I encourage all of you, sometime today before you forget, to write down what the Holy Spirit showed you today during worship. Okay, it is very important. We teach it is important to journal. Write down, acknowledge, and remember the impressions, the visions, the thoughts, the feelings, and the scriptures. Write down what you heard, what you saw, what impressions He really made on your heart. What conviction He put in your soul, right? When you do that, you are stewarding His voice. You are stewarding the presence there. Hallelujah. Then you can go back and talk to the Lord more about that, because I can guarantee He is probably not through talking. He just wants to continually come all day, every day. This is our lifestyle as a believer. Glory to God.

I am going to exhort us today. I entitled this, "Guardian God and King Jesus." I read a lot of scripture, because "faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the Word of God," amen. His Word is true. His Word goes and opens up our hearts to hear His heart. God's Word opens up our spirit to see in the Spirit. God's Word goes before us and breaks open a way for us. Jesus said, "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life." He is the Word of God. So, we honor and acknowledge the Word all week, amen. Whether He wakes us up in the night, or as we go along the way, or in our quiet places, Holy Spirit just speaks the scripture to you. When you are studying, reading, or praying and wherever it may be, it is the Word of the Lord manifesting the Kingdom of Heaven. The Word of the Lord manifests the Kingdom of Heaven.

Great Holy Spirit rests upon the believer in power and in might to take us into the heart of the Lord. It is the Holy Spirit who gives us understanding. It is the Holy Spirit who interprets the word. You know how that is. You can read something, and you are not too sure what that really means. But if you will ask, seek and knock, He will continue to reveal Himself in these words. The Lord is always talking to us, 24/7. Even in the night, whether you have dreams or visions or not, He is there. He is hovering over His beloved. He speaks. He is ministering to our spirit. Our spirit is one with Jesus. I guarantee you that Heaven's happening even while you sleep. Yes, and you may not know it. You may wonder why you woke up with a little, "skip in your step," but, Jesus is always ministering, and the great Holy Ghost is empowering us to know God. He is faithful and true. We just honor His Word, and encourage and exhort you in this. Amen. Oh, hallelujah, say "Guardian God and King Jesus." Now, we are going to say it like we mean it, say, "Guardian God and King Jesus!" There you go.

1 Peter 1:3-5 NKJV

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord, Jesus Christ." In this introduction, in this letter, in First Peter, they go forth in honor and praise and blessing the Father, yes. Blessing the Son, blessing the Spirit, blessing His heart and the intent of His heart, always. Always come into His presence with thanksgiving. Come into His courts with praise. Give thanks to His holy name, declaring who He is. That is truth. "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to His abundant mercy." God is merciful. Oh, my God is merciful. He is abundant in mercy.

Because of His abundant mercy, "He has begotten us again to a living hope." Christ is not dead. He is alive and He is living. He, through His sacrifice, died so we could go beyond the veil. Go into the heart of God and be born again. Yes, we have now, what we call a "living hope." We have a "living hope." We are living. We are living. We are not dead, okay? He has begotten us again to a living hope. We were born again for a living hope. Hope is not dead.

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He encourages us in hope, the power of hope, and hope in His resurrection. He has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, because He was raised from the dead. So, we rejoice and give God all glory, honor and praise when we think of that resurrection every day. Every day, you have to think about this, that Christ was crucified, dead and buried and He was raised. Okay? You have to think on this every day, not just a special holiday, correct? You are thinking every day that the God that I serve is living, and the One that came to save me died for me. He gave me His mercy. He gave me a “living hope.” But, He is a “living hope.” Okay, this is a resurrection. This is power. It is incorruptible.

Verse four, “He gave us an inheritance, incorruptible,” very, very important. God gave us, “an inheritance, incorruptible and undefiled, and that does not fade away, reserved in Heaven for you.” That is truth, “Thy Kingdom come, Father. Thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven.” This is what Jesus Christ has done for us. He has begotten us again unto a living hope, and we can live in resurrection power while we are still on the Earth. We are to live by His power, His resurrection power, through His living hope while we are here.

We are not in the grave anymore. The last grave you saw was when you were baptized into Christ Jesus, and then He raised you up, amen. Your spirit man is alive and well with Christ. Your spirit is living with Him. That is truth. Yes, one day we will cross on over, hallelujah. “He who believes in Me shall never die. We have been born again to a living hope for an “inheritance incorruptible.” We have no idea, apart from the Scripture, what that inheritance entails. We think we know, but Oh, beloved, “no eye has seen, no ear has heard, all the thoughts that are in the Father's heart towards us.” We think, we know. We see in part. We have the word. We dwell on it. We are caught up in glory. We even have visions of Heaven. We are sometimes taken there in glory. But, here is the truth of what is laid up for us as believers. This is our “inheritance incorruptible and undefiled that shall not fade away, and is reserved in Heaven for you.” That is personal. It is every saint, from the eldest to the youngest, amen.

He goes on in verse five, “Who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.” So, every day, and I think I quote this Scripture every day. I am not joking. “I am kept by the power of God.” That is what you have to do. You know what God has reserved for you now and in the age to come. He has laid up something for us that is so absolutely glorious. We just believed God. We just believed Jesus Christ, as the Lord and Savior of all, and that He died for our sins. We believed it. We believed the gospel. We believed it. Then, we enter into this living hope. We enter into the family of God. We enter into His inheritance. Yet, we become His inheritance.

We have entered into a Kingdom that can never be shaken. No one can take it. It is undefiled. It will be eternal, forever and ever and ever. Yet, He says, “Now I am going to give you power to live in that today, while it is called today.” We can live from that life. We can live from that knowing. We can live from that power, even if you are going through a rough spell, amen. So, you could just meditate on that over and over again. Put that scripture in your mouth, confess it, decree it, pray it, and let it strengthen your soul. Your spirit's got it, but your soul needs it, and the body says, “Oh, I hope so.” No, the body, “knows in whom it believes.” Thank you, Jesus, that you have begotten us to a living hope.

1 Samuel 2:9

“He will guard the feet of His saints, but the wicked shall be silent in darkness.”

“He, God, will guard the feet of His saints.” Does He just like our feet and our our toes? What's up with that? Yes, He likes our feet. He made them, but this has everything to do with our walk, our step, and His plans for us. His destiny for us. It has everything to do with that. It is not just the bottom of my foot, but yet it contains my foot. “He will guard the feet of His saints,”

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wherever we go. "He will guard the feet of His saints, but the wicked shall be silent in darkness." Say, "He guards my feet." He is a Guardian God and King Jesus.

Psalm 91:1-2 NKJV

"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord. He is my refuge and my fortress, my God in Him, I will trust." He is the rock of our strength. He who dwells in the secret place, who lives and abides with the most High shall abide under the shadow in His canopy, in His covering, in His house and His glory. This is His glory, His glory, His glory. "So I will say of the Lord, 'Oh, you are my refuge, and you are my fortress, my God in Him I will trust.'" You know that through the Scriptures. Everything the Spirit is trying to get us to do is to, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, lean not on your own understanding, but in all your ways, acknowledge Him, and He will make our paths straight." That is the journey on this side. It is trusting in God Almighty, trusting in His Word, trusting in what has been written and spoken, and trust what He speaks to us. We are hidden under the shadow of that glory. We are under that canopy. We are under His shadow.

I Peter 2:25 NASB

"For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls."

Truth, "you were continually straying like sheep." That is who we were. That is when we were lost, "but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls."

"The Lord is our Shepherd. We shall not want." Yes, hallelujah! Oh, I am so glad He called us to Himself. Thank you, Jesus!

Isaiah 40:28-31 NKJV

This passage just puts you right up front and center before God in Heaven to praise Him. That is what this passage does. This word just brings you up, forward and center, right before God. It is the truth. Have you not known? Have you not heard? The doors start opening to the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the Earth. You see yourself entering in closer and closer to Him. Right? You are introduced to the living God in the Scripture. You are introduced through this prophet's words. You are introduced to Him, and you are going up that ladder, right up into His presence. You are introduced to Him. Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, and the Creator of the ends of the Earth, "He does not faint and grow weary." Because, humans do and we do.

"His understanding is unsearchable." You see the praise? "He gives power to the weak." Remember earlier, we quoted that, "He has kept us by His power," correct? "He gives power to the weak," thank God. "To those who have no might, He increases strength. Even the youth shall faint and be weary, and young men can utterly fall." But, "those who wait," on that word. "Those who wait." It says this, "For those who wait, look for, hope, expect, endure, remain, look eagerly, hold fast like a twisted rope bound together, robust for the notion of binding fast, to be strong in the Lord. "Those who wait on the Lord." It just got bigger. Sometimes you just think it is like you are just sitting there waiting, you know?

Instead, this is action. It is active. It is living. It is a living hope. It puts you in a position before our creator, God, almighty God, Himself. It positions us before the Father to see who He is. He meets us in our weaknesses. He loves us in our weaknesses. Yet, He demonstrates His greatness as He approaches us in light. He strengthens us as we see Him for who He is. He strengthens us. So, those who wait, who look for hope, expect, endure, remain, look, eagerly, hold fast like a twisted rope bound together, robust for the notion of binding fast. I love that, "to be strong." You see, that puts some more umph on it. "Those who wait on the Lord." It is not passive. It is strength. "When you wait on the Lord, the power of Heaven comes.

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When you wait on the Lord, the strength of God manifests. When you wait on the Lord, you are saying, "I believe you, God." When you wait on the Lord, you put all your faith in Him. He is, Almighty God, Creator. He does not faint and grow weary. When you wait on the Lord, "You shall renew your strength." There you go. You are lifted up. "You will mount up with wings like eagles. You will run and not be weary. You will walk and not faint." You see, you are lifted up immediately into the presence of God and what God can do. Truth. This is the abiding under the shadow of the Almighty. This is abiding and dwelling under the shadow of the Almighty. We serve Almighty God, yes.

Yet, He is our Father, and we can come boldly to the throne of grace through the blood of Jesus. The Lord is assuring us. He says, "I am your Guardian God." He is assuring us of this in these scriptures, "I am your Guardian God. I am your Chief Shepherd." He watches over us. He keeps us, His flock and His inheritance, as the true Shepherd. We are His inheritance. We belong to Him. He said, "My sheep hear My voice. Hallelujah. We belong to Him. He is our Guardian God. He is our Chief Shepherd. He is watching over us and He is keeping us, His flock and His inheritance. He is our trust and our assurance.

All that we have just read comes together to these heart issues. Because, humans want to do everything in their own strength, and not ask for help sometimes. "I got this, we are good. We are good." How are you, "I am good." "Baloney," alright, and sometimes it looks like that. But, it is the defense that we put up. "I am good." God says, "No, you are not." He is getting us to come up, front and center, to trust Him. He wants us to have this assurance that He is the Lord, my Shepherd. The Lord is My Shepherd. We have a picture of Him on the back window in this church. Y'all don't believe me? Look up there. You can just turn around and look. There is a picture of Jesus, the Shepherd, with a little sheep. Wow. He is assuring us, He is our Guardian God, and Chief Shepherd. The God of glory, guards.

The God of glory, guards. The God of glory, guards. The God of glory guards. He keeps whatever is entrusted to Him. He keeps and He watches over what belongs to Him, constantly, 24/7. You are never out of His heart. You are never out of His sight. Amen, Hallelujah, "where can you go from His presence? Where can you go from His Spirit?" Right? He is there. He neither slumbers nor sleeps. He never fails. He just can't. He can't. Your spirit is rejoicing. Your soul says, "I will believe it." Yes, He is the Watchman. He is the Strong Tower. He is your Champion of the faith. He guards and He keeps. We bless the Lord. He is going to keep the one who trusts in Him. He surrounds us like a shield, and He envelops us. The Word of God guards. When you read this Bible, when you read the word, when you hear the word, and when He is speaking to you, He is guarding you. He is guarding you. He is guarding you, not just from evil, but He is guarding you in His glory. Amen.

The Word of God comes from His heart and mouth and the Spirit of grace, period. That is what we are hearing. We hear the Words of God, and we are drawn to God. "A strangers voice, we will not listen to." Amen. The Word of God is a guard set over you day and night. The Word of God is a guard set over you day and night, and does not slumber nor sleep. You didn't know that the Word of God was working? The Word is literally ministering to us day and night, 24/7. The Word is always ministering to us day and night, night and day. The Word of God is guarding us. It isn't just that, you received a "word in 1984 that a prophet gave you." No, no, no, the Word of God, the living, breathing Word of God. "I Am that I Am," He is ministering to you. He is guarding you day and night, night and day. He is your Guardian God, guarding that Word that is manifesting over you every day. That is how we can go from glory to glory.

You sure can't take credit for it. You just say, "Here I am, Lord. I am yielded to you, and I believe you." God's Word is active, working, watching and waiting. If He is the Guardian God, of course, His Word is working out His great salvation in us, day by day, moment by moment.

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He is watching. He is active, working, watching and waiting. He is opening our understanding to go deeper and deeper, in more revelation knowledge of who He is as our Guardian God. He is so good, isn't He!

Proverbs 2:8 NKJV

"He guards the paths of justice." That is about my feet again, "our steps." "He guards the paths of justice and preserves the way of His saints," truth. "He guards the paths of justice." That is a big statement. When the foundation of His throne is justice and righteousness, He guards the paths of justice and He is preserving the way of His saints. Guardian God, Chief Shepherd, True Shepherd, in trust and assurance, the God of glory is guarding and keeping.

Isaiah 58:8 NKJV

He sure does. The angelic hosts are guarding that glory. Yes, they are guarding the glory. They are guarding the God of glory in you. They are guarding your windows, your doors, your gates, your paths, your feet, your house, when you lie down, when you get up, and when you go along the way. They are guarding your path. They are guarding the glory. The angels of the Lord are hearkening unto the voice of the words of the Lord. They are guarding your destiny. They are guarding your future. They are seeing to it that you are going forward and upward and onward into the high call of God in Christ. That is their job. When you are in the Word, you abide in Him. You speak these scriptures and the flame just got fired up. But nonetheless, this is truth. Truth, okay, and when you wake up in that glory, whoa, there they are. There it is, "the glory of the Lord is your rear guard." That is a good thing. The rear guard is important in the military. Amen. I read this last week. I am going to continue on a little bit more.

Ephesians 1:17-23 AMPC

He says, "For I always pray to the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you," saints, me, "a spirit of wisdom and revelation [of insight into mysteries and secrets] in the [deep and intimate] knowledge of Him." He is praying that He would give us the spirit wisdom and revelation, insight into mysteries and secrets, in the deep places of God's heart. Deep and intimate knowledge of Him. So, you know the Lord in a whole new way today like you didn't yesterday. You saw Him in a whole new manner and light. He revealed Himself in a new way that you have never known before. Your praise just went higher. You are giving such high praise, because all of a sudden, "oh my God, He provided my need. He healed my body. He told me He loves me. He gave me deeper revelation of the scriptures that I am reading. He took me into heavenly places and explained it to me, truth!"

Verse 18, "By having the eyes of your heart," I love this, "flooded with light, so that you can know and understand the hope to which He has called you, and how rich is His glorious inheritance in the saints (His set apart ones)." He guards the paths of justice, and He preserves the way of His saints. The saints are His inheritance. We are His and He is ours. Amen. "Having the eyes of our heart flooded with light so that you can know," oh, I hope I know, "so that you can know and understand the hope." The hope, "Christ in you, the hope of glory." We can know the hope "to which He has called you," you, me, us, the Church. "The hope to which He has called you, and how rich is His glorious inheritance in the saints." This is Kingdom of Heaven. You can't put an American dollar on this. You cannot measure it to man's standards. It is not even compared to the things of this world and the world system. Even the greatest, wonderful, most beautiful places on the planet that He created, cannot compare to the knowledge and the glory of God in His saints and His family. Nothing is to be compared to those that He has called His own. Amen. We are the inheritance, yet He is our inheritance as one. Say, "as one."

Verse 19, "And [so that you can know and understand] what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe." That, we "would know and

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understand what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength.” It is like Heaven is for us. Heaven is pursuing us. What Jesus Christ opened for us is His sonship. The reality of knowing what it is like to be a son, a child, a daughter of God, and to know the inheritance that we have in the Father. Jesus is the firstborn of many brethren. Yes, He is the one that made a way and allowed us to come back to Him. Hallelujah. We are just a bunch of prodigals, but here we are. We know in Whom we believe, yes. I want to know and understand the immeasurable, unlimited, surpassing greatness of His power, because I believe. I believe. I believe and this is what is pursuing us. This is what is bathing our feet in cream. This is what is directing our step in Kingdom business in the Kingdom of Heaven. This is what empowers us when we take down, we bind, we forbid, and we destroy the works of the devil. This is what is backing us. Amen.

Verse 20, “Which He exerted in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and He seated Him at His [own] right hand in the heavenly [places].” All of that. When He was raised from the dead and ascended and seated. Sealed, say, “sealed, done, finished.” This is your Guardian God and King Jesus. All of this. “He exerted in Christ,” the Anointed One and His anointing, “when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places.” We know that is the throne for Jesus. Jesus sits in the throne. Nobody else sits in that seat, but Jesus, reserved and kept for Him. Truth. That is His throne and His seat. Truth, wow, there is power there. He describes it further.

Verse 21, “Far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named {above every title that can be conferred}, not only in this age and in this world, but also in the age and the world which are to come.”

Verse 22, “And He has put all things under His feet and has appointed Him the universal and supreme Head of the Church, [a headship exercise throughout the church].” You see this explanation of His authority, His kingship. He is the Guardian of the glory in you. He is the Guardian of the glory over all thrones, powers, principalities, from the highest ranking to the lowest. Everything created in Heaven and Earth, below the Earth, and all that God has done. He is King. He is the Guardian of all. He is enthroned and sits at the right hand of God Almighty. At the right hand of power and the right hand of authority and the scepter of righteousness rules the land, truth. It is a throne of righteousness. Christ my righteousness. He is transforming His saints into His righteousness. When we get all revelation and understanding of who He says we are now, in Him, then apart from Him, we can do nothing. You see this position? He says that He is the Head of the Church.

Verse 23, “Which is His body, the fullness of Him,” the Church, “who fills all in all.” “Which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him who makes everything complete, and who fills everything everywhere with Himself].” Christ, the Head. Through Christ Jesus, we as the Church, carry spiritual supremacy. Okay, He is the Head. We are the Body. He is on the throne, and yet, we are going to be seated with Him. So, He fills, all in all. Picture it from Heaven. Everything that fills is His Body and His authority. Oh my, this is not just, “one day when we grow up, and we are going to die and go to heaven,” talk. This is Kingdom authority, and He prays that we would get this. That is why there is so much anointing on these apostolic prayers, because it is spoken by the Apostle Himself, Christ, given to the Apostle Paul, to give to the saints in glory and give to the Church, throughout time. Until we see Him face to face, then it is going to overflow into the millennial reign. Truth, His Body, the fullness of Him. Say, “His Body, the fullness of Him.” That is why the Body of Christ is so valuable, so precious, and so pure to Him. Yes, the Body of Christ. Wow.

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Then, usually, the Body of Christ is the one that persecutes you the most. It is where the most wounds take place. The lost have their share, right? The devil has done a number, because every saint is trying to figure out who they really are. They will compete, they will judge, they will be enemies, they will be jealous, they will get in the flesh, strife and envy. All those workings of the flesh and sin work to oppose this kind of power and anointing. Because, if the devil can keep you going around and around in circles and mess, you have a hard time laying hold of this great inheritance, right? But, once you "turn the page," you say, "wait, wait, wait a minute." Who am I really in Him? Yes. When He gives you the scepter of righteousness to rule with, you say, "Okay, this is a whole new ball game." Glory to God, "Which is His Body, the fullness of Him."

Now, you have to think of the Body of Christ. He knows those who are His. The Body of Christ, the fullness of Him. The Body of Christ, the fullness of Him. We are not separate from Him. He is the Head. He is the Husband. We are the Bride. We are One. You hear it? The the Body of Christ, the fullness of Him. We have work to do, alright? We are there with Him. We are there with Him. We are with there with Him. Can you feel it? We are right there with Him. We are right there with Him, as He works across the globe. He is the Guardian God, and He is guarding the paths of justice. He is preserving the way of His saints. There is purpose. There is purpose, there is hope and there is future. We have His spiritual supremacy, but we are not on His throne. God be praised, amen.

Ephesians 2:5-10 AMPC

"Even when we were dead, (slain) by [our own] shortcomings and trespasses, He made us alive together in fellowship and in union with Christ. {He gave us the very life of Christ Himself, the same new life with which He quickened Him, For} it is by grace, (His favor and mercy, which you did not deserve) that you are saved, (delivered from judgment and made partakers of Christ's salvation). Ha, "even when we were dead, slain by our own shortcomings and trespasses in our sin, He made us alive together." Say, "Together in fellowship and in union with Christ." He gave us the very life of Christ Himself, who does that? What king gives you, everything he has? He says that, "You are in Me, and I am in you, and we are one." Wow. "All authority has been given to Me in Heaven and Earth, and I give you authority, go." Who does that? "Oh, the grace of Jesus." Yes, the same new life that was in Christ and quickened in Him.

He gave to us the same power, the same Holy Ghost, the same passion is in us now. That's why we are so wild and crazy, right? We are sold out. We believe He delivered us from judgment. We are partakers of His salvation. When we take the cracker and the juice or the wine in communion, representing the body, this is covenant, yes. This is covenant. It is a reminder of covenant and of what He has done. We are in covenant with God through Christ. Everything that belongs to God, belongs to you. Everything that belongs to me, belongs to Him. You hear it, co-inheritance. Oh, my God, I have been grafted into the household of faith. Every time you take this, you are remembering who He is, what He has done, and where you sit. How you are in Him, how you are with Him, and how He has anointed you. He has bathed your feet with cream. He is just. He is directing the way of His saints through His justice. He has anointed us to be His own.

Verse six, "And He raised us up together with Him and made us sit down together." It is like, "Sit right here. I love it. I am a mama and grandmama and I love it. It is like, "Sit down right here, right? Sit down, sit down, come be with me. Talk to me." You put them in your lap. Hold me. Sit with me awhile. "He raised us up together with Him and made us sit down together." You have to see it as Father God, "Sit with Me. Be with Me where I am. My Son bought you and raised you from the dead, and you are alive now. I want to be with you here. You be with Me here. Now I am going to be with you there." Truth. You have to hear it. You have to hear the heart versus some legal thing. "He raised us up together with Him and made us sit down

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together, [giving us joint seating with Him] in the heavenly sphere. [By virtue of our being] in Christ Jesus, (the Messiah, the Anointed One).” He has allowed us to sit with Him in a rule and authority under God, under Christ, the Head, the Body that fills all in all. This is going to change everything. The closer and the closer, the more glory, and the more revelation knowledge we will be given of this. All of a sudden, you are starting to see more dominion, more authority, more manifestation, because the intimidator comes to show you how evil, how dark, how bad, how revolting he is. Jesus said, he is a thief. He has been a murderer from the beginning. He wants to intimidate you and have you forget where you are seated. He wants you to be intimidated in fear, so that you will not pray that “effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man that is working powerfully and availing much.” Because when you know, hey, listen, “I use the name of Jesus, and the name of Jesus has all authority from Heaven all the way through under the Earth. When I say the name of Jesus, Heaven is responding. It is not my authority, it is His.” Hear it? “Well, wait a minute, Satan is under the feet. He has no authority and power.”

“I am seated with Jesus in heavenly places.” The name of Jesus is the name above every name from the highest in the heavens all the way down. He covers it all, that we are the fullness of Him who fills all and all. The intimidator wants you to shut up, quit dreaming, and don't think big, right? Don't go out there and do the work of the ministry. You are not qualified. He wants to lie to you and keep you down. All you have to do is get up, and sit down in your seat and know that you are seated with Christ. It is like, “move over,” right? The fullness of Him who fills all in all. The devil is terrified of the believer knowing who you are. When you get in that kind of authority, and you pray that effective, fervent prayer, Heaven is moving. You may not see the results of it, but Heaven is moving. If we see the results, glory be to God. If it is that soul you have been laboring for, and they come in through someone else leading them to Jesus, or they got caught up in the glory, praise God, your prayer has been answered. That is what He does. But, we have to take them back *from the enemy*. We have to snatch them out of hell. Amen. You hear the power.

I Timothy 6:20

As a church, we are called individually and corporately to “guard what was committed to our trust.” Yes, and that is people, humans, the flock, one another, and all that He has entrusted to us to keep in the work itself.

II Timothy 1:14 NASB2020

“Protect, through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us, the treasure which has been entrusted to you.” Protect, guard and keep. You see, we have been given the wealth of Heaven. We have been given “the riches of the glory and inheritance of the saints.” We have been given Christ Himself, the King of kings, the Lord of lords. The Guardian God has entrusted to us King Jesus. Everything that is His is ours. Everything that belongs to Him, belongs to us, and we belong to Him. We are His inheritance, and He is our inheritance, and we are one. That is why, when you read John 17, you just see it right there. “I am in you, and you are in Me, and we are one.” Oh God, that they “would know the glory and know the love that We have for them.” That is the labor of the Godhead for us to come into that revelation knowledge, amen.

Let's stand up and acknowledge His ministry to us today, start to finish. He is not done yet.

“God, impart Your life. We thank You, Lord for giving us more, greater, deeper revelation knowledge of who You are. You are our Guardian God. You guard the sheep. Oh, You guide the sheep. You take care of the sheep. We are so glad you are our Shepherd. Jesus, You are a good, good Shepherd. Thank you, Jesus. Thank you Jesus. We believe Your words. We receive Your words. We pray as You have manifested in our lives. Change us, Lord, as we go from glory to glory. We thank You for the angelic hosts that are guarding that glory and have our back. In Jesus' name, amen.
