Living Sacrifices to God

“1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, **by the mercies of God,**

that you:

- present your bodies a living sacrifice,
- holy,
- acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service [true worship; spiritual worship].

2 And **do not** be conformed to this world, but **be transformed** by the renewing of your mind, that ***you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.***

Serve God with Spiritual Gifts

3 For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you,

- not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think,
- but to think soberly [wisely, sensibly, soundly]
- as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

4 For as we have **many members in one body**, but **all the members do not have the same function**, 5 so **we, being many, are one body in Christ**, and **individually members of one another.**

6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us,

6 NLT - In his grace, God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well,

let us use them:

- if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;
- 7 or ministry [serving], let us use it in our ministering;
- he who teaches, in teaching;
- 8 he who exhorts, in exhortation;
- he who gives, with liberality;
- he who leads, with diligence;
- he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

Behave Like a Christian

9 Let love be without hypocrisy.

- Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
- 10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
- 11 not lagging in diligence,
- fervent in spirit,
- serving the Lord;
- 12 rejoicing in hope,
- patient in tribulation,
- continuing steadfastly in prayer;
- 13 distributing to the needs of the saints,
- given to hospitality.

14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.

15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

16 Be of the same mind toward one another.

- Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble.
- Do not be wise in your own opinion.

17 Repay no one evil for evil.

- Have regard for good things in the sight of all men.
- 18 If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.
- 19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. 20 Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head."

21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."
