lord. Oh, thank you. I missed it there. Thank you for your forgiveness, Lord. Oh, I was wrong. Thank you for forgiving me, Lord." One grace after another. One empowerment to do good. "Oh, thank you God that you put in me to do good. Thank you that you put in me to do the right thing. Thank you that you put in me and gave me the grace to stand against my adversary, the liar. Thank You that You gave me grace to forgive." It is daily bread, one grace after another. We have all received, and had a share. We were all supplied with one grace after another. It wasn't just what you got when you got saved. Good luck for the rest of the world. I hope you make it, bless God. "One grace after another, and spiritual blessing after spiritual blessing." I do not think we even fathom or know what that is. I think there is a scripture. "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no heart has even thought or entered into the heart of man, what God has planned for those who love Him." That is where that is. "Well, I have to let go of this religious line. I have to get out of that region of captivity that has me in bondage and laboring to do good or right. I have to step into Living Revelation. I want to see your glory, Lord. God shows up and says, "Ask for the Shekinah glory of God." That means I am going to come in a way that is so holy that you did not even see it coming. I am going to come. I am going to come in a way that is so holy. I am going to bring Heaven in a way that you never saw coming. You were stuck in religion and dead works. But, I am going to bring you out into a Living Revelation with me." I am going to invite the Shekinah glory to my spirit, soul and body, my mind will and emotion. Come and let it change everything about me. "One grace after another. One blessing, one spiritual blessing after another, and favor upon favor." Who does not need favor? He calls us "highly favored." There is so much in the Bible about favor. "His favor surrounds me like a shield. It is daily bread. One gift heaped upon gift. It is heaped upon." In our house, Christmas takes up three rooms, because, there is not enough room to put all the gifts under that tree in that room. We had to get another one in the other room, and then we are about to graduate to another room. There is just "gift after gift. Heap after heap." There is not enough room. That is the glory of the Lord. He calls you to Living Revelation. He says, "You thought that gift of tongues was great. Wait, I am going to give you something more. You thought that gift of wisdom was great, but I am going to show you something else. I am showing you every attribute of My heart." We go from glory to glory. We go from faith to faith. That is what it looks like. Say, "I am growing up."

17) For while the law was given through Moses, grace (unearned, undeserved favor and spiritual blessing) and truth came through Jesus Christ." Oh, thank the Lord.

18) "No man has ever seen God at any time; the only unique Son or the or the only begotten God, Who is in the bosom, (in the intimate presence) of the Father. He has declared Him.[He has revealed Him and brought Him out where He can be seen. He has interpreted Him, and He has made Him known.]" He has revealed Christ. He has brought Christ out where He can be seen. "He has interpreted Him, and He has made Him known."

That is what we are walking in every day. This is the revealing, this is the Living Revelation we are in every day. What is stale and old, go before God and say, "Search me and know me. See if there be any wicked way in me. Where have I tried to accomplish anything in my own strength? Where have I abandoned your presence and your glory. Bring me into that Living Revelation and use me for your glory." Oh, He will take you up on that. He sure will. There is a cost involved. Yes, there is a cost, but it is glorious. I exhort us today in this, and we will continue, but this is where I am ending today.

Let's stand up and let's praise Him from start to finish. "Those who have ears to hear, let them hear."

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“Father God, we thank you for Living Revelation. We, thank you that you sent your Word. Thank you that you have grace and peace. It has been multiplied to us to see the One who is and was and is to come. Thank you Jesus for saving us and imparting to us fresh, Living Revelation. We welcome the fullness of your Spirit.
