We love the Lord. We love and we believe in hosting His presence. I believe that every saint is a minister. Every saint is to know God, fear God, obey God, and have fellowship with God. Worship and high praise is really a part of our life. It is not just for Sunday mornings or special gatherings, but when you gather corporately. There is a special anointing in the house of Lord for all of us to join together. How do I know that? Because, I have a Bible that shows and talks about what goes down around the throne of God in Heaven. High praise, day and night, night and day, and every creature worshiping and praising Him. The elders are constantly throwing down their crowns before Him. Angels are ascending and descending, and there are lightning bolts of glory power. Just one movement of His face and all of Heaven stands up, saying, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord." This is in your scripture. The prophets have seen it. The revelation of Jesus Christ is something that is our inheritance. Hallelujah that we get to praise Him and love Him every day. Amen.

Today I have entitled this, "Beloved, Empowered Saints of God." Who are we really? The Lord calls us saints. That is a big word. We used to be a sinner, correct? Okay, you cannot be a saint unless you have been born again from above. We were born sinners. That was easy. It came to us naturally at birth. But, in John chapter three, Jesus says, "You must be born again," and then you go and transition out of a sinner to a saint. That is awesome. That is miraculous. We are going to talk about that. Amen, that is truth. We become saints of the Most High God. We read this a lot because this is the Lord's prayer for His church. Thank you Holy Spirit.

### Ephesians 1:15-21 NKJV

In the exhortation from the Apostle Paul to the church of Ephesus, through the Holy Ghost, he wrote, "I am so encouraged in your faith." He encourages them in their love for all the saints, which included them, yes? He gives thanks and he is praying. He prays to the God of the Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory. The Father of glory, that is the saints' Father, the Father of glory. Therefore, if He is the Father of glory, the saints have something to do with glory. We are receiving the glory of the Father. We are about to be translated out of sin into the glory of the Father. There is an inheritance here, and he knows that the Holy Spirit's wisdom and revelation and knowledge will bring you into this understanding. He prays this prayer, even that our eyes would understand. That it wouldn't just be something we read, but we don't get it. He will come in and change us, right? We are recreated. We are being reformed. We have been born again. He is making everything new. This is a constant prayer, and it will be a prayer for us until we literally cross over into glory. This will not stop, amen.

"What are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints." The Lord has an inheritance in the saints. I am His inheritance. We are His inheritance. That is important to Jesus. He died to have us. He laid down His life. He was crucified on the cross. He died to have us. He gave up everything in obedience to the Father to save us, to redeem us, and by His stripes, we are healed. Amen. This is important. He does this, and He wants us to know the exceeding greatness of His power that is towards us. His power in every day that you live and breathe on the planet. His power from on high is flowing through the Spirit towards us. His inheritance is coming from Heaven. His glory, His power, His riches, His omnipotence, and His greatness is flowing from Heaven towards us every day. It is not just when you read your Bible. It is not just when you go to church, right? It is every day. This is the life of the glory of His presence, abiding daily. "Abide in me and I abide in you. Abide and remain in My word. My word is remaining in you." We are hosting. We are hosting the inheritance of glory and power every day

#### Daniel 7:18 NKJV

This is in the Old Testament, and is a very important verse that most have heard at one time in their journey. This is a declaration that says, "But the saints of the Most High shall receive the Kingdom and possess the Kingdom forever, even forever and ever." Say, "That is me." There is some power in this word, "But the saints of the Most High God **shall** receive," that is covenant. "Shall receive the Kingdom," the Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of Heaven, "and possess the Kingdom." Wow, that is that inheritance, 'and possess the Kingdom forever, even forever and ever."

#### Daniel 7:27 NKJV

He says some more about that complete and total dominion from Heaven to Earth, yes. Heaven is residing in the saints. He has chosen to give us the Kingdom of Heaven. But, it is going to be completely and totally made new. You can see this at the end of the book in Revelation chapters 20 through 22. It will be completely and totally made new. Hallelujah! These are not cheap verses. They were bought by the blood of Jesus and prophesied. Daniel got to see into something that is really holy. When you read Daniel, you get a little scared, because you are thinking of the end of the age. You say, "I don't know if I could put up with that." Change the way you are thinking to the glory of the inheritance in the saints of God and what He has laid hold of for us, amen. This is all in Jesus Christ. He is the King of kings. He is the Lord of lords.

#### Jude 1:3, 20 NKJV

He is speaking to the saints. He calls them "beloved." Isn't that wonderful? "Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you, exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints." Oh, we are shifting a little here. "I was diligent to write to you," these things of salvation, but I know it is necessary. I need to exhort you to "contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints." "Contend earnestly," that is the equipping of the saints. That is revelation knowledge. That is why the Apostle Paul prayed this, "My love for all the saints. I need you to understand the riches of the glory and inheritance that you have in Christ Jesus." It is a continuous prayer. "I exhort you contend for the faith that has been delivered to the saints of the Most High that the saints will overcome," yes. "That the saints will receive that glory. That the saints will understand the inheritance that has been given to us in Christ." We may see just a little now that every day it is growing more and more and more.

Sometimes you don't know just how blessed you are. Then one day, you say, "You know what, I am so blessed." You know you should be so thankful. But, some days you say, "I am so thankful." Some days you know that you have been pulled out of the pit of hell. But some days you say, "You know what? I was pulled out of the pit of hell." One day it comes to you, and you say, "I have been sick. I have been weary, heavy burdened and worn down by the spirit of antichrist that opposes and wearies the saints." Then all of a sudden, something is enlightened in you. You rise above it, and you are laying hold of what is being laid hold of for you. It is contending earnestly for the faith that was delivered to the saints. That every saint would have revelation knowledge of the riches of the glory we inherit now and in the age to come. "Eye has not seen, ear has not heard, all that God has planned for those." Truth. We are walking talking representatives of Heaven now and forevermore.

John 20:21 NKJV

Jesus, we love His commissioning. One statement to His saints, "Peace, to you, as the Father has sent me, I also will send you." We are walking talking representatives of Heaven now and forevermore. "Shalom to you, wholeness, peace and prosperity," the Father sent Me to bring you into the inheritance of glory. Now I am going to send you in that same glory, in that same power to go bring more saints home, save the lost, and get the sinners into the Kingdom, amen. It is an inheritance. It is ascending. It is a commissioning, and it is for every saint. It is not just for "them," right? Say, "It is me." Say, "I am a walking, talking, representative of Heaven now and forevermore. I have received a Kingdom that cannot be shaken."

II Corinthians 5:20-21 NKJV

Beautiful. That is what the saints are carrying. Anyone that is still lost and has not been born again from above and knows Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Not just someone who goes to church. You have go there in your soul, give up your life and receive His, amen. That is what every saint is carrying. He sends us. We are ambassadors of Christ, right? We are representatives. We are bringing and enforcing Heaven on Earth. We are bringing the good news. God is pleading through us. There is that pleading through us. "Earnestly contend for the faith."

He is pleading through every saint, "You must be born again, be reconciled to God, and be saved from this perverse generation. Come out of the dark and into the light. Come up here." We are that witness of His resurrection. We carry resurrection power now in the flesh, even though we are still being perfected, which is amazing. While we are still in this flesh, we are being perfected, correct? We have an inheritance incorruptible. We have an eternal Kingdom that is dwelling within us. That is amazing. That is amazing. We have an eternal Kingdom. Say, "I have an eternal Kingdom. I don't just go to church." You are the Church saints. Amen. I am always *declaring* that because we need revelation. I am earnestly contending for the faith of the saints, amen.

Hebrews 10:14 NKJV

He says, "For by one offering, He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified." That means made holy, yes. You say, "I thought a saint was someone that is really holy." Well, that is what the blood of Jesus just made you, amen. "For by one offering," Jesus Christ in His flesh, "He has perfected forever." That is a covenant word. "He has perfected forever." Those "He has perfected forever," the saints, yes, "who are being sanctified." We are not the same as we were when we first were born again. Oh, thank God! We have all grown up a little. Don't be discouraged. Say, "I am growing. Thank you for your exhortation, Jesus." He calls us, "beloved, empowered saints of God." Okay, that is what we need to lay hold of.

Luke 17:21 NKJV

He says, "Indeed, the Kingdom of God is within you." This was before the cross. He is preparing us. "The Kingdom of God is within you," saint. An incorruptible, exceeding greatness of His power to those who believe. My God, you know what kind of force and power is coming from Heaven through the Holy Ghost towards us to receive the Kingdom! He said, "The Kingdom of God is within you." That is why the verse from Daniel says, "The kingdom and dominion and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole Heaven shall be given to the people." Wow, "For the Kingdom of God is within you," says Jesus. Daniel is looking ahead. But, oh my God, one day this will be our reality. Thank you, Lord.

1 Peter 1:3-9 NKJV

That is how this is all made possible, because the Spirit raised Him from the dead. The Spirit quickened Christ's mortal body, and He was raised to an inheritance, incorruptible, undefiled, that does not fade away, reserved in Heaven for you." Say, "I have reservations. They are

already made in Heaven. That is good news.” Oh my God, “we are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation, ready to be revealed in the last time.” This is Kingdom authority. This is Kingdom revelation. This is Kingdom inheritance. This is the empowerment towards the saints. You have received an inheritance, incorruptible undefiled, that does will not fade away. It is reserved in Heaven for us. Yet, Jesus said, “The Kingdom of God is in you.” That tells me, right now that Kingdom is already working in me while I am still on the Earth. That is the labor. That is the place of revelation. That is a place of knowing the Lord. That is a place of growth.

Yes, when I first got born again, I didn't know any of this except John 3:16-17. But, don't worry, the Lord Jesus Christ will come and teach you. He revealed to you Himself through the word. That is why you read the word about Christ, His Kingdom, His glory, His majesty, His anointing, His healings, His miracles, His salvation, His determination and His hope. That is it. It is all about Christ. Everything belongs to Christ, and everything belongs to you. Everything belongs to Christ. I just listed a few, but everything belongs to you. You say, “I didn't know that.” Thus the earnest prayer and contending for the saints to receive revelation knowledge of the glory, the power, the authority and the dominion of what has been reserved and now is within you, Christ and His Kingdom. Think on His glory, His majesty, His anointing, His healings, His miracles, His salvation, and His determination. Jesus is determined. Thank the Lord. He is not a quitter. He does not shrink back. He never has. He never will. These beloved saints aren't called to shrink back either. Amen.

Hope sees, faith sees and love knows. Love knows you. Love knows me. He knows those places in your soul you desperately need to know that you are loved. God is love, and the greatest of these is love the Scripture says. We see by faith. We see in hope. Love comes, and you say, “I know in whom I believe.” I cannot talk you out of it. Hope sees and faith sees, but when you love, you have received a love that cannot ever be shaken. Because it is in an unshakable Kingdom. Yes, the anointing of Christ rests upon and within every believer. His anointing. He had an anointing from the Holy One, truth. We have an anointing from the Holy One, and we know it very well.

He also, in addition to choosing to indwell within His people, has chosen to baptize His saints in the Holy Ghost and fire. Say, “There is more.” Okay. Many times we limit God with what we call unbelief, but God's not limited. We may not believe what He is saying about me right now, but God's not limited. He will overcome it. He will keep pursuing you, and pursuing you and pursuing us, until we open more and more of that door of that stubborn and unbelieving heart that says, “No, I am still over here in the sinner zone. Jesus, don't you know I am still a sinner? You are trying to make me a beloved saint, clean, pure, holy before God.” He is working to open up our understanding, correct? We are growing. We are growing up. God is not limited, but we limit ourselves with unbelief.

“Faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word.” That is why we read all the scriptures, because when you hear the word, the spirit quickens it, you get it, and veils come off. You see, you hear and your heart receives. There is resurrection power. Yes, we don't want to be blinded or veiled. Remember, the Spirit is quickening our hearts to the inheritance of the glory in the saints. That is good news. He understands that we are flesh, and we are walking this salvation out daily, correct? He has not abandoned us.

Galatians 2:20 NKJV

Paul says, “I was crucified with Christ,” because there is that oneness of my sin into Him. He took it. I died with Him. Sin died with Him in the grave. Then we are raised with Him, we are baptized into His death, and we are raised to life. That is water baptism. Then He comes with the Holy Ghost baptism, where He baptizes you into the Holy Ghost. You are raised in power, authority, anointing and the glory of Jesus to be sent and to go bring more saints into His

inheritance. Whoa, power! Yes, what a work of God. "The Father so loved the world He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever would believe in Him would not perish, but have everlasting life." That is what we are talking about. This is the eternal place, everlasting life. Eternity now, say, "Eternity now."

We sing the old song, "One day at a time, sweet Jesus, that is all I am asking of you." I know that is good, but it is like just barely getting by, Lord, right? We have to come out of religion. We have to come into intimacy with Jesus. Every day I abide with Christ. Every day I hear His voice. Every day I receive His love. Every day is fresh and new for me, even when I am going through hell, even when we are going through flesh, even when we are going through difficulties in life. It is not just, "Dear God, I don't know if you can handle this. Just get me through." That is what we are talking about. That is why they earnestly contend for the faith of the saints to understand the inheritance of glory. Truth! We are looking at His way of thinking, Yes, His way of thinking. We are not quite perfect yet, but we are being perfected. Amen.

What does "more than enough," mean? If we say, Oh, "He is more than enough," right? "He is more than enough." Well, what does that really mean? What does that really mean? How should we live today while it is called today? It is receiving that. It is receiving it. Every day it is receiving it now. You know your need now. You know the desire in your heart now. You know your greatest wishes and needs. You even know where you are at with God now. Say, "I need to be revived. I have been through so much hardness, I need to be revived." Well, today is the day of revival. Amen.

We could do so many good works and really make a difference in this life, in every area of influence, yet it is just one thing He is asking of us, right? It is that we would know Him, because we carry the Kingdom. We are going to go around doing good and healing all who are oppressed by the devil. We are going to go around and do good works. We are going to shine, Jesus, shine. We are going to be faithful in what God has appointed to us. We have gifts and callings. We are using them for His glory, but don't get stuck in the works. Even those who have to go to work, you understand?

We have to go work in the morning. I have to go to school in the morning. I have to get up. I have to go. I have to go on with my life. We go, we do, and we serve. We clean, mop, cook, clean, shower, bathe, serve, birth, raise up, and bury. We have to carry on in this life, but there is an inheritance that is within us. This is our daily bread to know and be renewed to His image and to His likeness. "This is the air we breathe." Y'all remember that song? "His very presence, living in me." If you think of it, what more can Christ do in me and with me? Just think, what more can Christ do in me and with me? Well, you better get a new journal, because He is going to tell you right away, yes. What more can Christ do in me? What more is there? How can I change? How can I grow? What more do I need in Him? What revelation knowledge do you really desire of Him? You know, what burdens you? He says, "I am not limited. I am not unbelieving in this. I believe you are going to get there. We are going through the gates to glory." Say, "Amen!"

Is it possible that your "exact obedience" today is that you choose to obey His voice as He calls you to Himself? Could it be He told us at the beginning of the year, it is about "exact obedience?" To love God is to fear God, to obey God, to love God and know God. He asks for our obedience, and our "exact obedience," is to obey His voice. As He calls you to Himself, there is your "exact obedience." Oh, my goodness. Because then when He speaks to you about that, you might push back a little bit. Because you come back to that limitation, and then you look at you instead of that living One in you. Yes, He calls you a saint. "You are beloved." He is abiding in you. I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me. It is Christ in you and through you. He is the One who heals through you. He is the One who saves through you.

He is the One that gives you knowledge and life and breath. He is the One living in you in the Kingdom of Heaven. We are saints of the Most High God changing the way we think constantly. His commitment is perfect towards us. Aren't you thankful? Oh, my God, His commitment to us is perfect, and our commitment to Him is being perfected. His commitment to us is perfect, and our commitment to Him is being perfected in "exact obedience." You know that pull on your heart, right? You know that pull on your heart, and you know where fear, doubt and unbelief can come against your soul. Yet, we have the glory. We have the promise.

So, we bind the stupor, we bind the slumber, and we bind the apathy. We bind that part of the soul that does not want to hear about the Kingdom of Heaven and a glorious inheritance, because that is going to wipe slumber out. Say, "That is awakening." Alright, that is the lifestyle of every believer. Say, "I am awake." Okay, we are no longer sleepers. We are not, we are not, we are no longer sleepers. Yes, we go to bed, we take naps, and we go to sleep. Our body desires that and needs that. Some just sleep a little longer than others, but we are not sleepers, right? We are not sleepers. When we first have babies, we know they need a lot of sleep. They have been tucked in that womb for a while, and they are growing. Some new mommies out there, say, "Are you kidding? This kid hardly sleeps." But, babies need a lot of sleep, right? As adults, you don't need as much sleep as you did as an infant. We are all growing. Say, "I am growing." There is this growth that God does in us.

There the spirit of stupor and slumber wants to lull you to sleep, limit God and yourself. You carry on in the same every day grind. He calls us, because He says He is never going to leave us, fail us, or forsake us. He is always walking with us. He is not a man that He would lie. He is constantly reviving the fire of His love within you. We lack, but He gains. We suffer, but He heals. We hunger and He satisfies. He knows and we receive. Correct, that is the truth. Where we lack, He gains. Oh my God, when we suffer, He heals. When we hunger, He is going to satisfy. How good it is when you can finally get a good drink. When you are so hot and thirsty, it satisfies that thirst. You know what I mean. When you are hungry or you are starving, and you eat, it satisfies the body.

In the spirit realm, if the Kingdom of Heaven is in you, you are hungering and thirsting for righteousness, and it says, "You shall be filled and satisfied. He will meet that hunger. He will satisfy us with Himself. Amen. His commitment is perfect." I love that. He won't quit. That is why some of you right now are on fire for God. Don't say, "Well, I probably should calm down." No, you need to go spread that fire. Wake up somebody else. Yes, ask for more. That is our saying. There is more. There is always more. Say, "Complacency is for fools." We hunger and thirst for righteousness. It is an ever increasing Kingdom.

Now I want you to hear these verses. Jesus taught us how to pray. I encourage you to go look at all the scriptures in the New Testament where Jesus talked about prayer. We teach on prayer here. We meditate on it. We are called to pray. The house of God is called to be a house of prayer. We labor constantly, not just for the leaders, not just for the seniors, but for all the saints to pray. Now there is some power. There is some power. You get those kids praying, and that is a "cherry on top," because, they pray with the faith of a child still. I want you to give attention to these verses on prayer. I am not going to read every verse where Jesus talks about it in the gospels this morning. We will save it for later.

#### Matthew 5:44 NKJV

He says, "pray," isn't that amazing? Because, He knows this. He knows the journey on the Earth, and you will have tribulation. You will suffer for His name's sake. You know that the sinners will still persecute the saints. He says, "you know the enemies of your soul. Pray, bless them, and forgive them." Amen, there is victory. That is the Kingdom of Heaven. You say, "Well, I am not sure I wanted that." The kingdom on Earth is spite, vengeance, killing, taking them

out, wipe them out, right? But, Jesus came and He bore that on the cross. He annihilated sin, right there. He defeated every work of the flesh, of the devil, and hell. He did that. He knows what He is talking about, because He prayed for us. Oh my God, "I have prayed for you." Oh, "thank you." Now, He says, "I am in you, so we are going to continue to pray for the sinners."

#### Matthew 6:6 NKJV

Answered prayer, manifested presence, tangible presence, of God in your life happens when you get alone with God and it is just you and Him together. He will bring the Kingdom of Heaven. He will manifest the glory to His saints. We are in the house of the Lord, and we pray. That is the individual call. Correct? We have all kinds of prayer and intercession groups. We do all of that, but every saint is called to that closet, yes, to that inner room.

#### Matthew 6:7-13 NKJV

You know, it is just by rote when have to read the stuff, and there's no life. It is not from your heart. "They think that they're saved by their many words." It is not that. He is getting personal. He is getting deep and intimate. Just open your heart to God. Pray the word. Reveal your heart to Me. I will reveal My heart to you. But you can still get into a "Father, oh Father, Father, Father, Father... No, no vain repetitions of His name even.

"Our Father, in Heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give me this day, my daily bread. Forgive me my debts, my sins. I forgive my debtors." There it is again. "Do not lead me into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one." Truth. "Yours is the Kingdom and the power and the joy forever."

That is truth and it all comes together in the beloved inheritance in the saints. It is daily abiding. He calls us to this prayer. We don't want to be prayerless. This was stated this morning. He talks about speaking to mountains and moving them by the saints of the Most High.

#### Mark 11:24 NKJV

Oh Lord, "whatever things you ask when you pray, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive it." Because you are communing with the Holy Ghost, and He is directing your prayers. You can tell Him anything. You can pour out your soul to Him. You don't have to have an accountability partner to tell all the mess in your life to. That is why you have God. Yes, there is a place in every soul that is only for you and God. Then there is a time to confess your sins one to another and pray. There is deliverance. There is healing. But this is the intimate place with you and the Lord, that the sleep or slumber does not want you to go into. But, we have been removed from that and quickened, even receiving the inheritance. Pray in that place. Believe you receive when you pray. That is that faith area. You don't know how He is going to do it, but you believe it. That is just raw faith. This is what Jesus instructs us here.

#### Luke 18:1 NKJV

You know, the antichrist spirit wearies and wears down the saints. It opposes the Christ, it opposes the anointing. It opposes Holy Ghost. Yes, it wears down the saints. You are weary in battle, and He says, "You must not lose heart." That is why it is good to praise the Lord and thank Him for everything you are praying for as a beloved saint. You are receiving an inheritance, you are receiving a Kingdom, and yet you have day to day battles. You have day to day needs. the Lord is right there in the middle of all. Amen.

#### Ephesians 6:18 NKJV

He encourages us with this. He told us all about this awesome, magnificent armor that we are going to wear, and how we are going to fight the good fight on Earth. His is the Kingdom and the glory and the power forever. He tells us this verse eighteen, "Pray always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, be watchful to this end, with all perseverance and supplication

for all the saints.” Prayer for all the saints. It is that working of that knowledge of what He wants us to lay hold of. It is not just one person's job to pray for all the saints. It is every saint's responsibility to pray for all the saints. The leaders are called to it. It is not optional. Heads of households, husbands, grandfathers, dads, men of the house, you are called to pray for your house, amen. Don't put it on the wife, and say, “Well, she is the praying woman, bless God.” No, you are the praying man of God. When the man of God gets up and prays and prays. They do not pray weak, wimpy prayers. What kind of prayer did Jesus Christ pray? What kind of prayer is He still praying? He is our head. He is our husband. He is the great high priest. He is ever living to pray for us every day. That is why we are getting our breakthrough. Somebody in Heaven is praying for you. He calls us and blesses us to pray, empowered saints of God.

I have to read one more time from Daniel 7:18, 27.

“But the saints of the Most High shall receive the Kingdom and possess the Kingdom forever, even forever and ever.”

“Then the Kingdom and dominion and the greatness of His Kingdoms under the whole Heaven shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His Kingdom is an everlasting Kingdom, and all dominion shall serve and obey Him.”

Let's stand up and receive His exhortation. It has been such a glorious morning. We are so thankful. If you need prayer afterwards, we always will pray for you. Amen.

“Jesus, we are receiving an incorruptible Kingdom. We receive the knowledge of You. Jesus, we receive your revelation, we receive your exhortation, we receive your laboring with us. You are with us in the quiet places, and you help us to pray and to bless and to forgive every day. You are with us in our needs. You are with us through dark times and good times.
